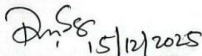

Chapter Three

Learning and Experience

3.1 Activities During Internship Period

At my internship, i had a daily schedule in the office Monday through Friday, from 10:00am to 06:00pm, regarding work in the multimedia sector and in the news desk. before carrying out my reporting work, i was given a roster the previous day, and i followed that roster to complete my assignments on time. where my key responsibilities included going to the field to collect video footage, then using that footage to create package reports on office. I also worked at the desk to prepare desk reports based on assigned topics and newsroom requirements. I worked extra hours when needed to meet deadlines or complete urgent news coverage.

Week:1 (September 1 to September 7 2025)

Activities: First week after joining, I observed daily office activities I tried to match my academic learning with real field and newsroom work. The newsroom in-charge explained the newsroom policies and rules to me. I was informed about my assigned duties and responsibilities. I started following instructions and preparing myself for regular newsroom tasks.

Learnings: I understood the difference between academic learning and newsroom policy. I also learned how newsroom works is completed step by step, and how the newsroom works together to prepare and publish reports. i also learn about news bulletin.

Week:2 (September 8- September 14, 2025)

Activities: In-charge explained multimedia equipment maintenance. I was guided on how to speak during Facebook Live and how to connect to the PCR through a phone. I was given an idea about how the news bulletin runs in the newsroom. I learn how to write a desk report in newsroom

Learning: From these activities, I learned how to properly use and maintain multimedia equipment. I also learned how to speak clearly and confidently during Facebook Live sessions, and how to connect to the PCR smoothly using a mobile phone for live updates. In addition, I understood the basic process of how a news bulletin is produced and how the newsroom team works together to run it successfully.

Weak:3(September 15- September 21)

Activities: During Durga Puja, I went to the field with the camera person and did live coverage. I wrote OV and SOT. During office duty, I edited and corrected the OV/SOT scripts sent by reporters before final submission.

Learning: Through these, I acquired the ability to confidently operate in actual field assignments, particularly within a major event such as Durga Puja. The lessons learned include the techniques to coordinate with the camera man, handle live switching, as well as remain composed despite working under time pressure. The ability to write OV and SOT effectively helps me to communicate the ideas within a simpler format, allowing viewers to easily comprehend the story. In the aspect of office duties, the correction of OV/SOT within reports enables me to identify mistakes and solve them efficiently among the reporters, including understanding the significance of newsroom standards before the actual broadcast.

Weak: 4 (September 22- September 28)

Activities: I participated in various daily activities for news. It was the first time I had the chance to sit down with the news presenter to go over the news with him. On the matter of our office discussions, I personally gained a better understanding of my contribution after our editor discussed the assignments of everyone in the room.

Learning: Through this, I gained experience in reporting the occurrences of the day in an even more organized and professional fashion. I understood how to gauge the crucial news part, gather necessary information, and put all of this information in an honest, truthful way. The first experience of having a news show to sit in on with the news presenter really opened my eyes to how news show content is checked before going out, and how the minute aspects of news show delivery, such as wordage, tone, and sequence of information, mean such a huge amount. Through office meetings, by watching the editor go through every one of our reports, I had a deep understanding of my strengths and weaknesses, making me even more meticulous, confident, and honest in my reporting and preparation of information.

Week 5 (29 September – 4 October)

Activities In most cases, I was assigned to the field as a trainee multimedia reporter. I reported live events that occurred daily. I composed reports on packages.

Learning: During the course of this week, I was able to learn the techniques of actively participating in multimedia reporting since I was in the field for a longer period of time. I was able to learn live reporting for day-to-day happenings and the timing aspect of carrying out my tasks outside the newsroom. At the same time, my writing techniques enhanced since I was able to develop package reports, which helped me to comprehend the techniques of structuring the information, the news focus, and effectively communicating the message to the audience. Consequently, this particular week enhanced my self-confidence when it came to multimedia reporting.

Week 6 (5 October – 10 October)

Activities: I was assigned to cover the programs of various political parties. I focused on content making. had been covering the Shahbag movement, providing live updates from there.

Learning: This week, I learned how to report on political matters in an expert and professional manner. What struck me is the fact that news reporting, especially in politics, must first and foremost involve accuracy, objectivity, and rigorous fact-checking. I gained expertise on how to extract key statements, pick the most relevant news angle, and report news in an objective and balanced fashion. Reporting live in Shahbag has also shown me how important it is to remain composed, articulate, and deliver updates in real-time without losing important details.

Week 7 (11 October – 17 October)

Activities: I have written OV stories for news bulletins. I have handled HSC result-based news stories. I dispatched pictures of students' movement to the office

Learning: This week, I understood how preparing bulletin news is done, as well as why writing concise is very significant when it comes to writing TV online bulletins. Doing OV work helped me acquire experience of writing the news in a concise way, discussing nothing but essential information. Writing about SSC Results helped me learn how to write about significant issues occurring in our country by getting proper reactions from the field. Transmitting photos and spot updates to the newsroom enhanced my efficiency, as well as learning how to convey information within a short span of time so that essential news is published considering deadlines.

Week 8 (18 October – 25 October)

Activities: coverage about a fire incident that happened in the Cargo Village area near the airport. I learned how to send information to the newsroom in cases of emergency and did it. I stayed at the airport all day for follow-up reporting. I sent scripts for a package news report.

Learning:

During this week, I was able to learn how to work during an emergency and report responsibly under pressure. Covering a fire incident taught me how to reach the spot fast, understand the scenario, and give live clear updates. I learned during an emergency, how correct and speedy

information should be relayed to the newsroom so the desk team could urgently update the audience without wasting any time. Staying for follow-ups all day helped me to realize the worth of continuous reporting and exactly how a story evolves with time. Writing and sending in package scripts allowed me to organize details accordingly, verify updates, and give a full report in a simple and effective manner.

Week 9 (26 October – 2 November)

Activities: I wrote content for a business entity called “Sanda Bakery.” I wrote desk reports based on global news. I covered the Tourism Fair on a reporting business trip. I reported on a political party's press conference.

Learning: This week, I had an opportunity to work on various types of news, which helped me in being versatile as a journalist. Sanda Bakery gave me training on how planning for a story before seeking visuals and facts, then packaging the story in an appealing manner can help in gaining attention. Writing the report for the international desk gave me training in conducting research work and how to write in an impeccable manner, considering accurate data. Attending the Tourism Fair for writing a business report helped me in learning how to write business news, which is highly useful in my life. It mainly consists of extracting facts, quotes, and statements, along with graphics. Covering the political press conference has given me an opportunity to extract the essence in no time and write a report according to the newsroom.

Week 10 (3 November – 8 November)

Activities: I covered a press conference held by the Election Commission. I developed news content. I did the overVOICE/sound on tape for the news bulletin. I attended newsroom meetings where everyone's work was discussed.

Learning : During this week, I have learned how coverage of official press conferences is performed, why it is very important to collect information at such events accurately and to verify it. Writing OV/SOT for bulletins helped me further in summarizing the key points in a short and clear way. Creating news content strengthened my understanding of structuring stories according

to newsroom standards. By joining meetings, I learned how newsroom planning works, how decisions are made, and how teamwork and discussion raise the overall quality of news content.

Week 11 (9 November – 15 November)

Activities: reporting on a murder incident in Old Dhaka. I have experience in "Content Making." The main Live coverage of day-to-day occurrences was my contribution. I transmitted OV/SOT to the newsroom.

Learning : I was able to learn about news reporting involving sensitive and grave subjects such as crime reporting. I was able to learn through doing news reporting of a murder case that the relevance of being accurate, accountable, and responsible in news reporting. I was also able to learn through doing live news reporting that my confidence level boosted because of practice, and I was able to learn about news reporting by regularly submitting OV/SOT that my speed and accuracy in typing are enhanced along with understanding news flow.

Week 12 (16 November – 22 November)

Activities: given live coverage during a tense situation in the Dhanmondi area on the judgment day of Sheikh Hasina. I wrote news packages. I did live reporting from the PCR assigned area. I sent my own OV/SOT, along with statements from the Commissioner of Police. I took pictures of the damage and mailed them in.

Learning: One of the most important things that I have learned this week is how to function in tense and sensitive environments. While doing live reporting during unrests, I was able to learn the ability to remain composed and focused on facts. While doing the news packages, I was able to learn the skill of constructing a comprehensive report from events that are constantly developing. While doing the live reporting from a location that has been assigned to me by the PCR, I was able to learn the skill of coordination with the control room. While doing the dissemination of the OV/SOT and official messages together with the photos, has taught me how to back up my story with good visuals and credible sources. Indeed, this has remarkably improved my confidence, responsibility, and professionalism as a field reporter.





3.2 Internship Experience at jagonews24.com

Over the course of my 12-week internship at Jago News, I learnt a lot of new things. This experience was very significant for me. Before doing this internship, I knew a few things about news but not how a real newsroom functions. I got to see the real workflow of online news at Jago News. I found out that news work has to be fast and it has to be correct. Although speed is vital, accuracy matters more than speed.

I gained insight into how the newsroom works. The newsroom is always busy. Human beings form a team. All have jobs and due dates. I understood how news is planned and how work is assigned. The assignment editor gives out assignments and guides the team. The assignment editor taught me a good way to communicate with them clearly and politely. When I received an assignment, I tried to comprehend the topic well. Whenever I was confused, I asked questions. I finished the task after that and updated the editor. I learned to become organized while doing work and manage time efficiently too.

I learned to write OV scripts during my internship. I learned how to write in a straight forward style. The main point must be given first in OV. The vocabulary should be simple to comprehend. I was able to learn how to write a strong beginning, how to keep the story smooth, and how to end it properly. I learned how to take away unnecessary words so the script becomes short and strong. My writing skills witnessed improvement because of this.

I learnt how to package news write as well. A package story is a complete news item. Step by step, I learned how to write a news story. I gained knowledge on how to include the news background, the essential facts, and the key points. I also learnt to carefully use information and maintain balance in the story. I came to know that a good package news is about writing also. It's also about making the news simple for people to follow.

Providing live updates was an integral part of my internship. I discovered how a group can collaborate on one platform to provide live updates. In live work employees perform a task simultaneously.

Some people gather information; some write short updates while others help in other support work. I learned how to be self-composed in live coverage. I also learned that you have to be careful as a mistake can spread quickly. This segment taught me how to maintain focus while performing under pressure.

I also discovered how to converse with the group team. The news content is published and managed by the panel. I found out how to upload news packages, set titles, and write captions in the studio. Small things like the title and caption are very important. I learnt this! They assist individuals in rapidly understanding information. I have learned to check the content again before publishing so that there are no major errors.

I collaborated with news anchormen also. I came to know about it from the presenters. It must be easy to read and easy to speak. New information sometimes comes at the last moment. We must rapidly modify the script then. I learned to collaborate with a presenter and prepare the presentation content. This taught me that teamwork improves the quality of the news.

Through this internship, I understood the editorial policy of Jago News. I gained insight into the type of news that is deemed newsworthy and the rules that must be adhered to. The news must be responsible and fair, I learnt. News not to create confusion News should be based on accurate information and reliable sources. This helped me realise the significance of trust in journalism.

It was one of the most beneficial aspects to develop a great rapport with coworkers. People were attentive and kind. I received guidance from seniors when needed. They corrected my mistakes and taught me better techniques to do the work. I quickly learned and developed self-confidence because of them. My internship at Jago News was a great learning experience of mine. I acquired the skills to compose OV scripts, package news reports, and deliver live updates from a single platform along with my team. Through my training, I learned how to communicate with the assignment editor, the panel given to me, and more.

the new presenter I also acquired the values of discipline, team spirit, speed and accuracy. This internship enhanced my skill set and prepared me more for pursuing media and journalism as a career. I have learned many new things during my 12 weeks internship at Jago News. This was an extremely valuable experience for me. Before this internship, I knew some things related to the news but not how the actual news process works at any news website like Jago News. I was able to witness the actual process at Jago News. I learned that doing news means doing it quickly, yet it also means doing it right. However, it is more important to do it right than doing it quickly.

I learned how the newsroom operates. The newsroom is always full of activities. Human beings work as a team. Everyone has a responsibility. Everyone also has a deadline. I learned how news is organized. I also learned how work is assigned. The assignment editor is responsible for assigning work. The assignment editor taught me a proper method to communicate with him. When I got the assignment, I made an effort to understand it well. When I had some doubts, I asked questions. I completed the assignment after that. I learned how to be organized while carrying out the assignment. I also learned how to be efficient with time.

I learned skills that entail writing OV scripts from my internship experience. I gained skills to write in a straightforward manner. The central theme has to be expressed first in OV scripts. The language used should be easy to understand. The skills helped me to grasp the technique to write a compelling start, make the story flow smoothly, and conclude it effectively. Skills to eliminate unnecessary words to make a script brief and powerful are within my grasp now. I learnt to package news write as well. The package news story is a complete news item. I learned step by step on how to write a news story. I learned much on where to incorporate the news background, the key news facts, and key news points. I learned on where to use news information and news balance. I learned that to make good package news write, one should know that writing is part of package news.

Giving live updates was an essential part of my internship. I learned the way in which the whole group can contribute to live updates on the same platform. In live, workers of the company complete the same task together.

Some people gather info, while others write updates and some assist in other support functions. I learned how to stay self-composed in live broadcasting. Additionally, I learned that you should be keen as an error can quickly get out of hand. This particular segment has taught me how to stay focused when under pressure.

I was able to learn how to interact with the group team. The news output is published and maintained by the panel. I learned how to upload the news packages, title, and add captions in the studio. Even the title and the captions play very significant roles. This, I have learned. They help people to quickly grasp information. I have learned how to review my output before posting, making sure there are no significant mistakes.

I worked with news anchormen too. I learned about it from the anchormen. It has to be easy to read as well as easy to say. There are times when the new information comes up just before the event. We have to quickly change the script then. I learned how to work with the anchorman in preparing the presentation. I realized the importance of collaboration in improving the quality of the news. In this internship, I learned about the editorial policy used in Jago News. I gained knowledge on the kind of news considered worth publishing and the norms followed. News has to be responsible as well as fair, I learned. News not creating confusion News has to rely on true facts and authentic sources. This helped me comprehend the importance of credibility in news.

It was one of the most beneficial aspects that I was able to build a strong relation with my colleagues. They were listening and treating me well. I got guidance from my seniors when required. They corrected my faults and showed me better ways of performing my tasks. I learned quickly because of them and gained self-confidence.

Doing an internship at Jago News has been one of the biggest learning experiences I have ever had. I learned how to write scripts for OV, assemble news programs, and do live reports all from one platform and along with my colleagues. By training, I know how to communicate with the assignment editor, the panel of assignments assigned to me, and more. the new presenter aside

from that, I have learned the values of discipline, teamwork, speed, and accuracy. This internship increased my skill set and better prepared me to pursue 'media and journalism' as my future career.

7. Increasing explainer content that will keep viewers interested.

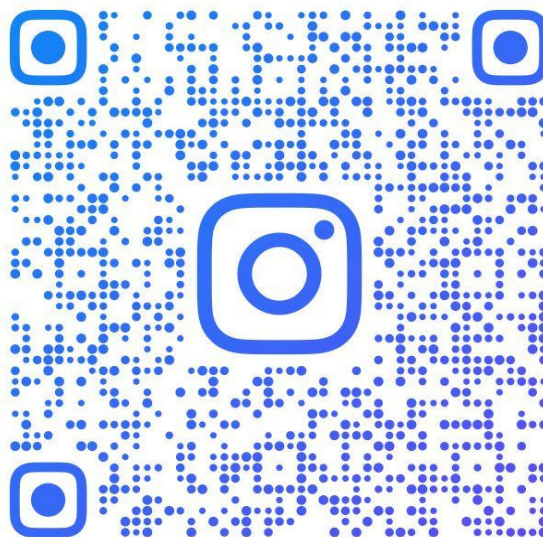

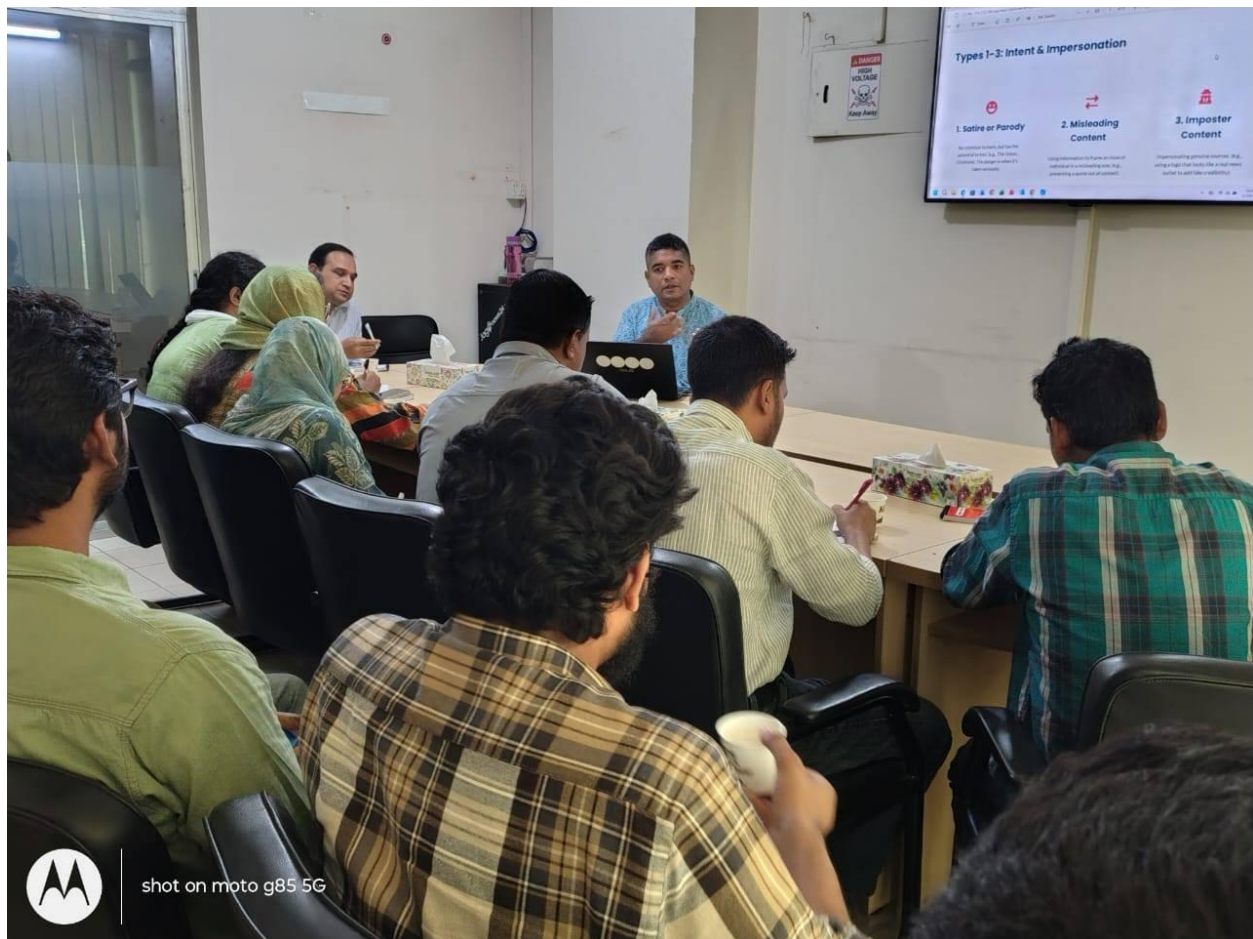
