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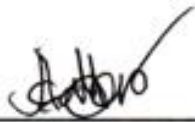

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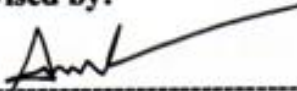

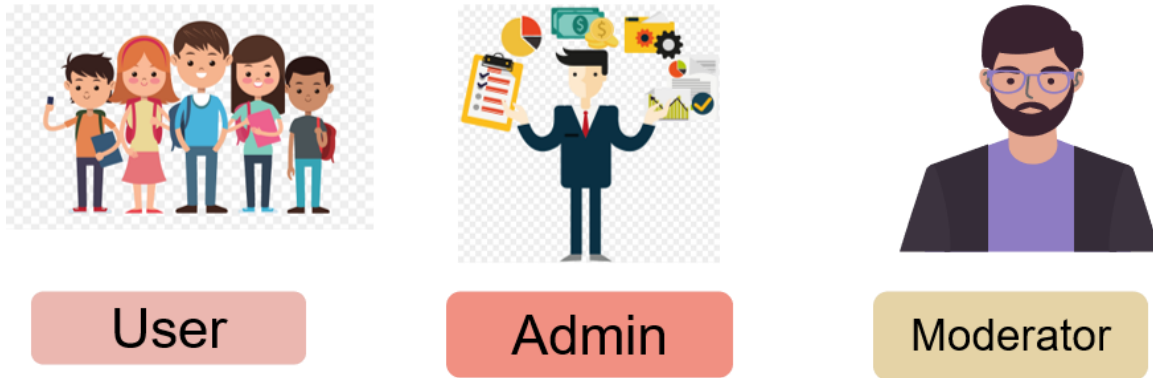


Figure 02: Stakeholder

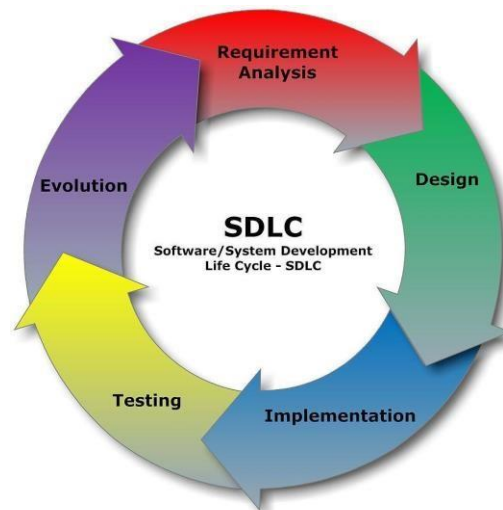


Figure 03: SDLC

3.1 Ware Frame

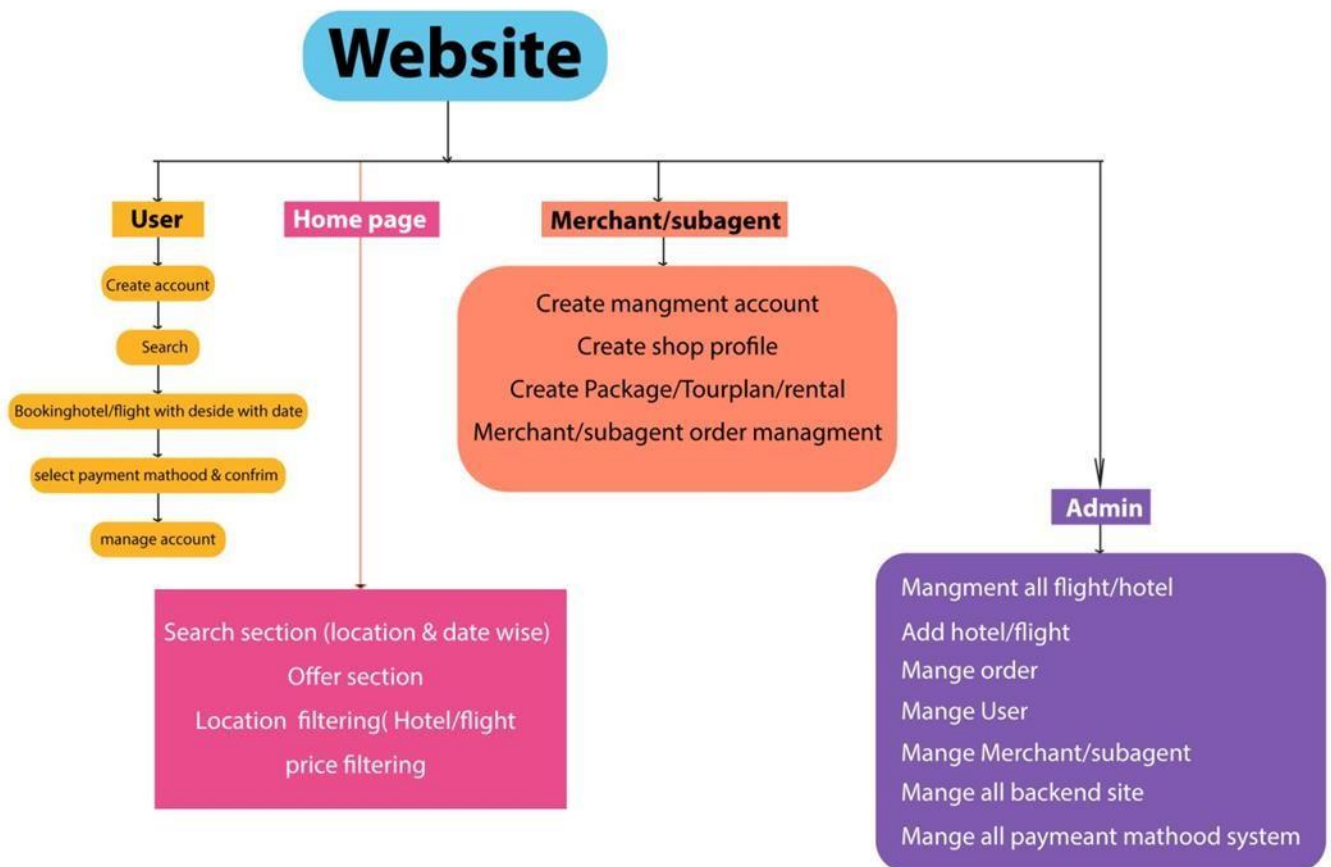


Figure 06: Ware Frame

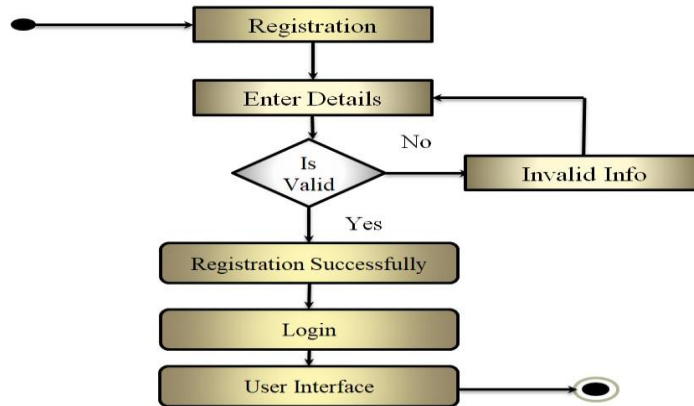


Figure 07: Registration

The user enters their username and password, which the system verifies. If the credentials are correct, the user is granted access; otherwise, an error message prompts them to re-enter their details.

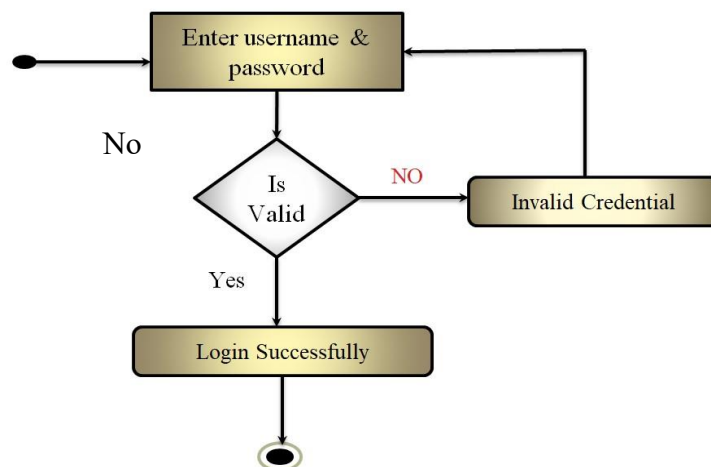


Figure 08: Login

The user accesses the update profile feature and modifies their personal details. The system validates and saves the changes, confirming the successful update to the user.

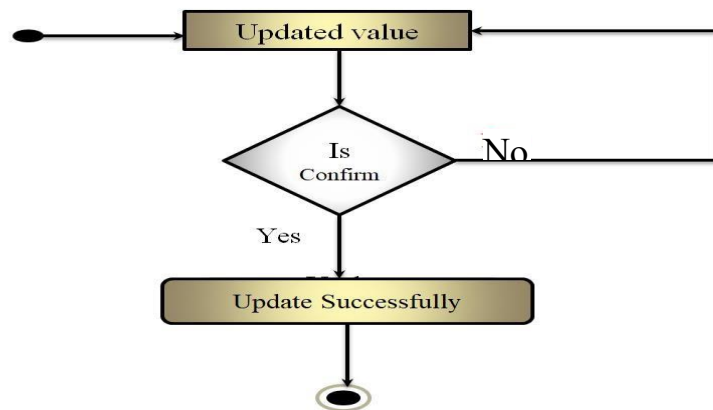


Figure 09: Update Profile

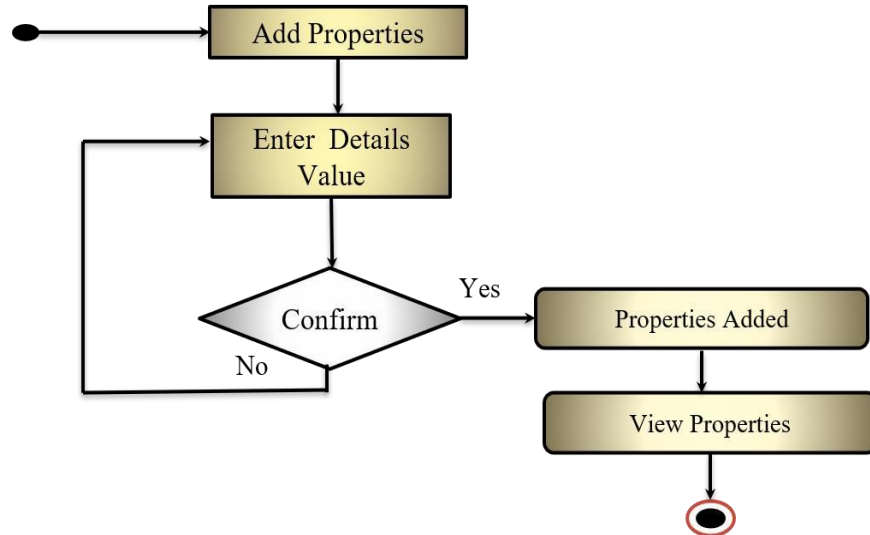


Figure 10: Add Properties

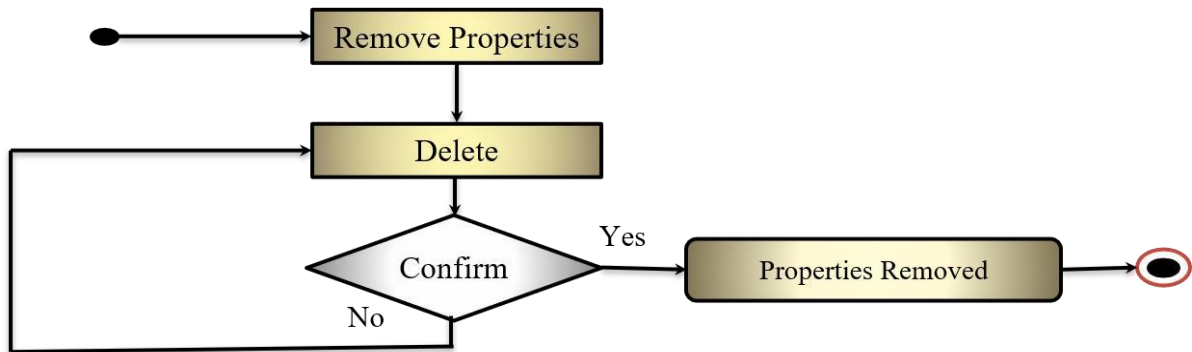


Figure 11: Remove Schedule

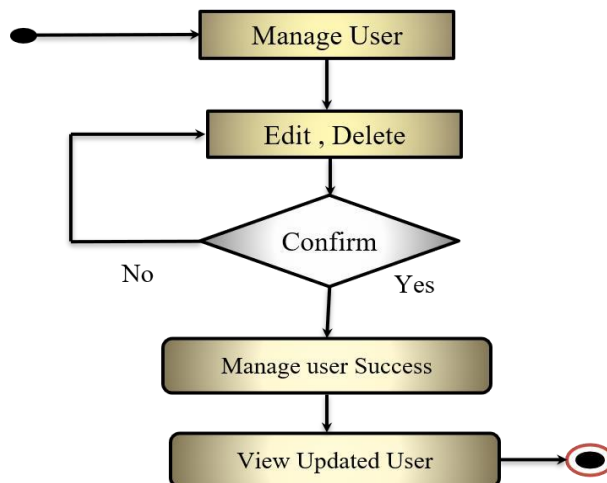


Figure 12: Manage User

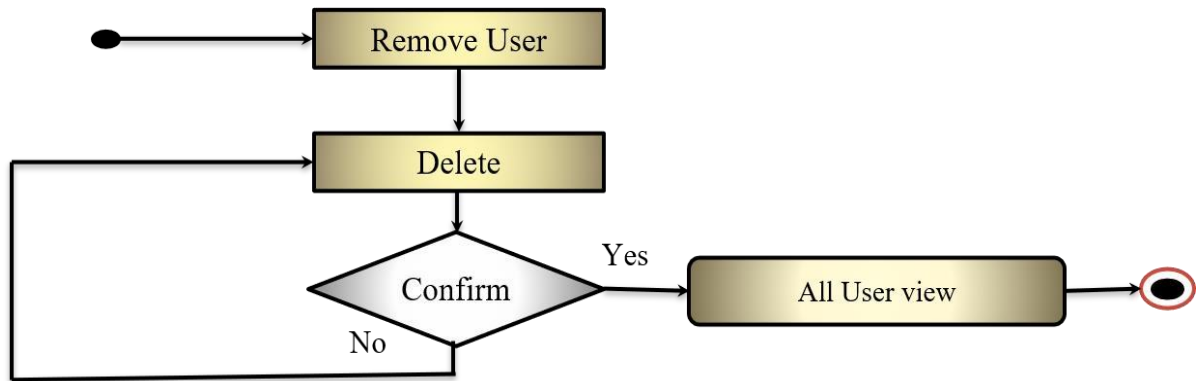


Figure 13: Remove User

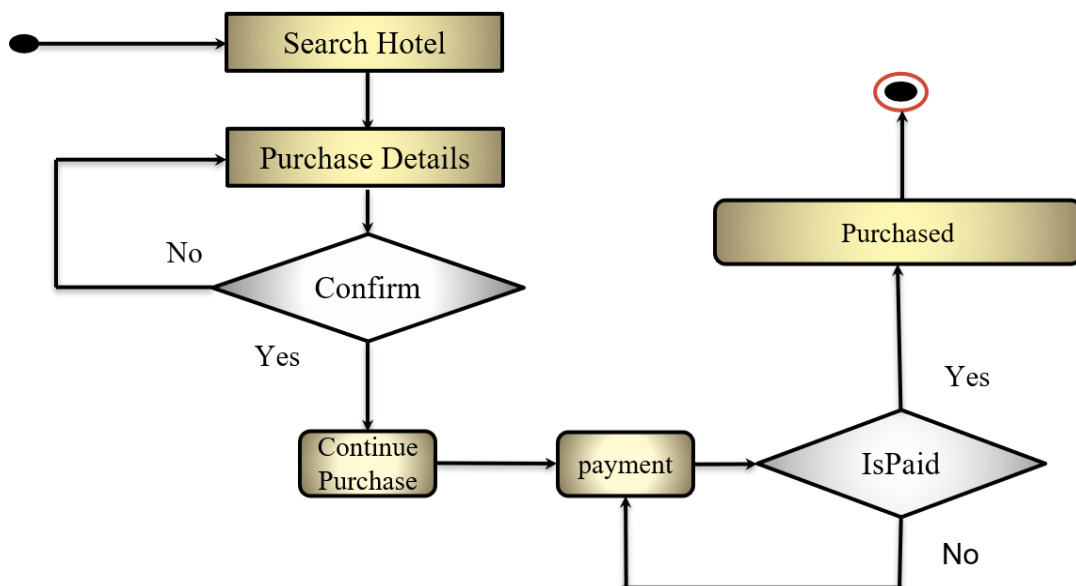


Figure 14: Booking Hotel

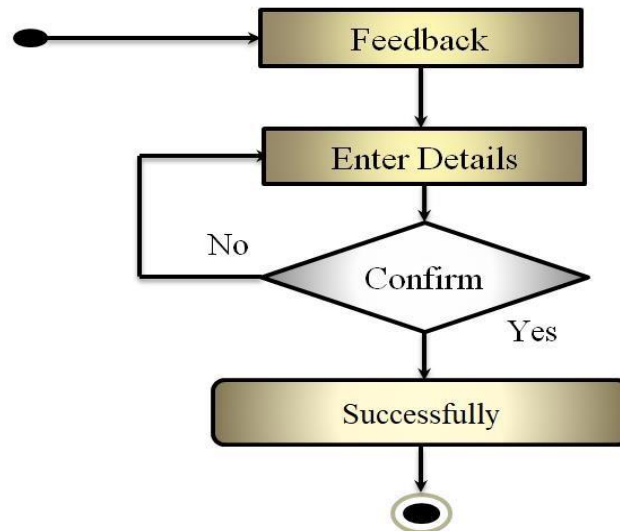


Figure 15: User Feedback

Upon selecting the logout option, the system ends the user's current session, clearing any active session data. A confirmation message may be displayed to confirm the successful logout.

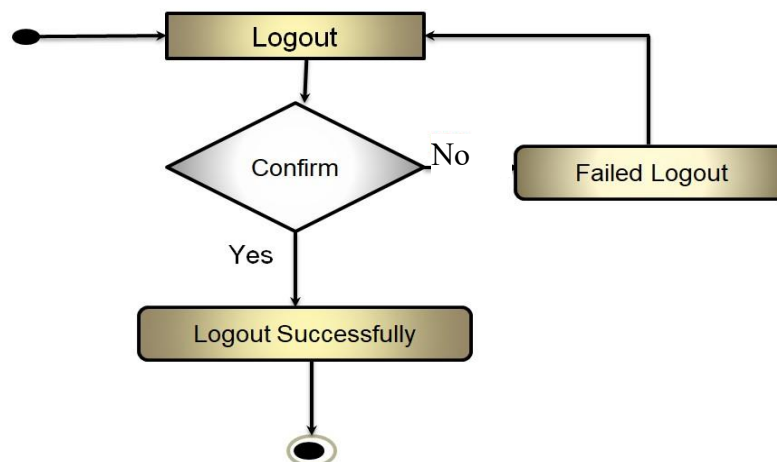


Figure 16: Logout

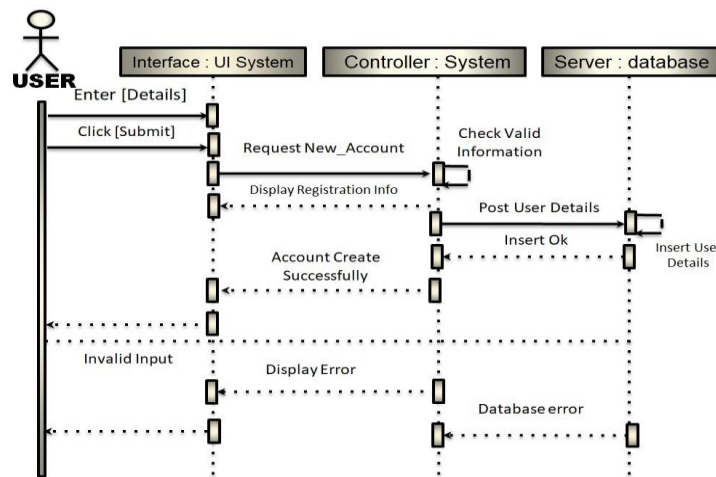


Figure 17: Registration Sequence

The login sequence begins with the user entering their credentials on the login page. The system validates the credentials, granting access upon successful verification and redirecting the user to their dashboard or designated landing page.

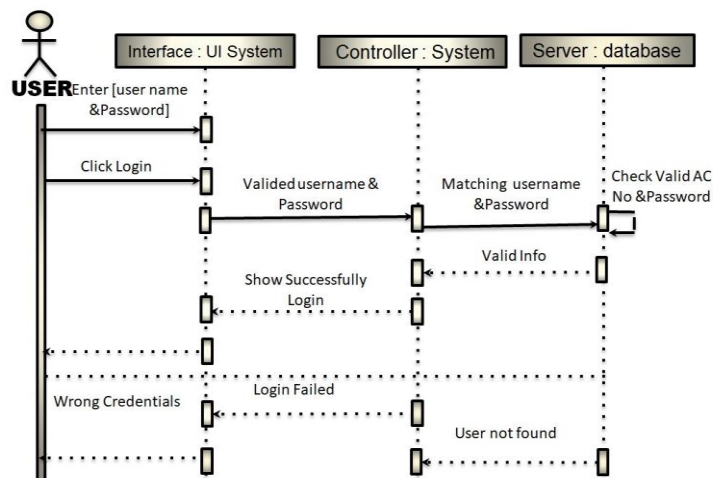


Figure 18: Login Sequence

The user initiates profile updating by entering new details. The system validates and updates the profile, confirming the changes to the user upon successful completion.

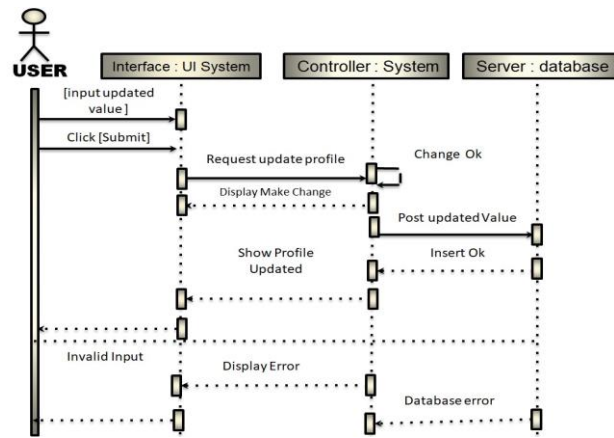


Figure 19: Update Profile Sequence

The user initiates property addition by entering details like address and type. The system validates and adds the property to the database, confirming the addition to the user upon completion.

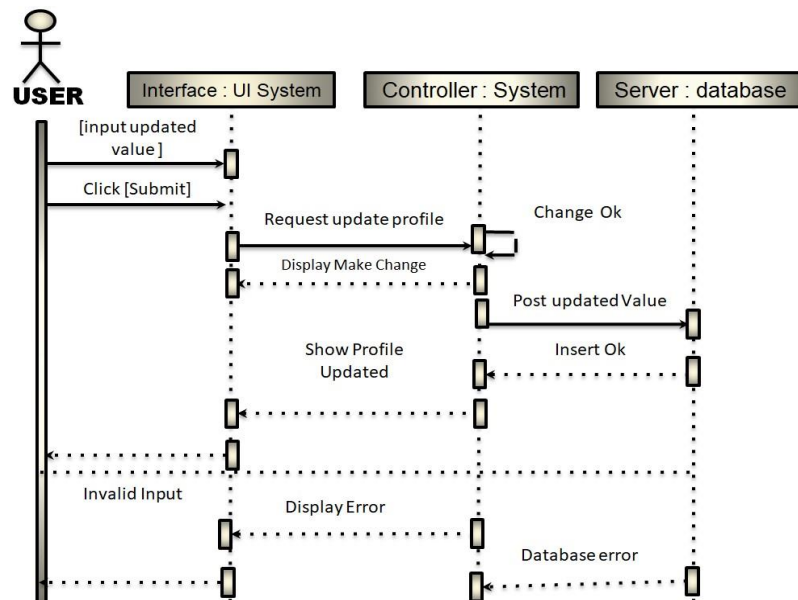


Figure 20: Add Properties Sequence

The user selects a schedule to remove from their list. The system verifies and deletes the schedule upon user confirmation, providing a confirmation message after successful removal.

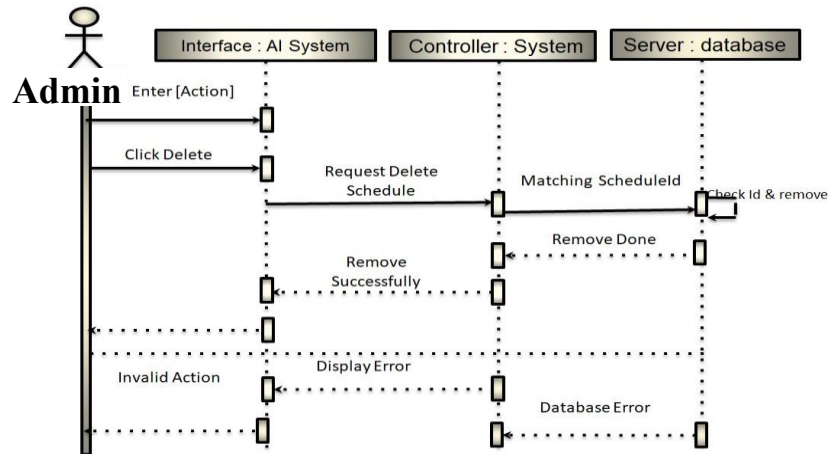


Figure 21: Remove Schedule Sequence

The user initiates ticket booking by selecting travel details and preferences. The system checks availability, reserves the ticket if available, and confirms the booking with details provided to the user.

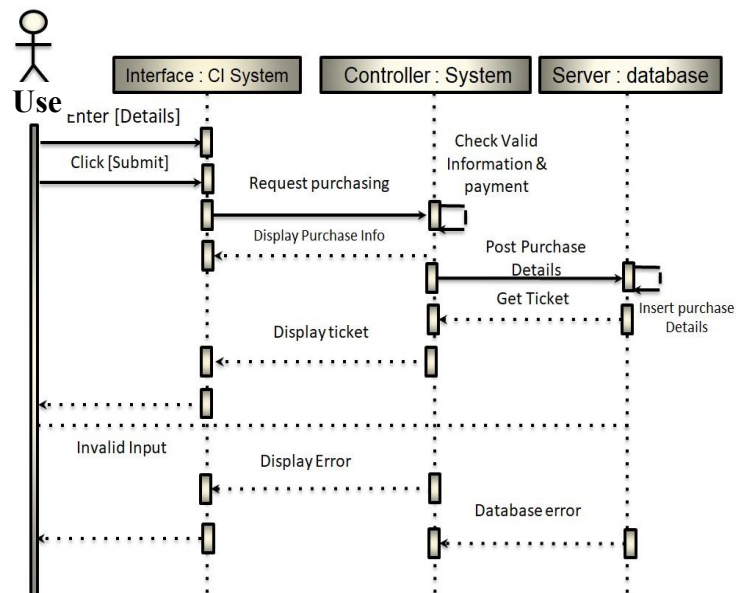


Figure 22: Booking Ticket Sequence

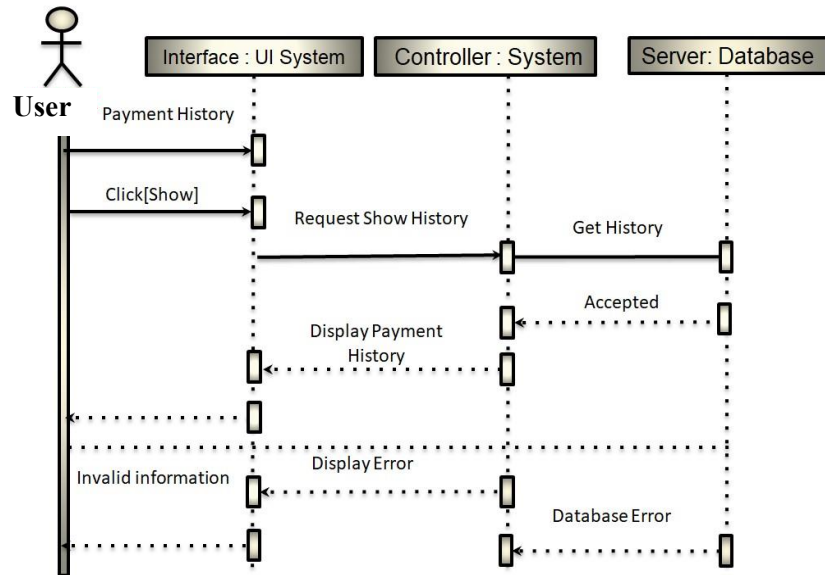


Figure 23: Payment History Sequence

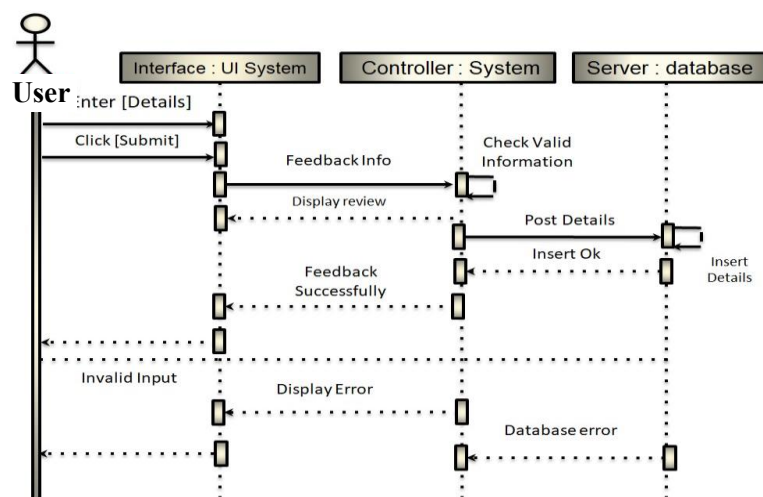


Figure 24: User Feedback Sequence

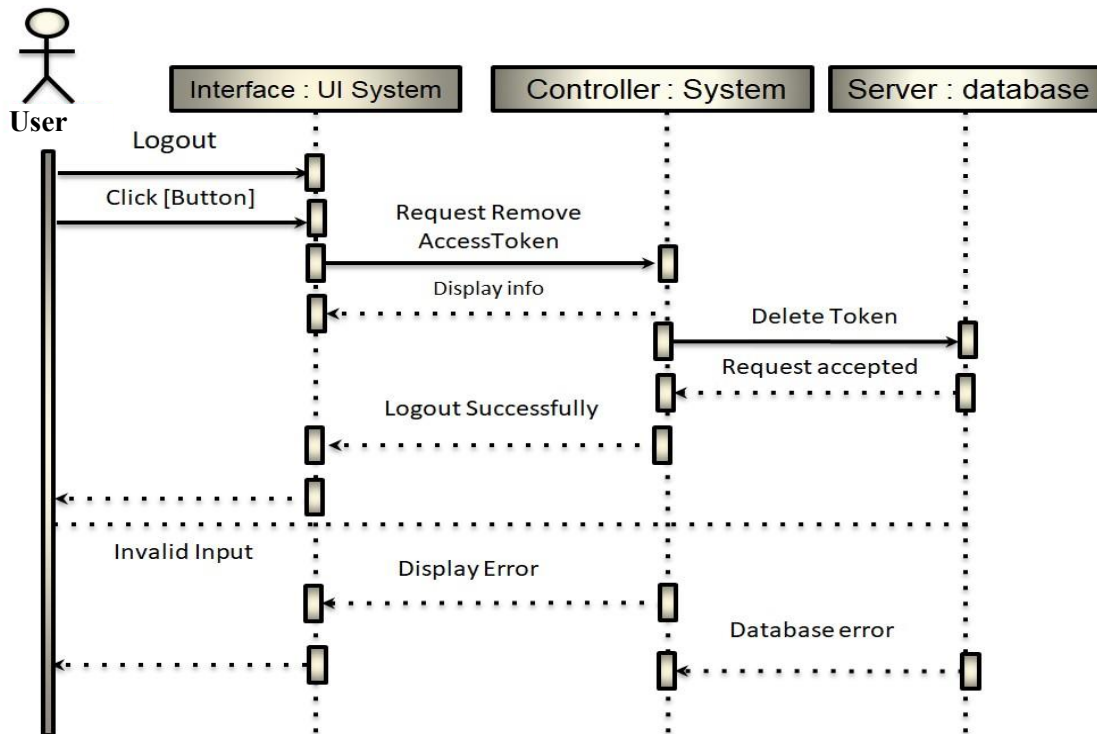


Figure 25: Logout Sequence

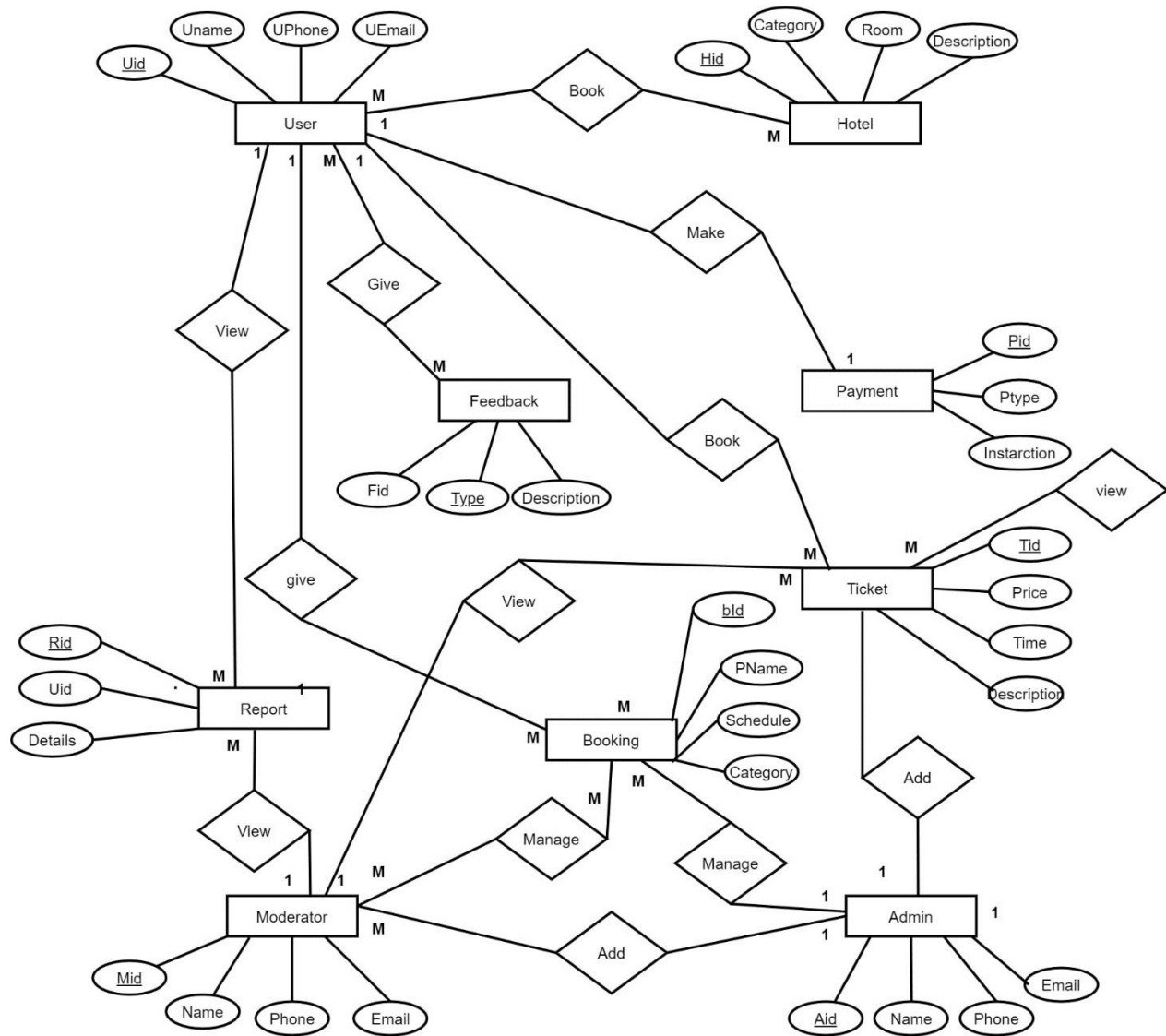


Figure 26: Er

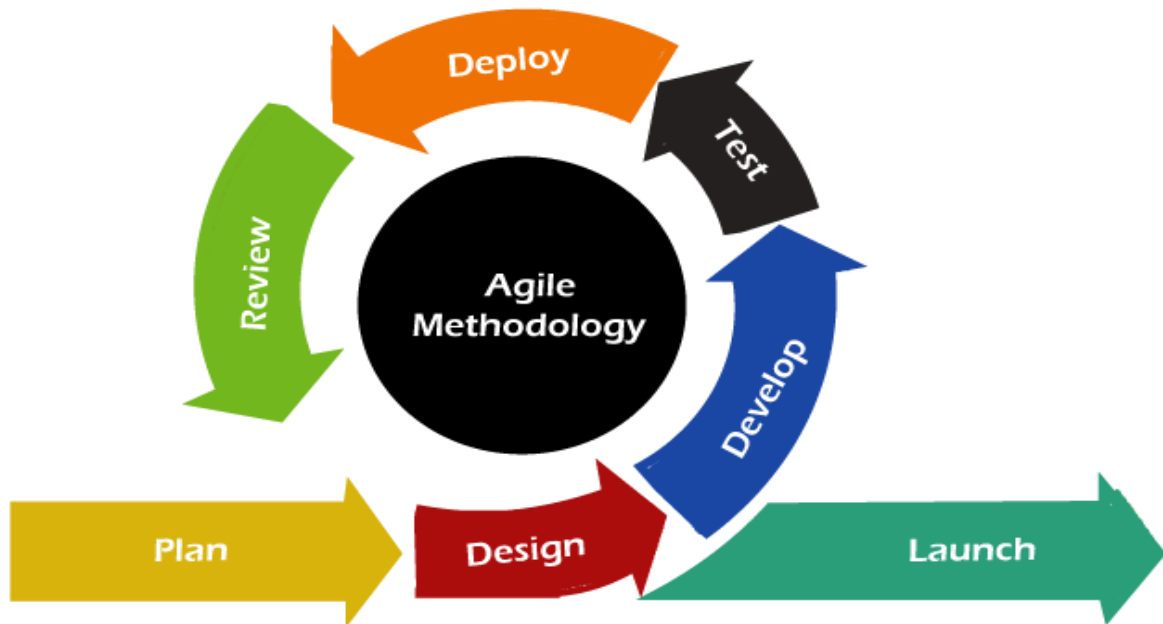


Figure 27: Agile Model

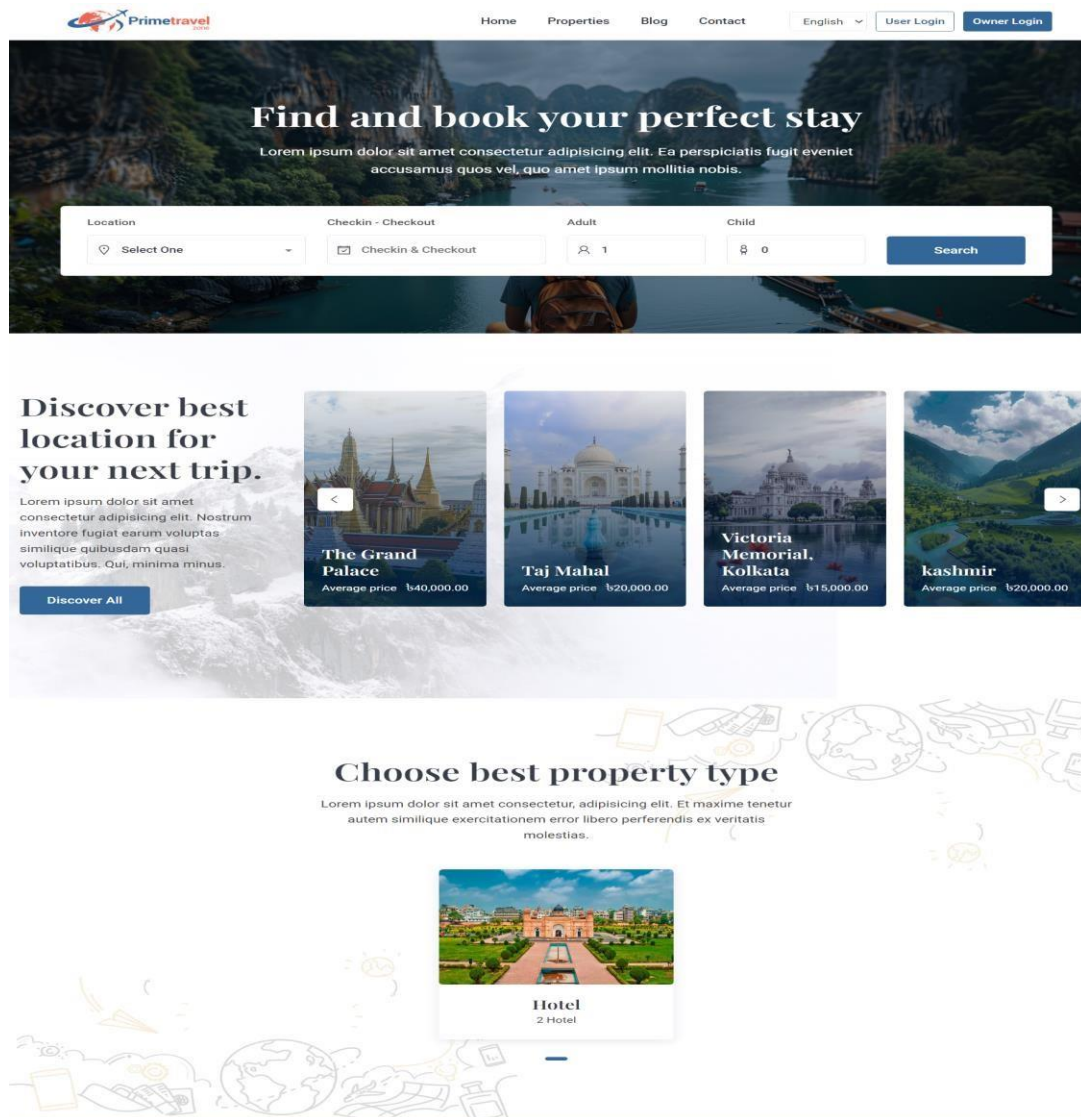


Figure 28: Home Page

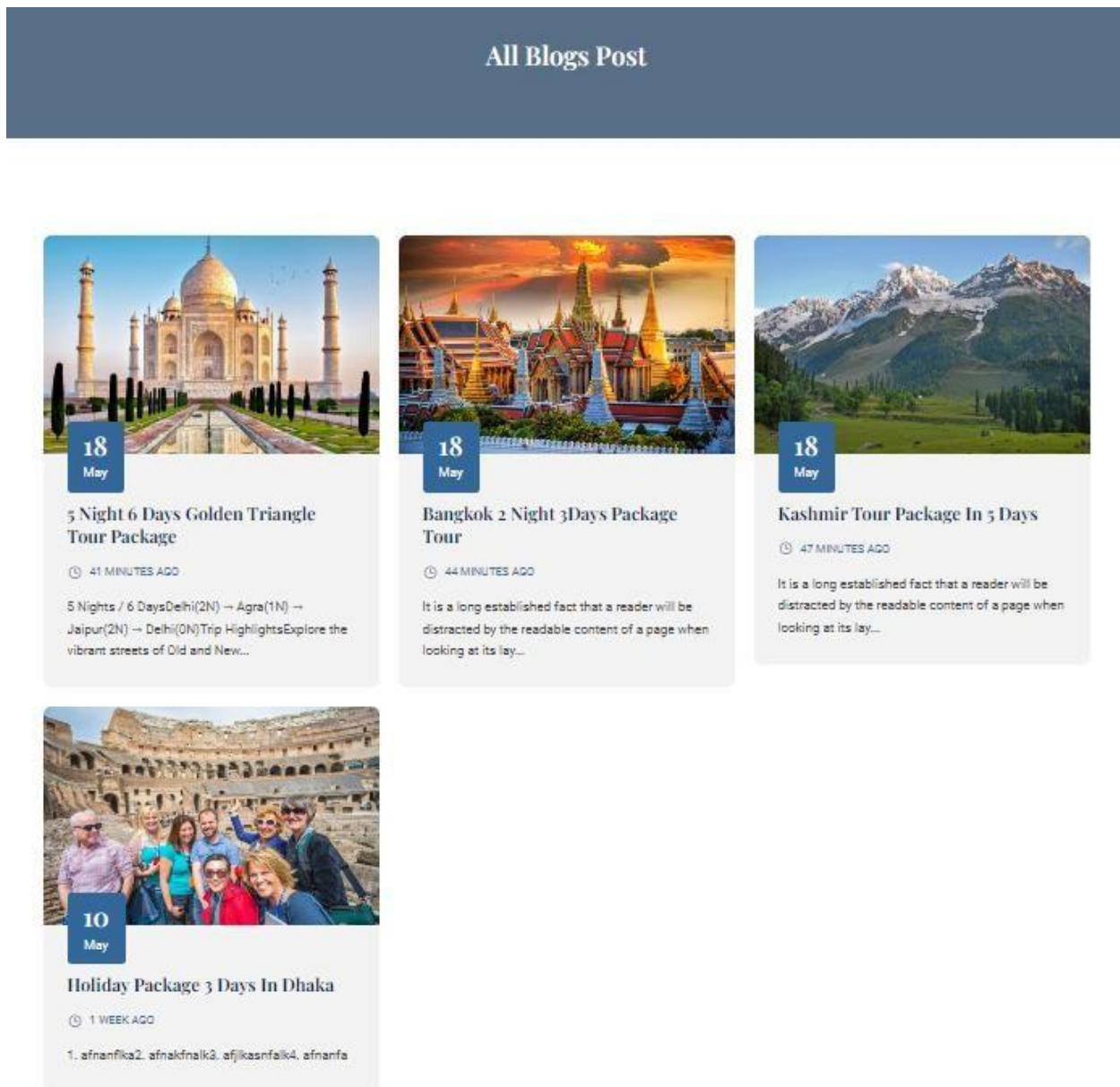


Figure 31: Blog

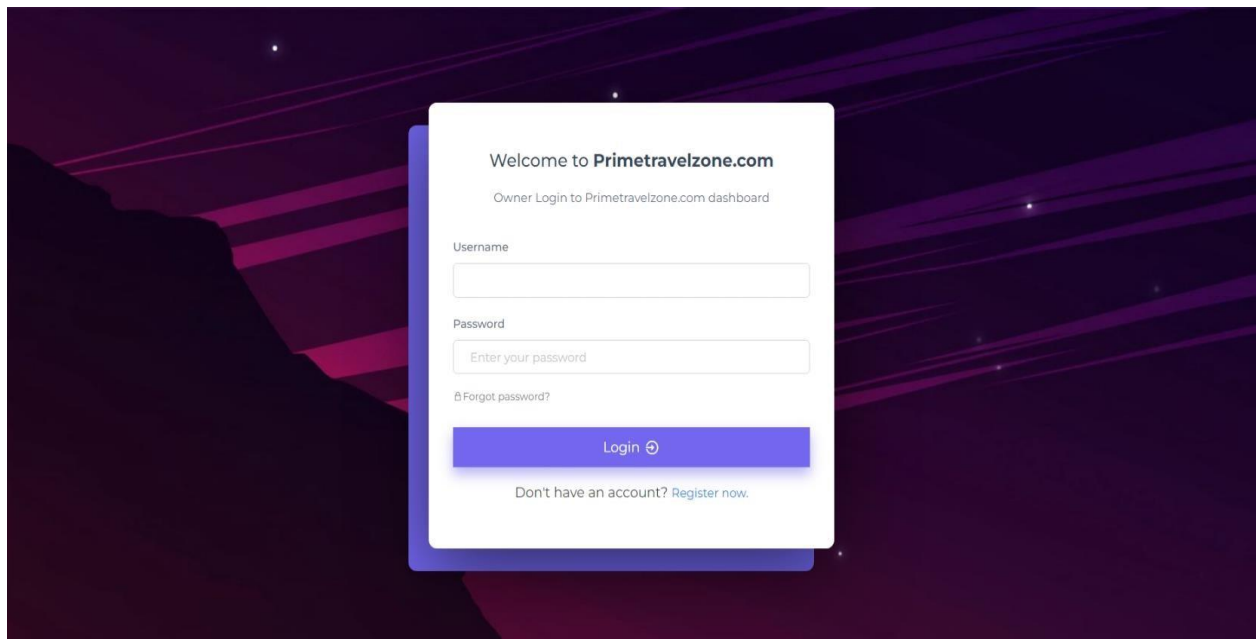

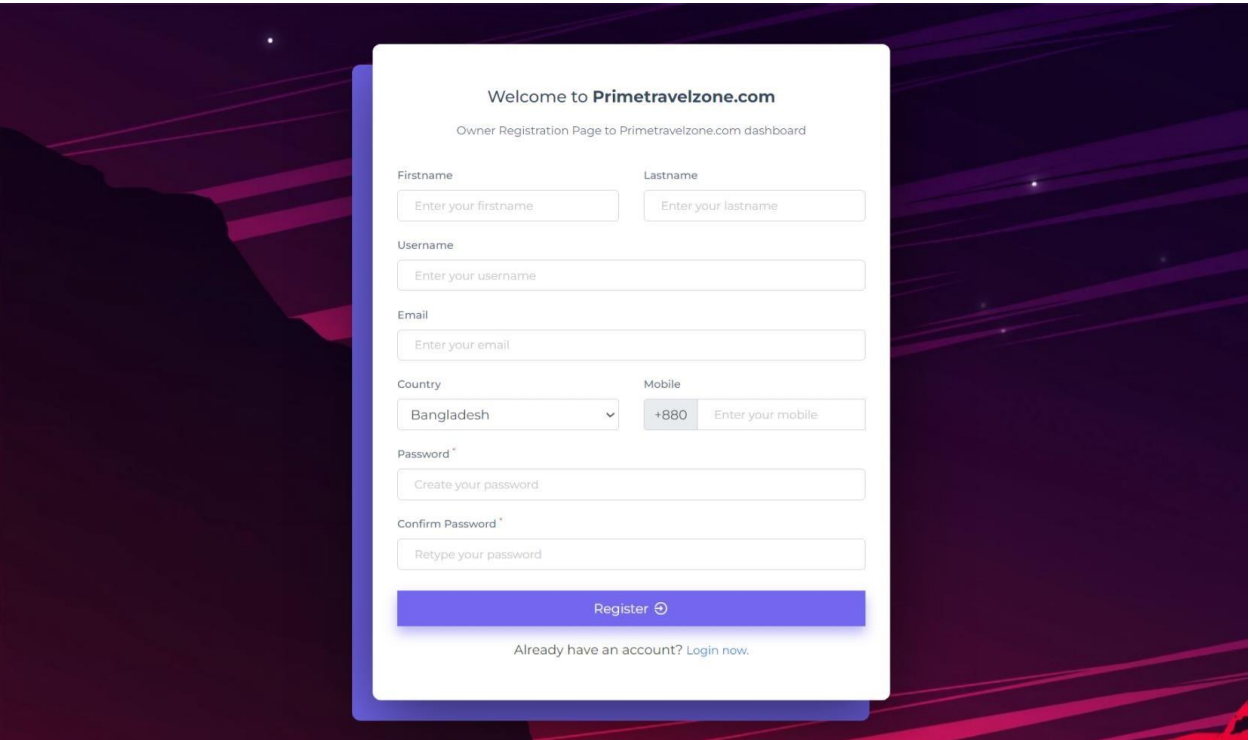

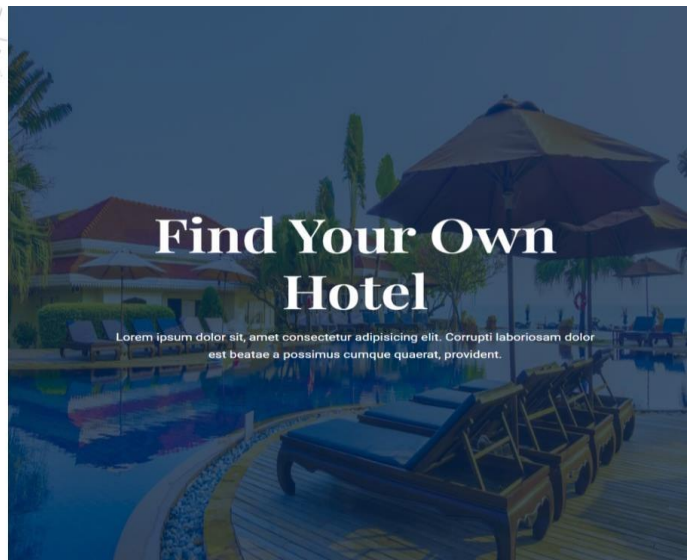


Figure 36: Registration

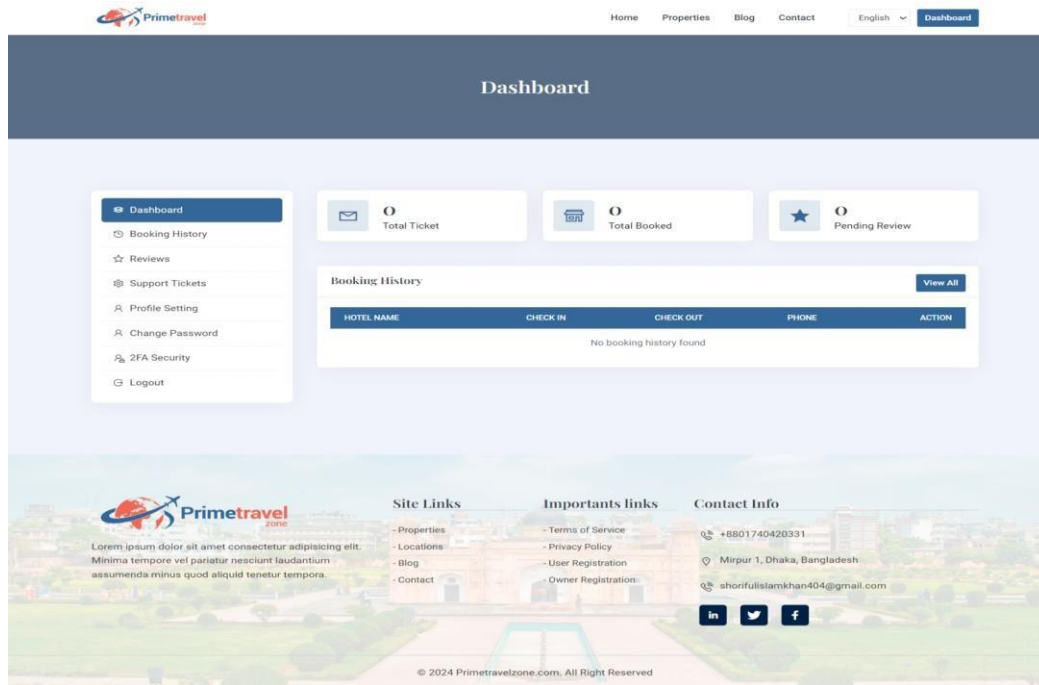


Figure 37: User Dashboard

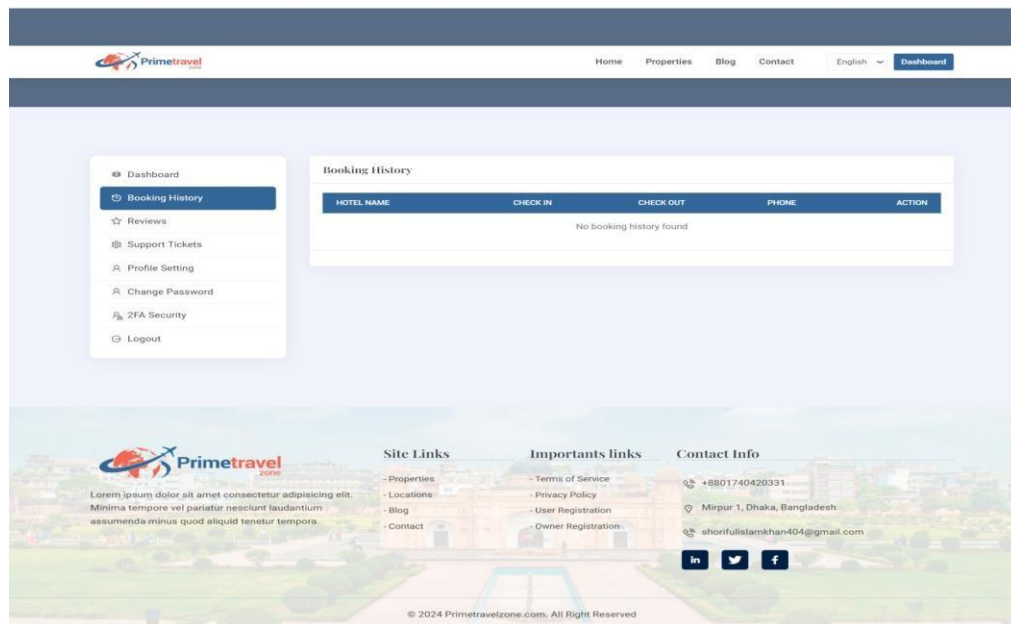


Figure 38: Booking History

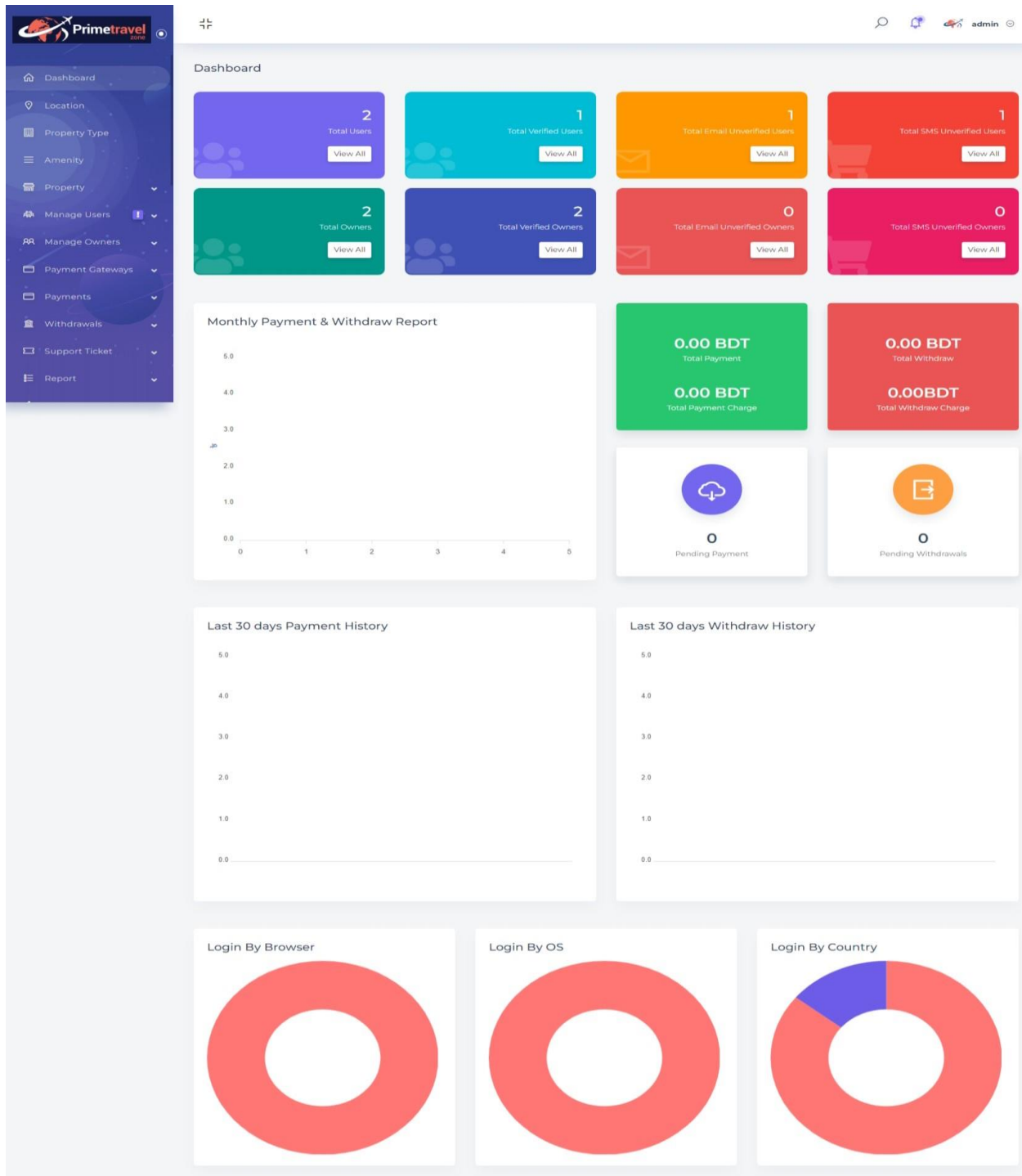


Figure 39: Admin Dashboard
