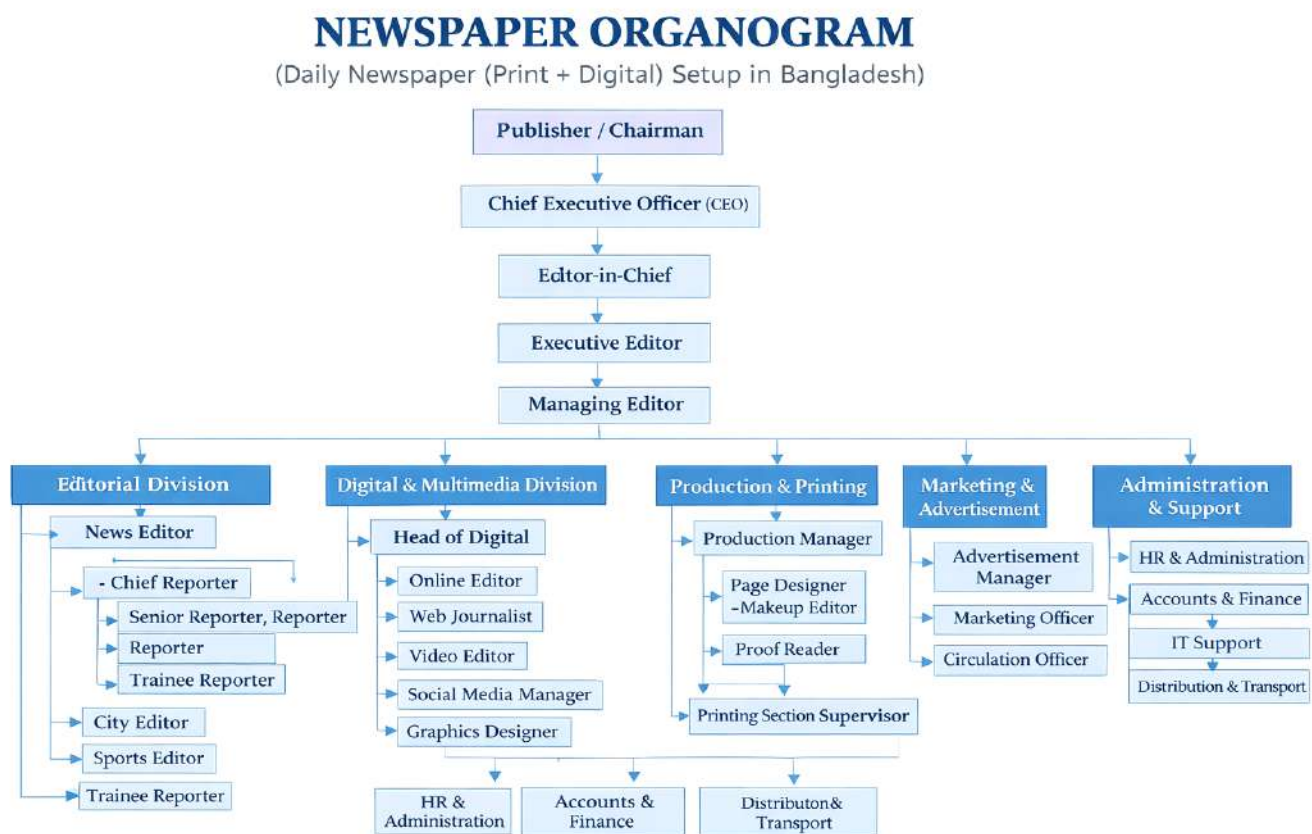
Chapter Two

4. Covered pre practice match press conference of Bangladesh football team.



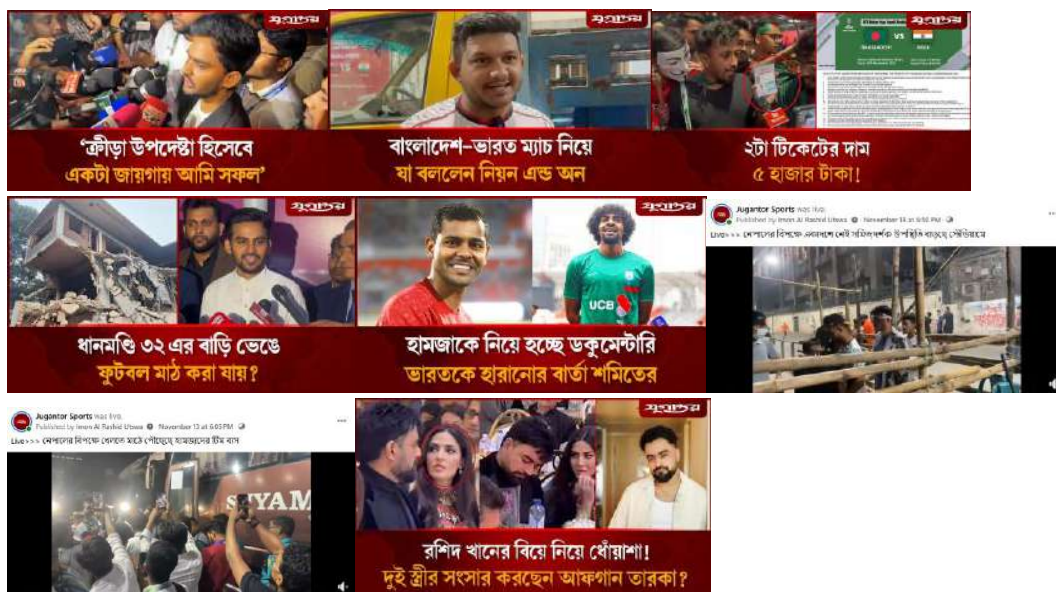

4.3 Limitations of The Internship Program At the daily Jugantor

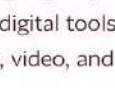

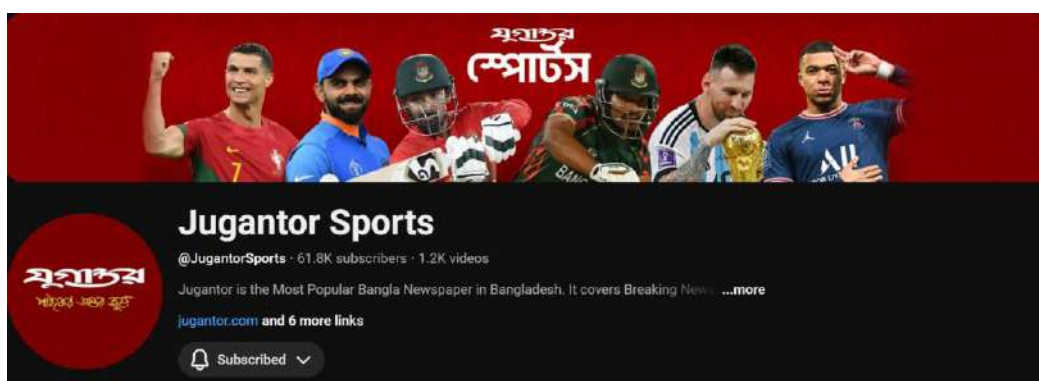
