User: Customers can use this application to visit or buy products from a bakery.

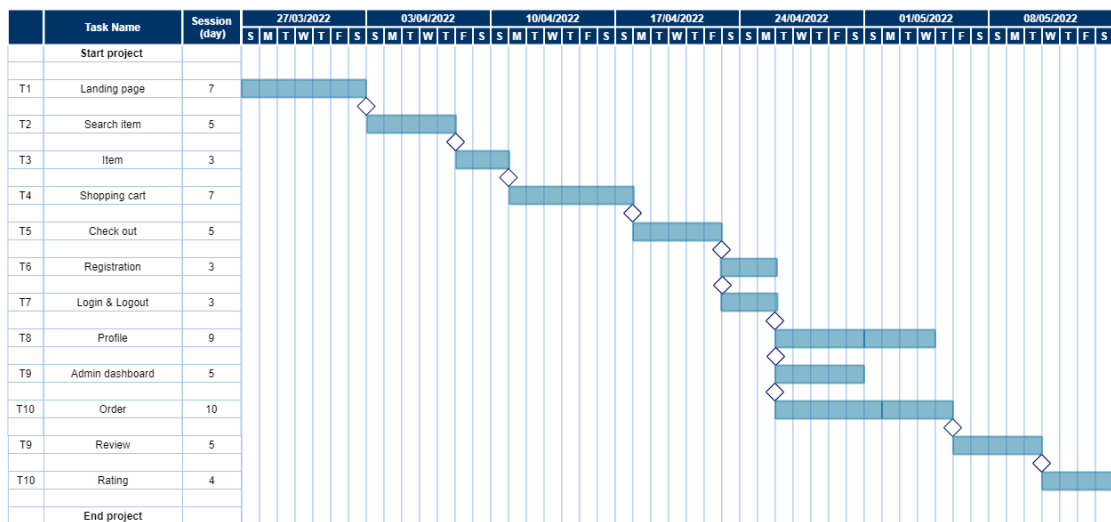

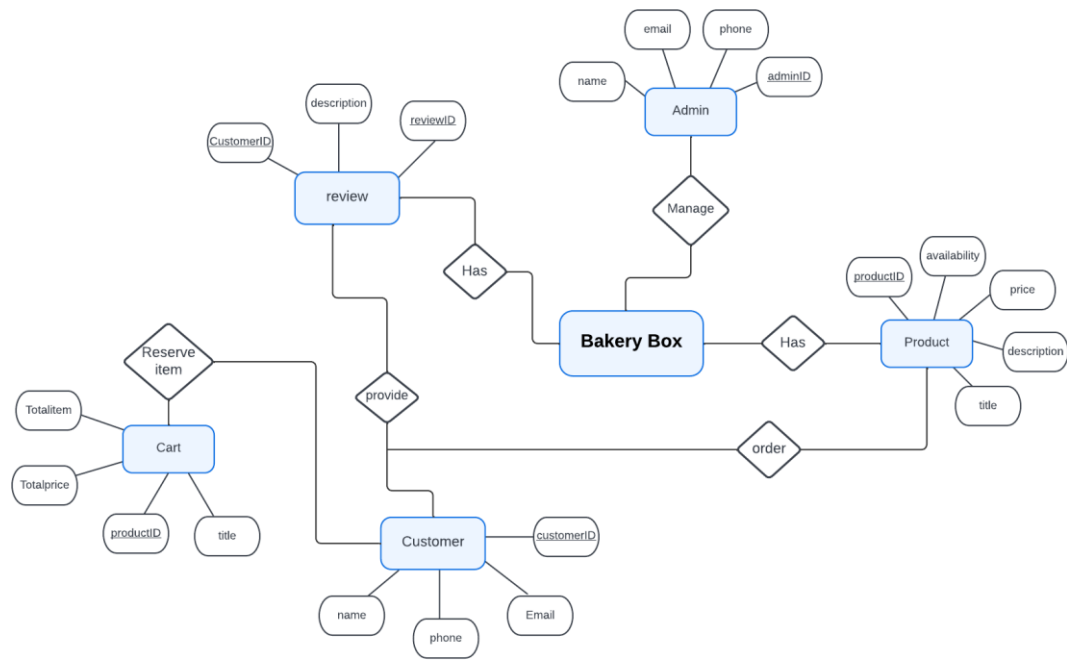

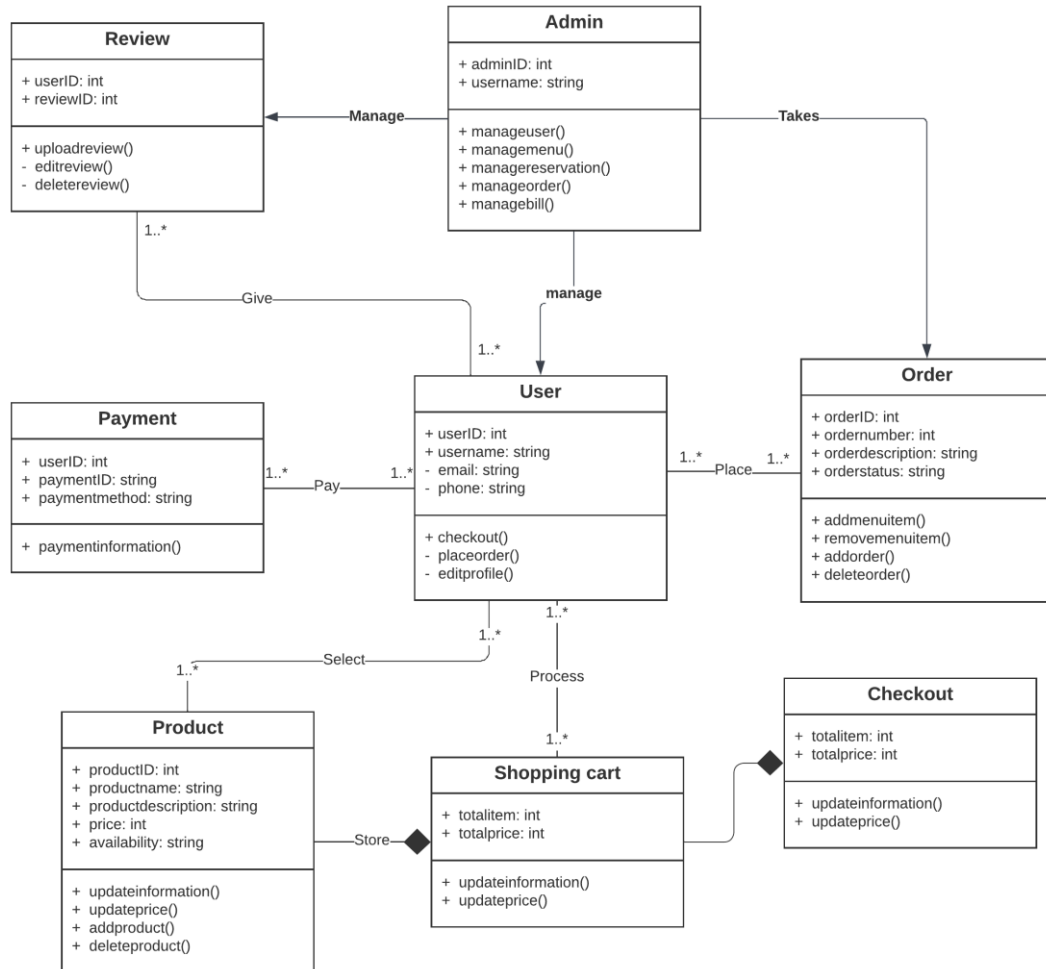
