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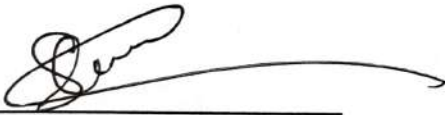

Business Process Model describes utilities of the project. In our project, most of the element illustrate, below given is the Business Process Model.

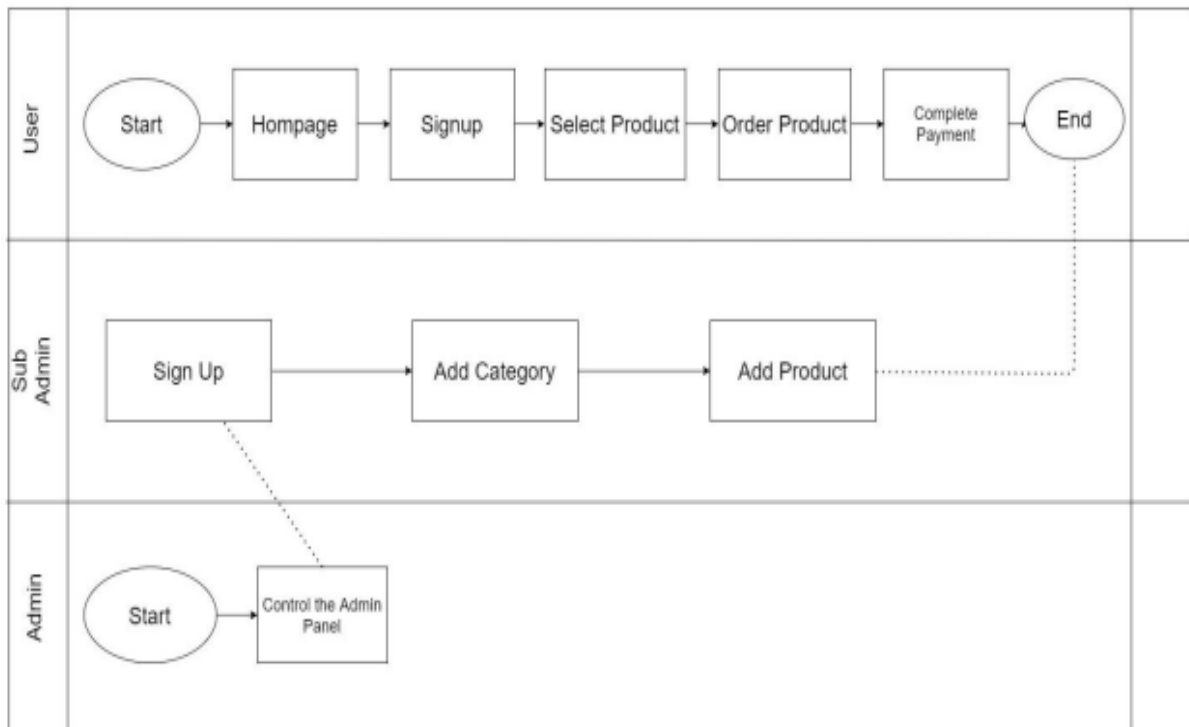


Figure 3.1: Business Process Model

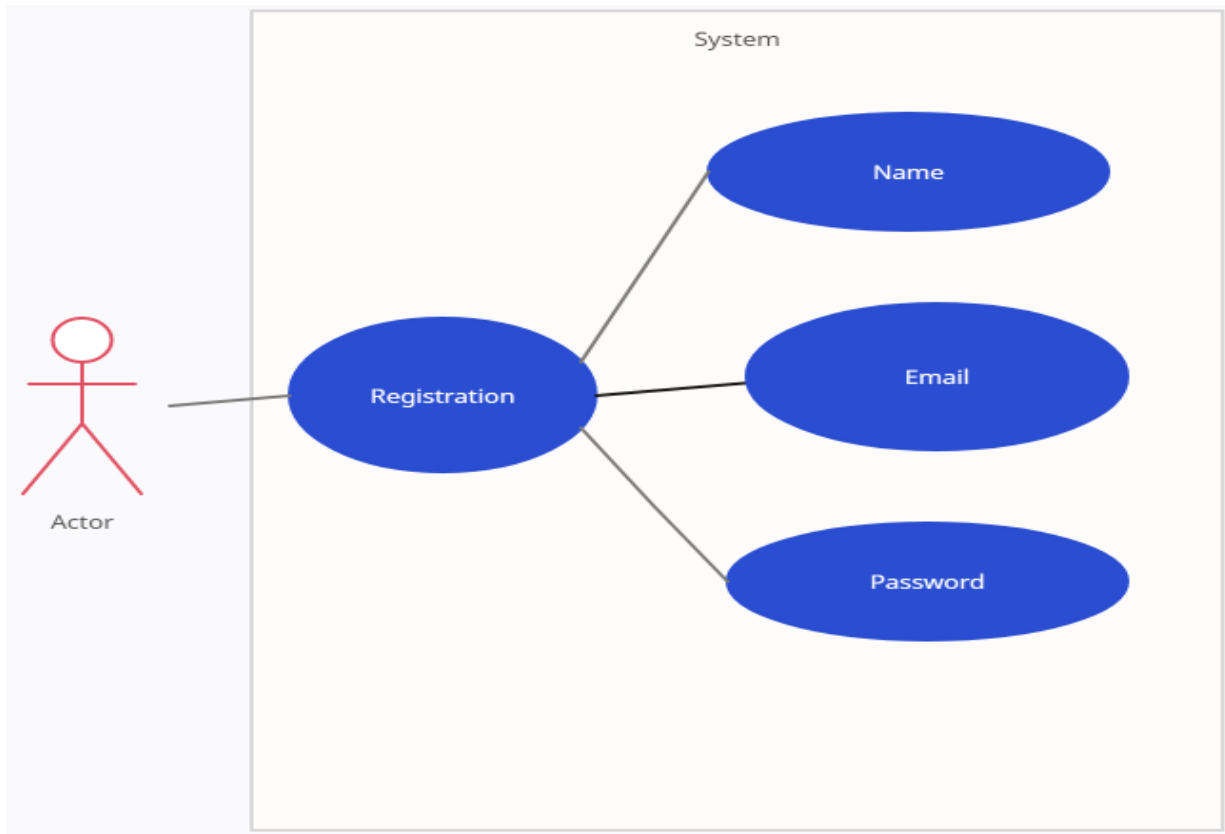


Figure 3.2: Use case diagram of Registration

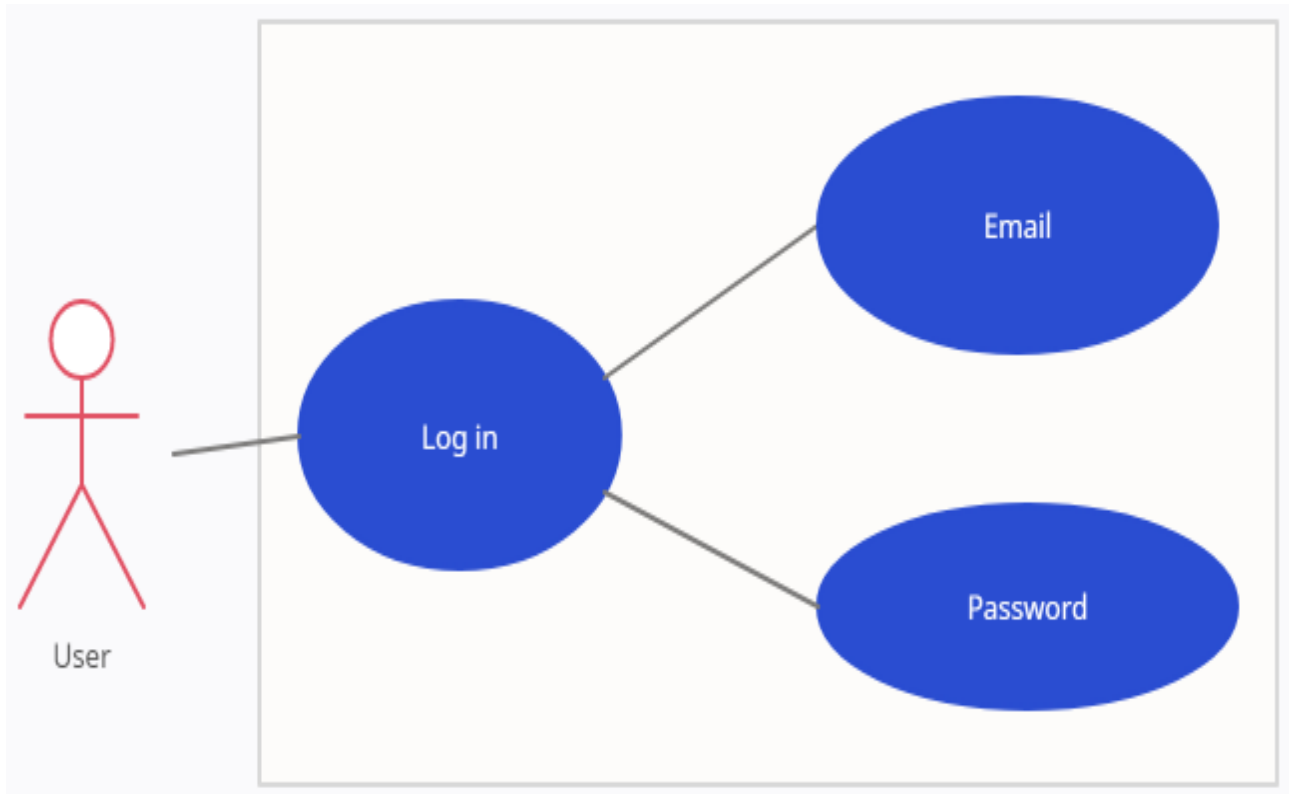


Figure 3.3: Use case diagram of log in

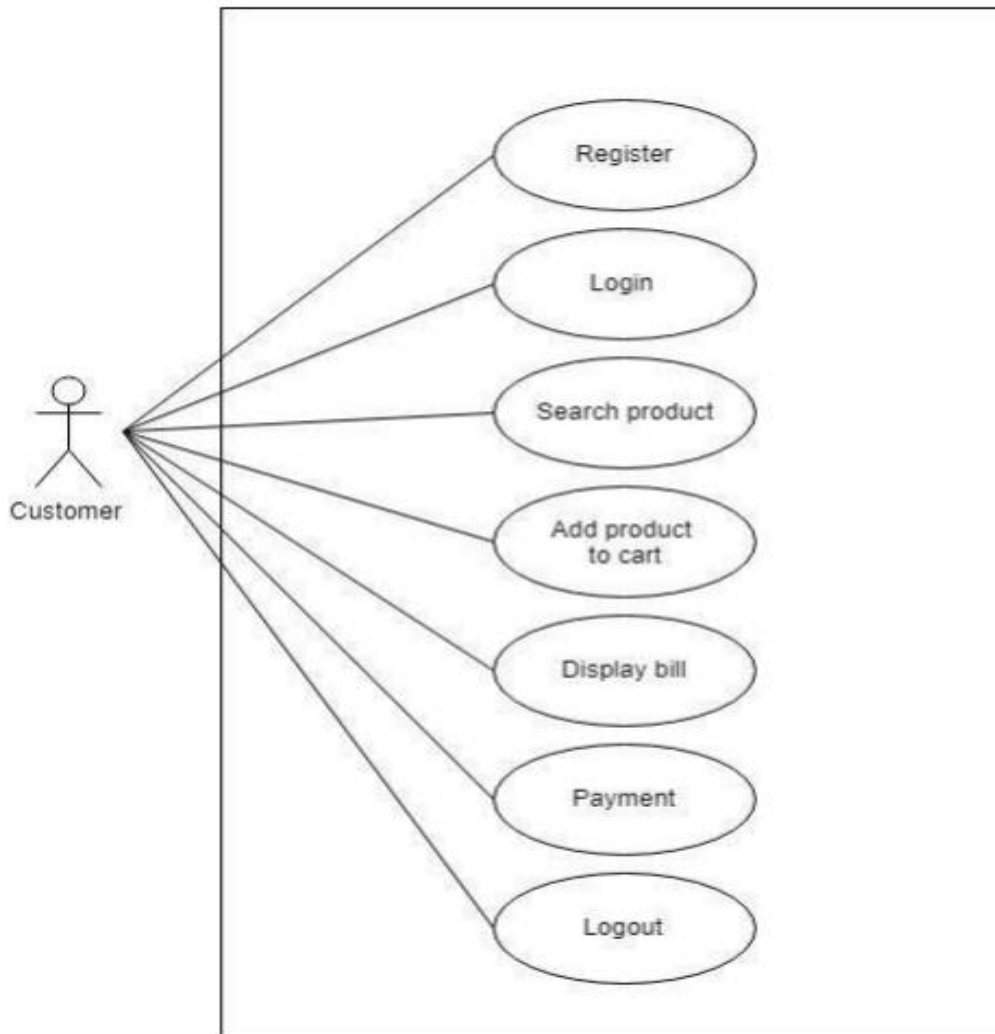


Figure: 3.5 Use Case Diagram for Customer

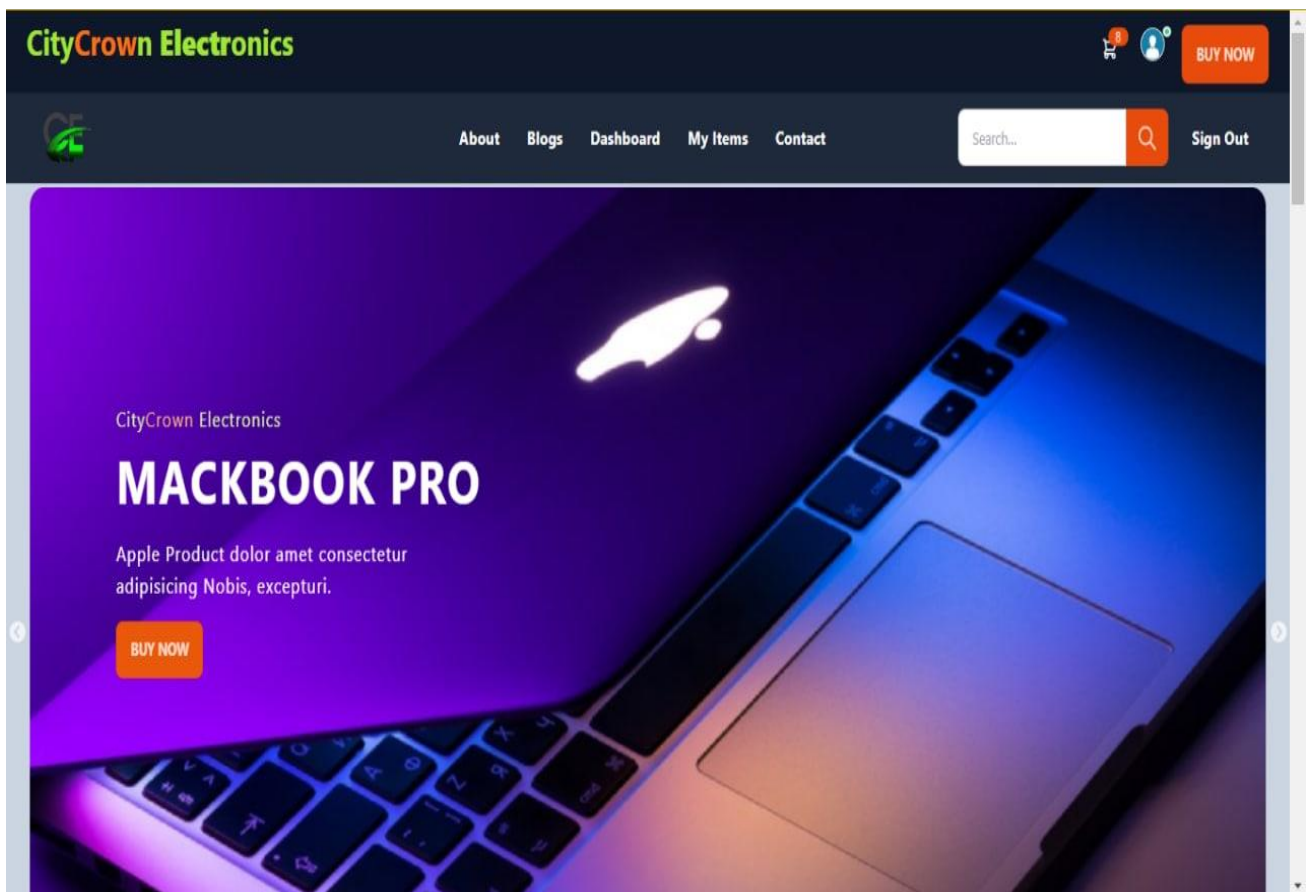


Figure 4.1: Front-end of CityCrown Ecommerce Website

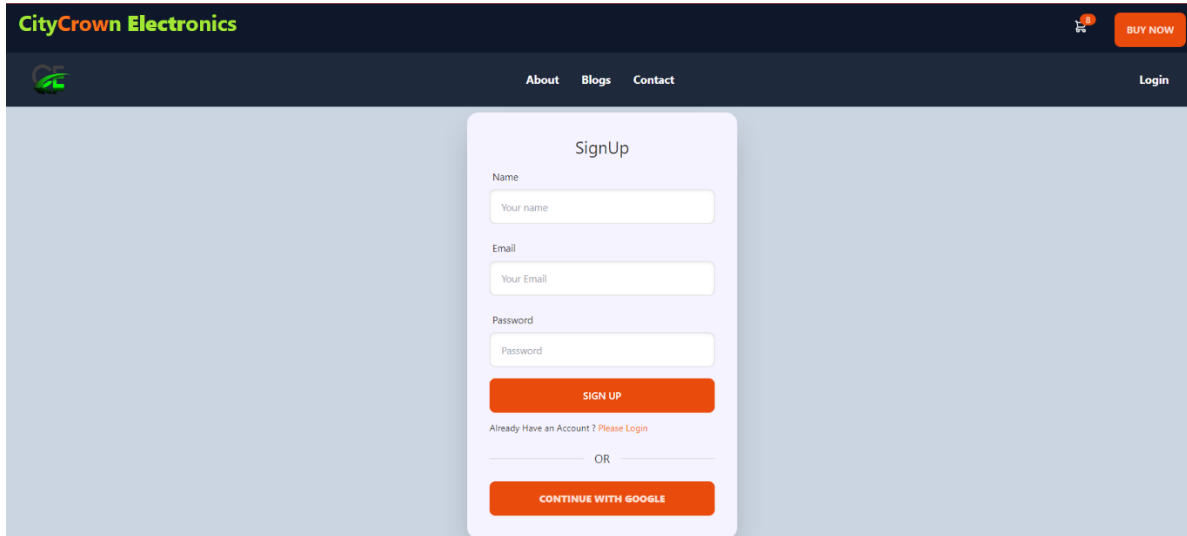

After successful sign up you will enter the website option. Then, we see the log in page in figure in 4.3, there we must need to input Email and password and click the “Login” button.

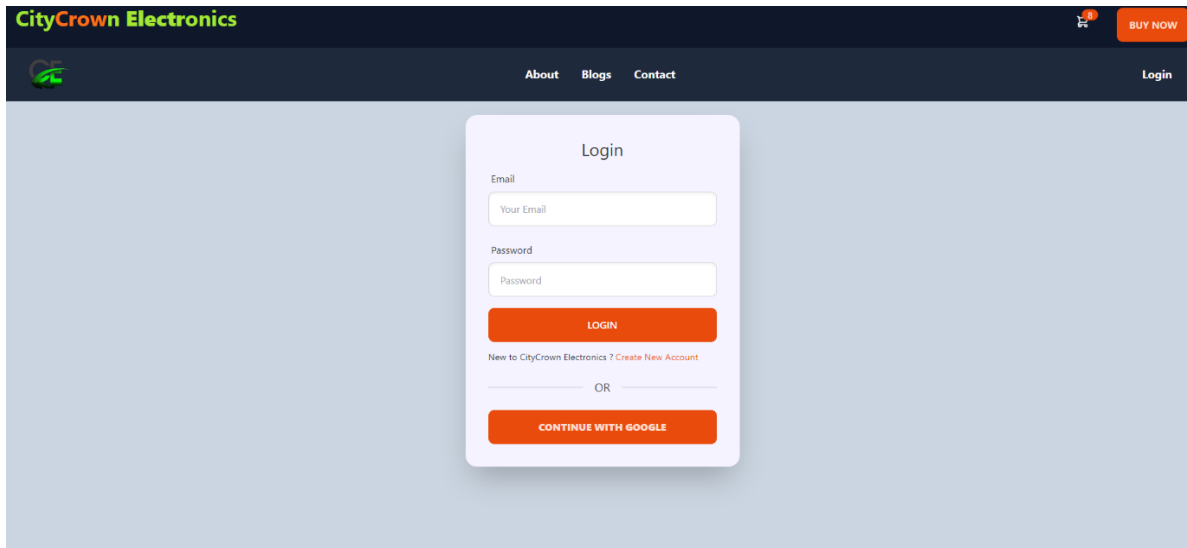

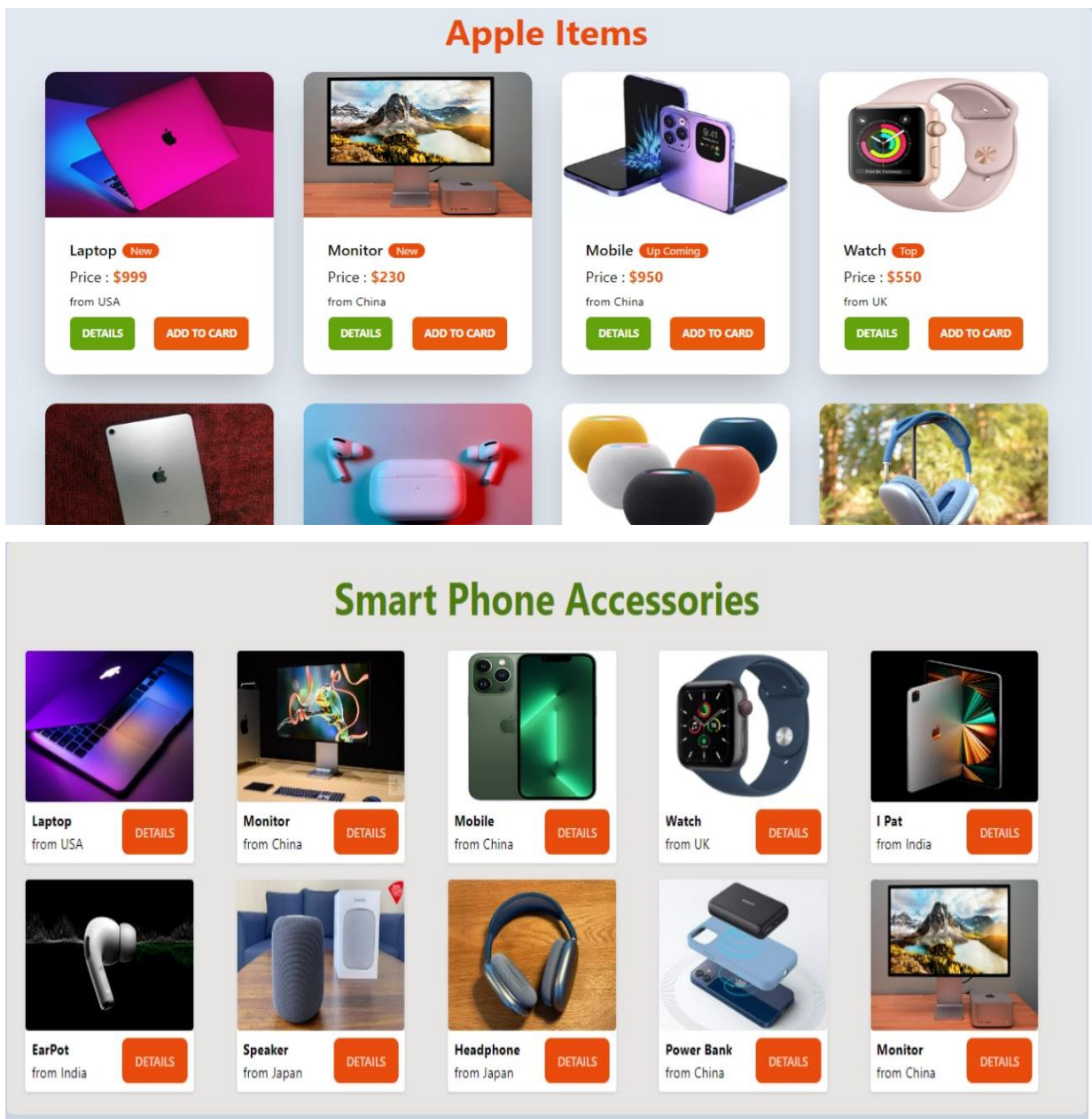


Figure 4.4: Product of CityCrown Ecommerce Website

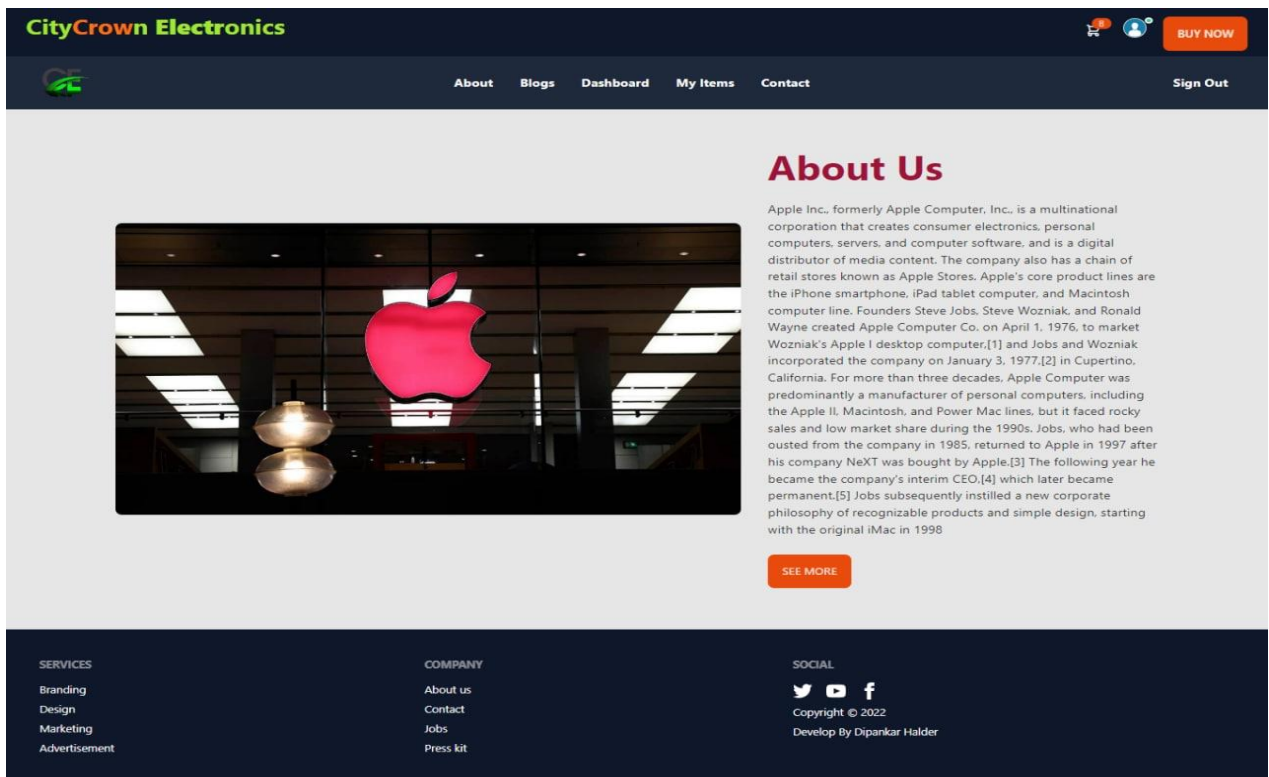


Figure 4.6: About section of CityCrown Ecommerce Website

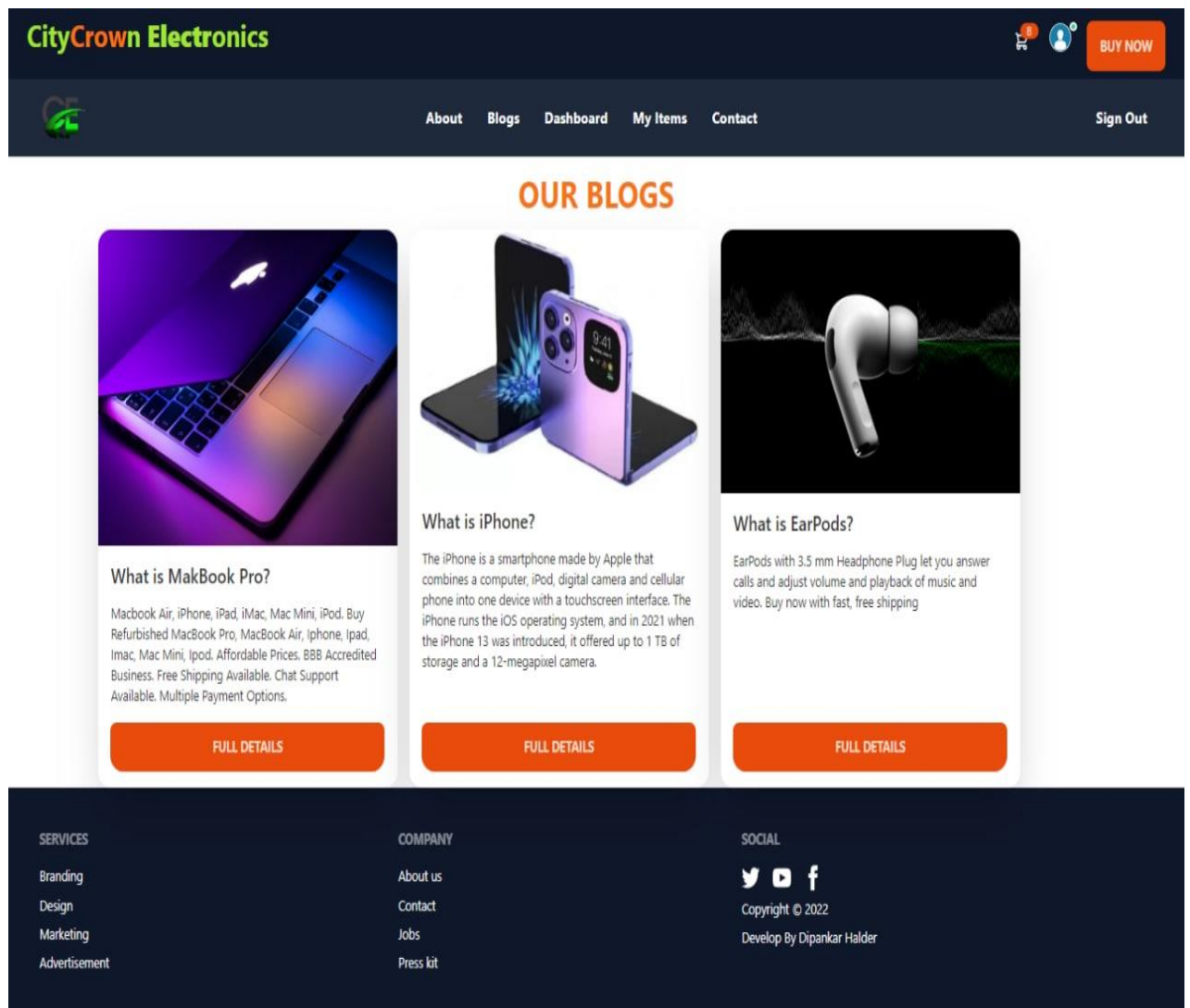
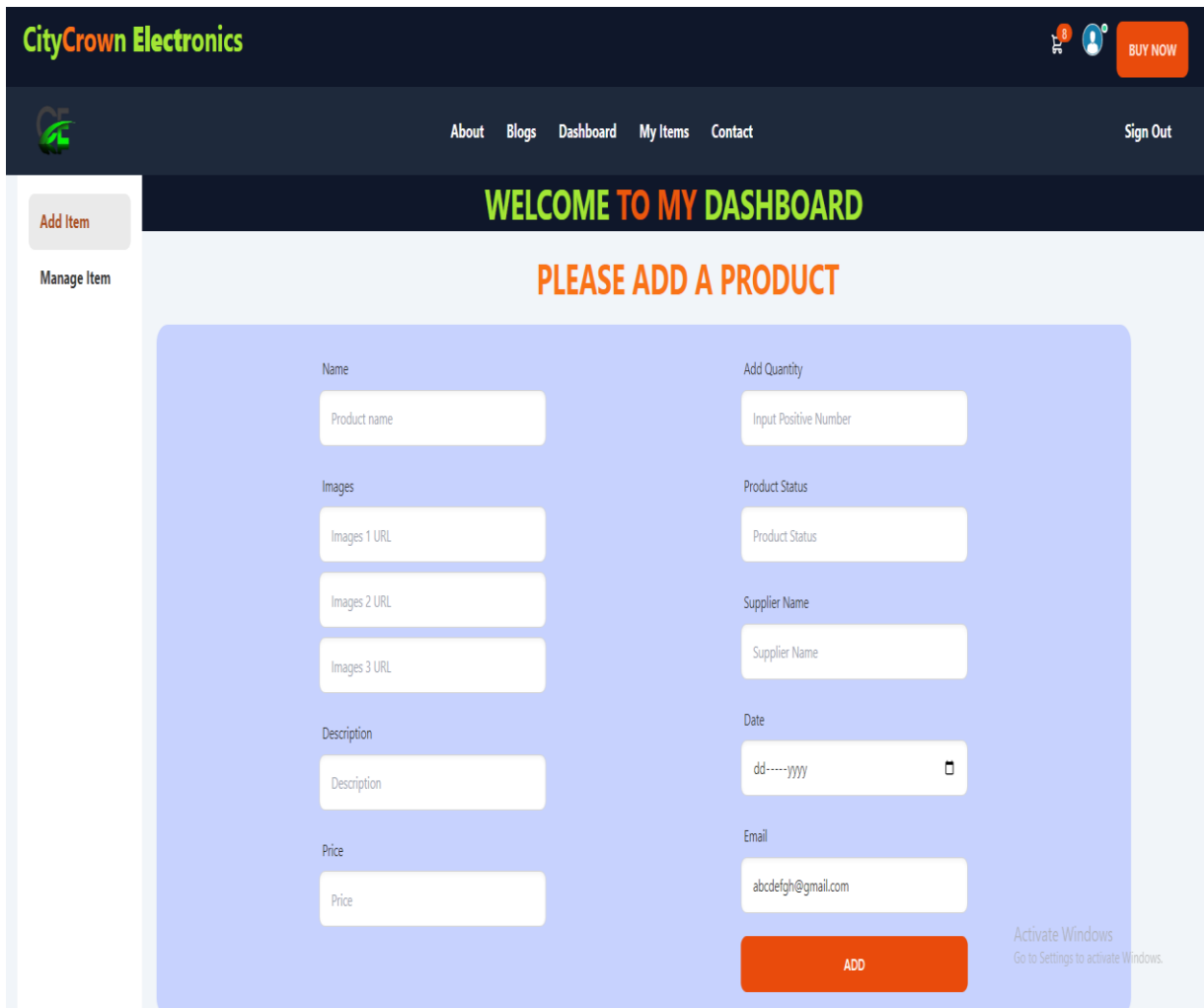


Figure 4.7: Blog section of CityCrown Ecommerce Website

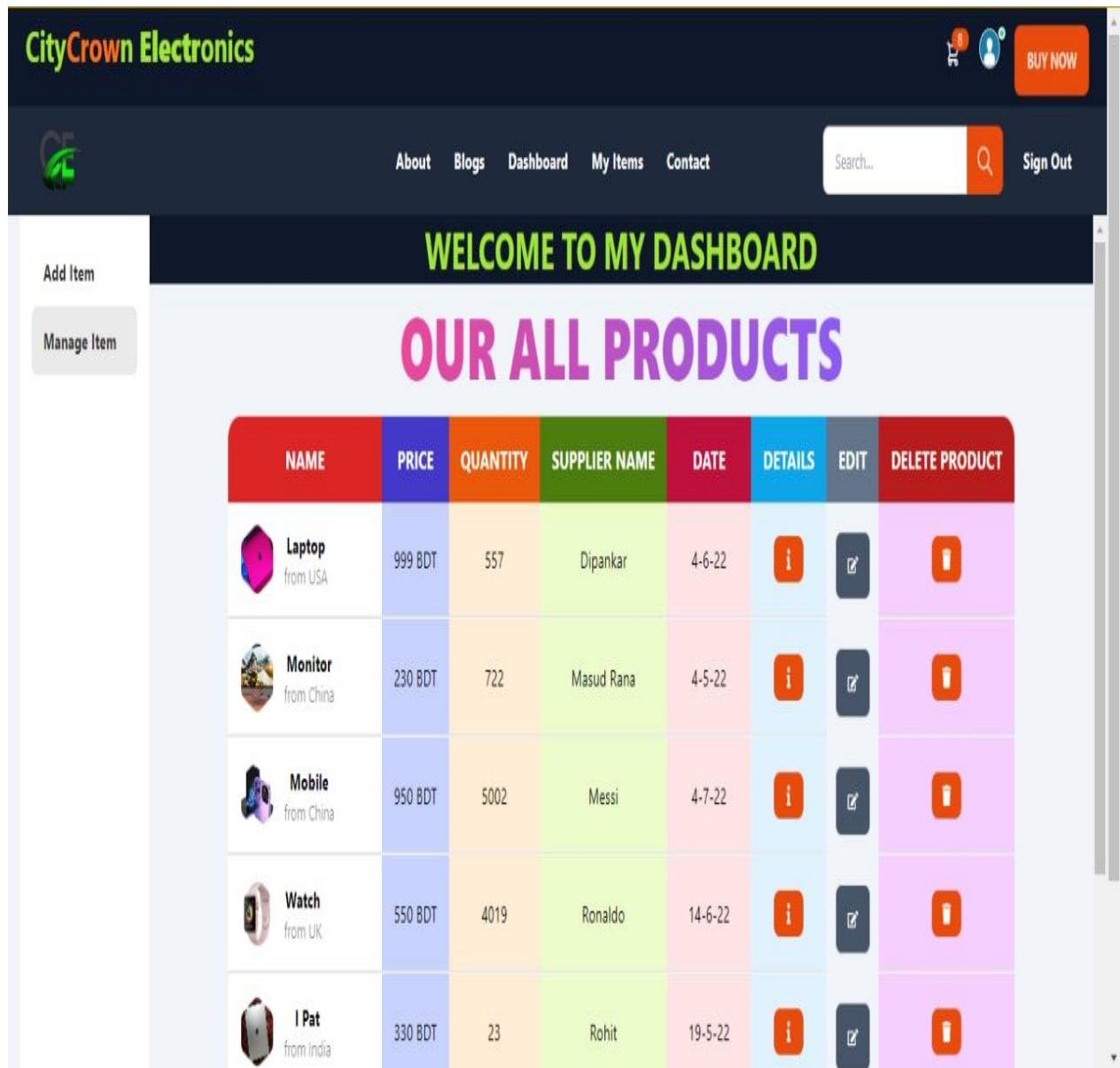

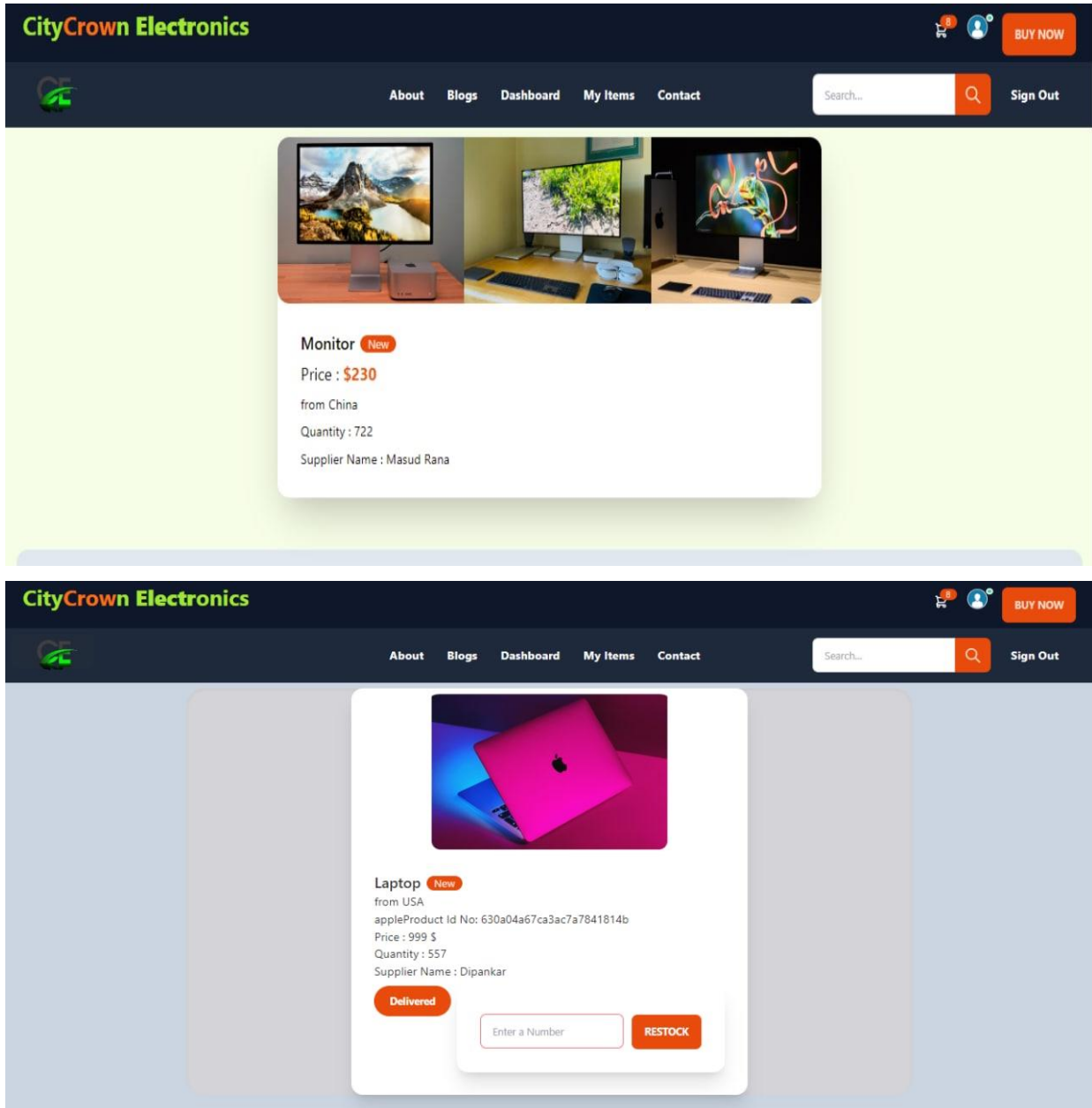
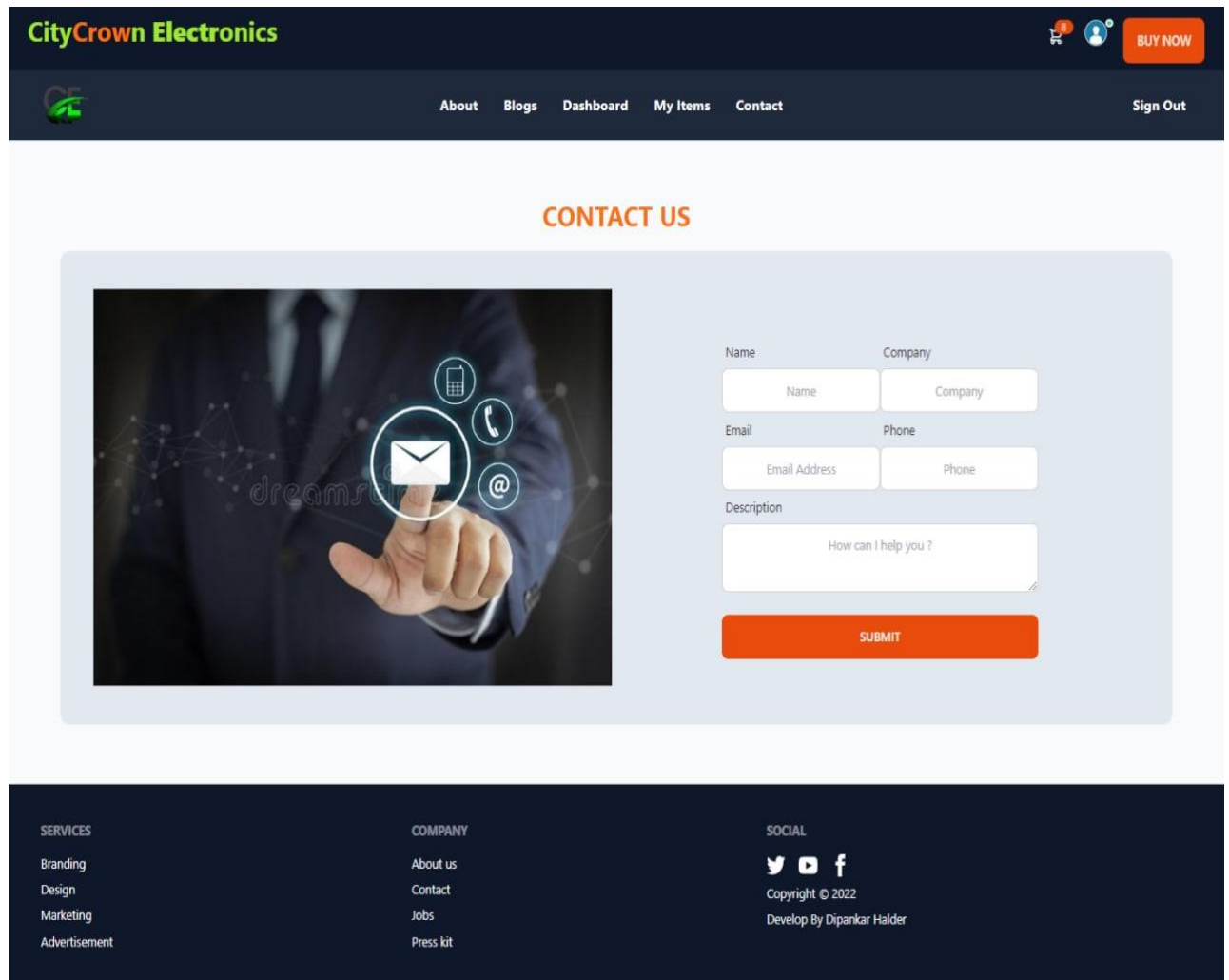


Figure 4.10: My items feature of CityCrown Ecommerce Website

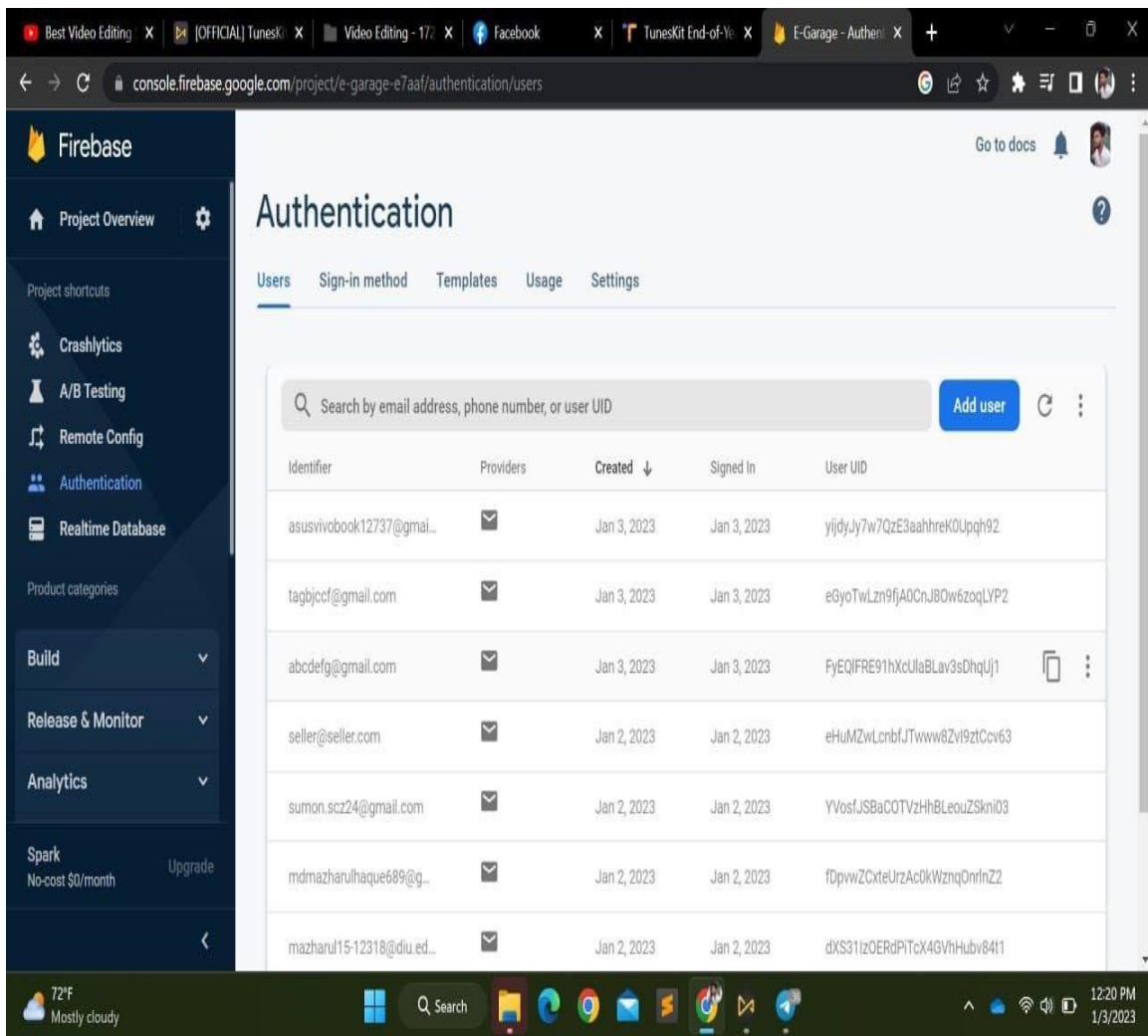


Figure 4.12: Firebase section of CityCrown Ecommerce Website
