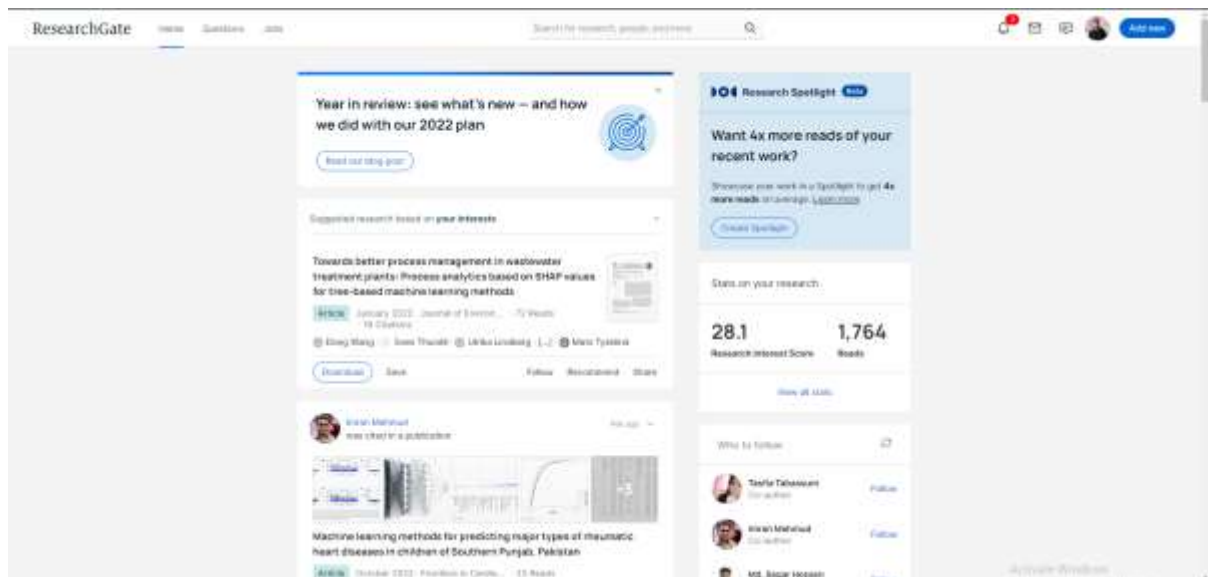


Figure:2.2.0: researchgate.net

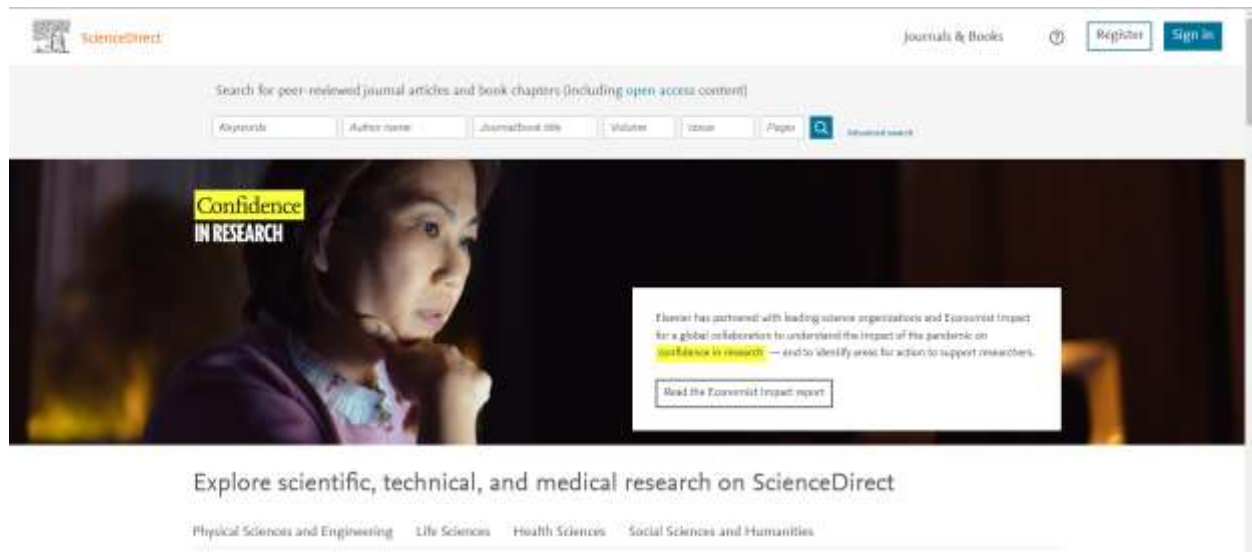


Figure:2.2.1: sciencedirect.com

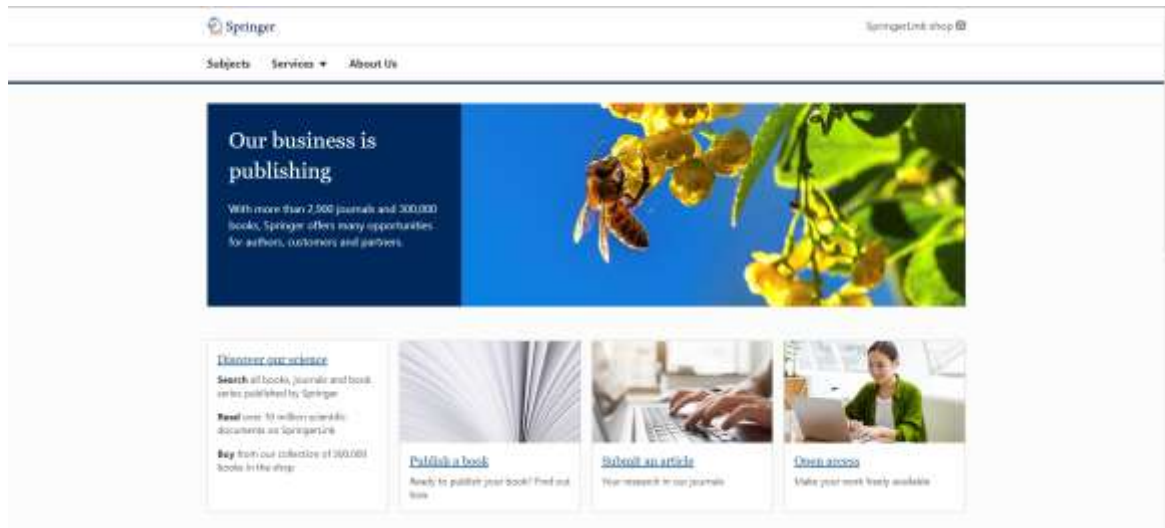


Figure:2.2.2: springer.com

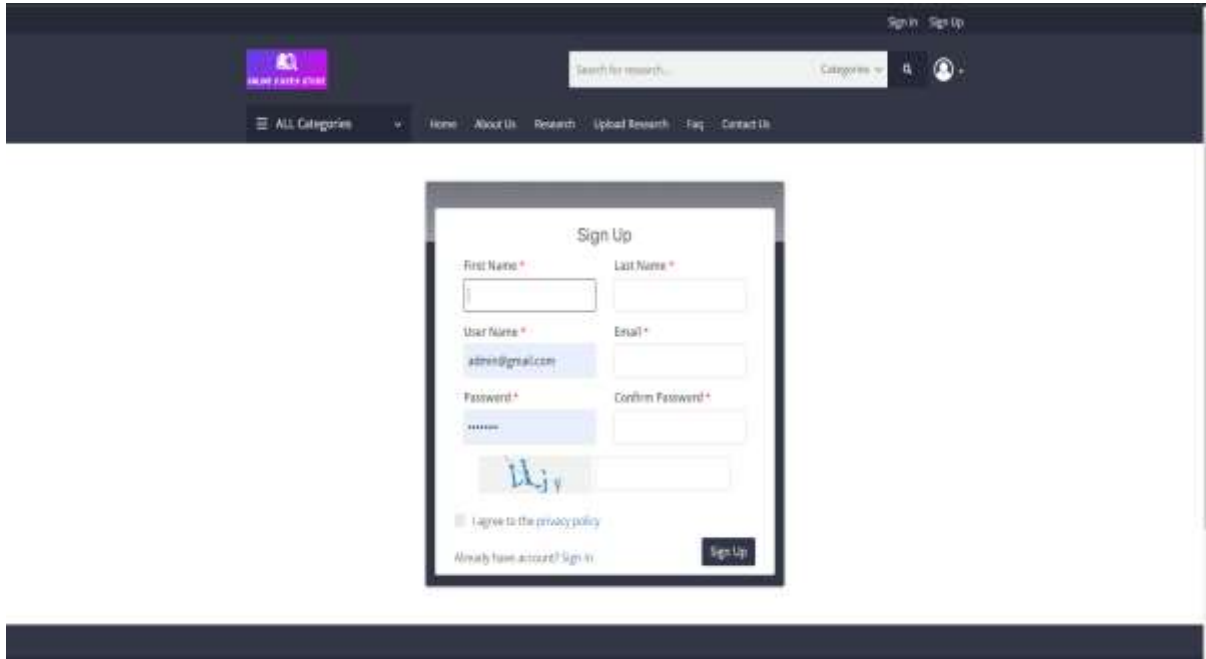


Figure:4.3: User Registration design

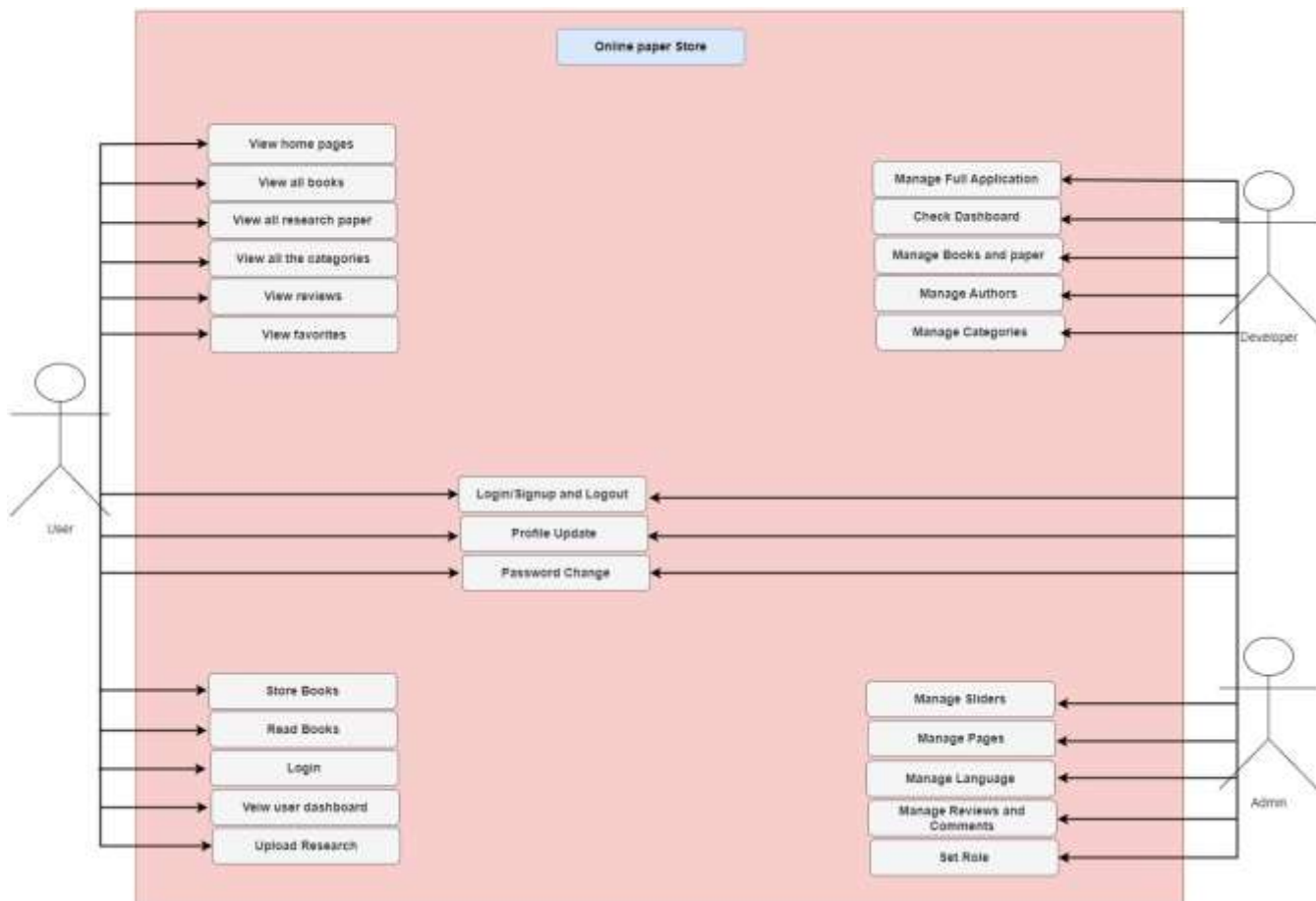


Figure: 3.6 Use case diagram

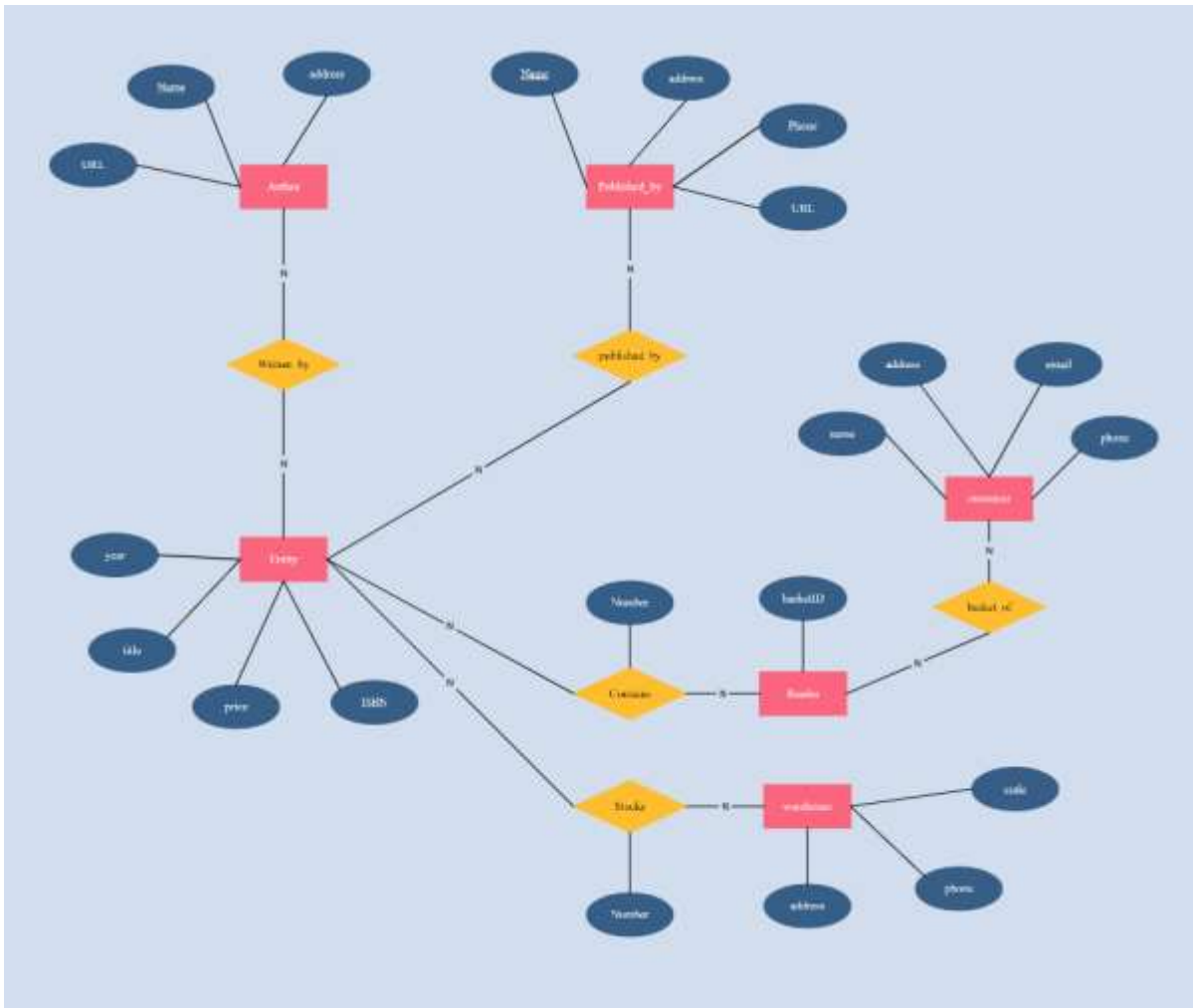


Figure: 3.7:ER diagram

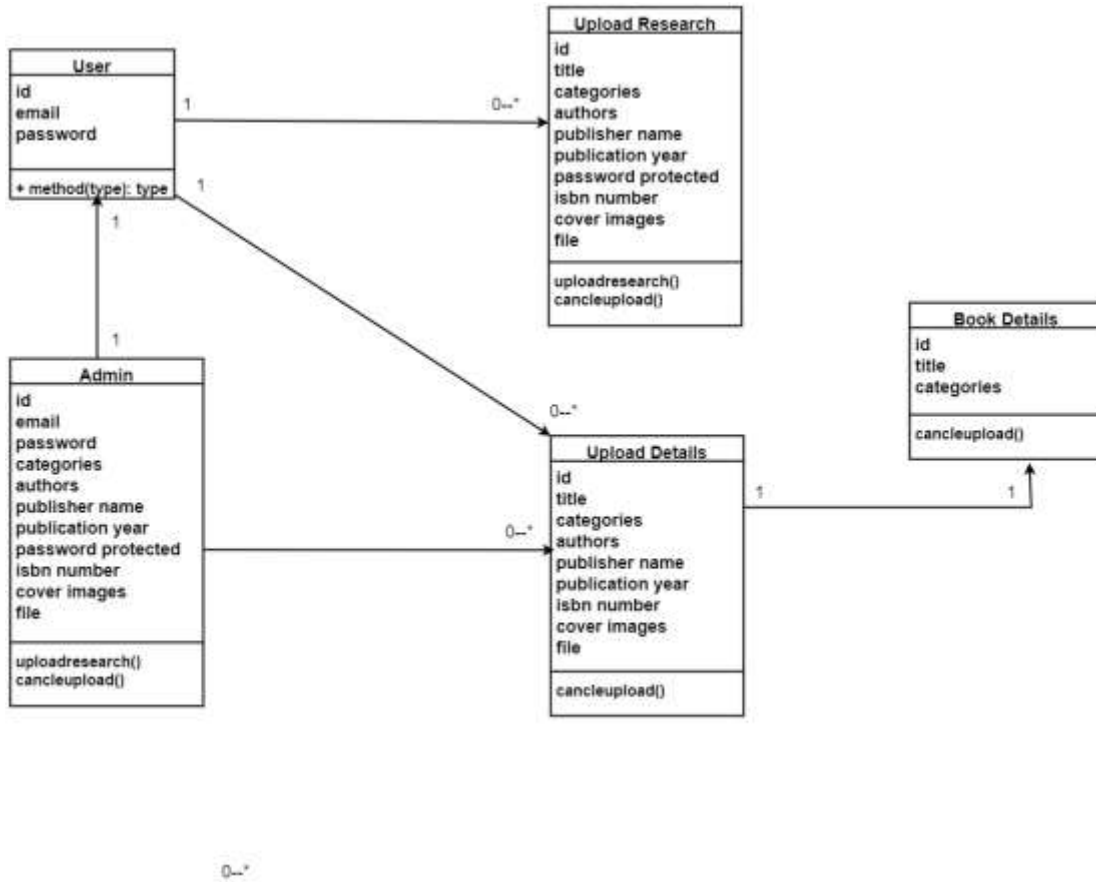


Figure:3.8: Class Diagram

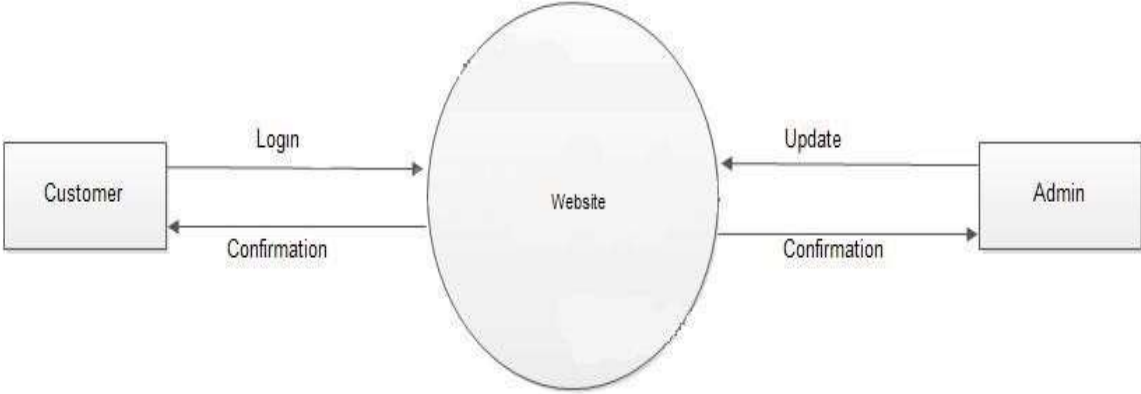


Figure:3.9: Data-Flow Diagram

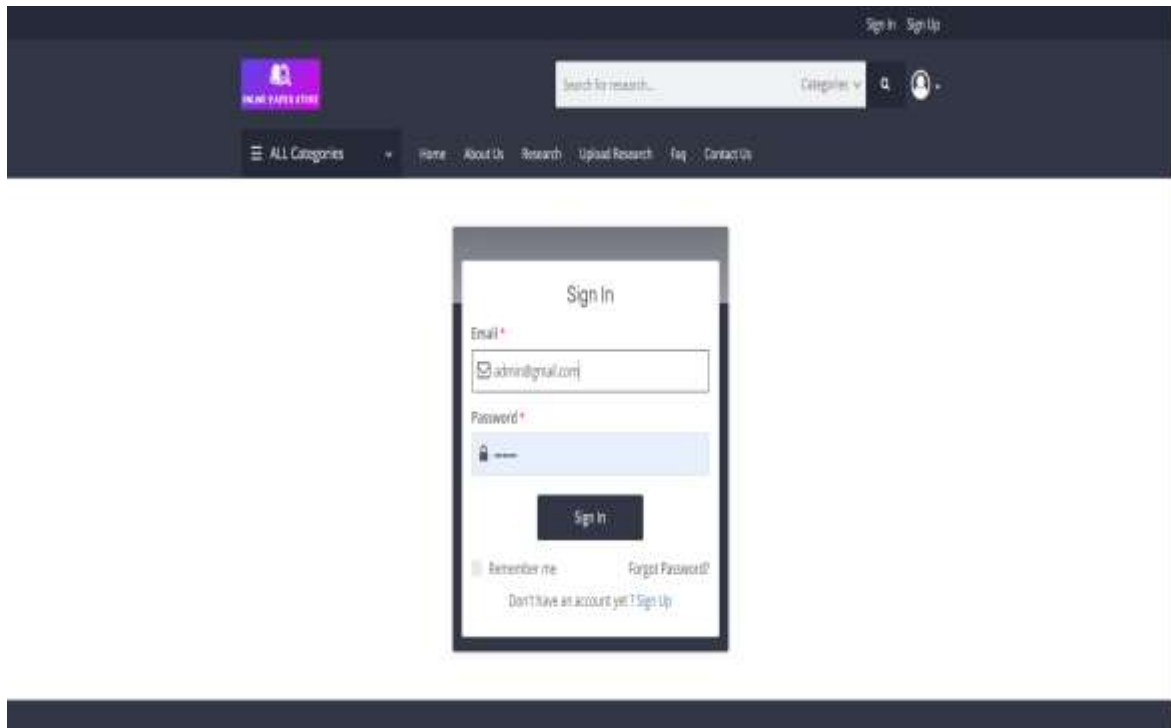


Figure:4.4: User login design

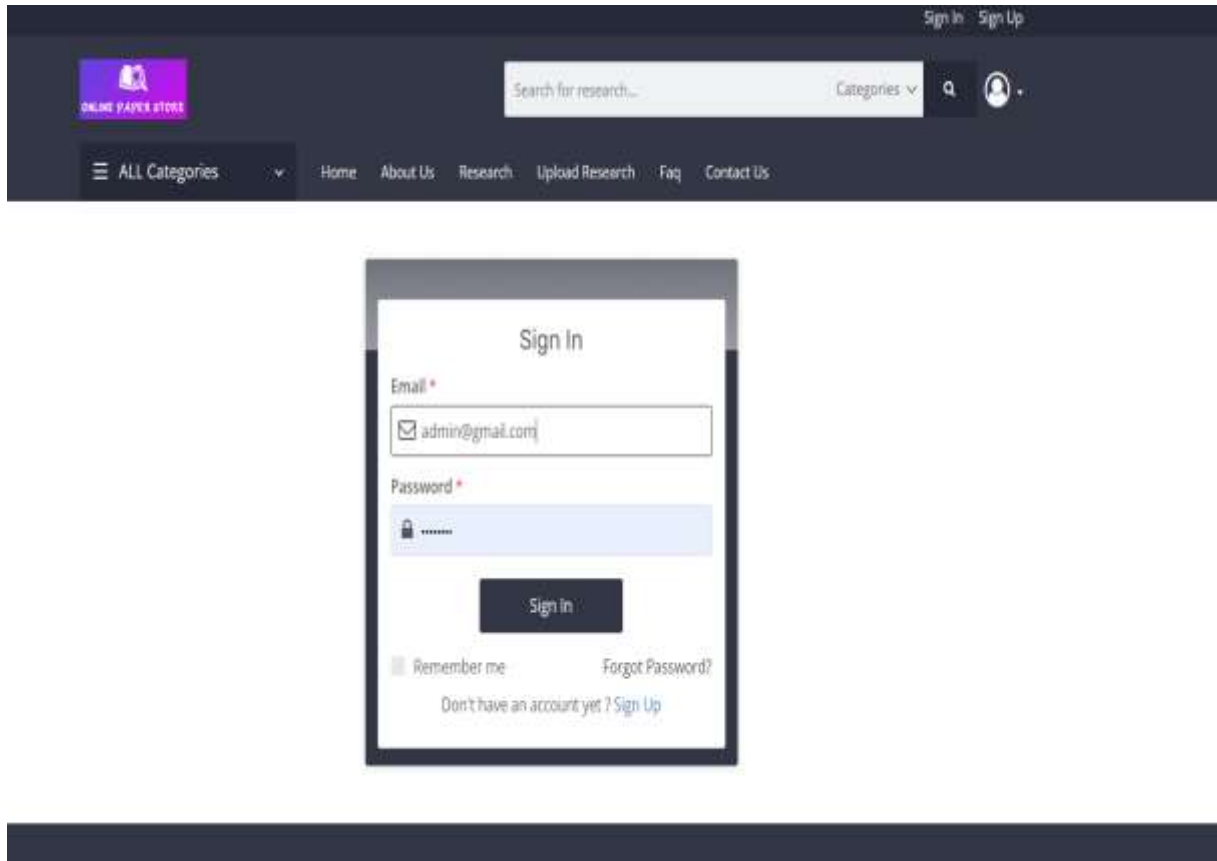


Figure:4.5: Admin login design

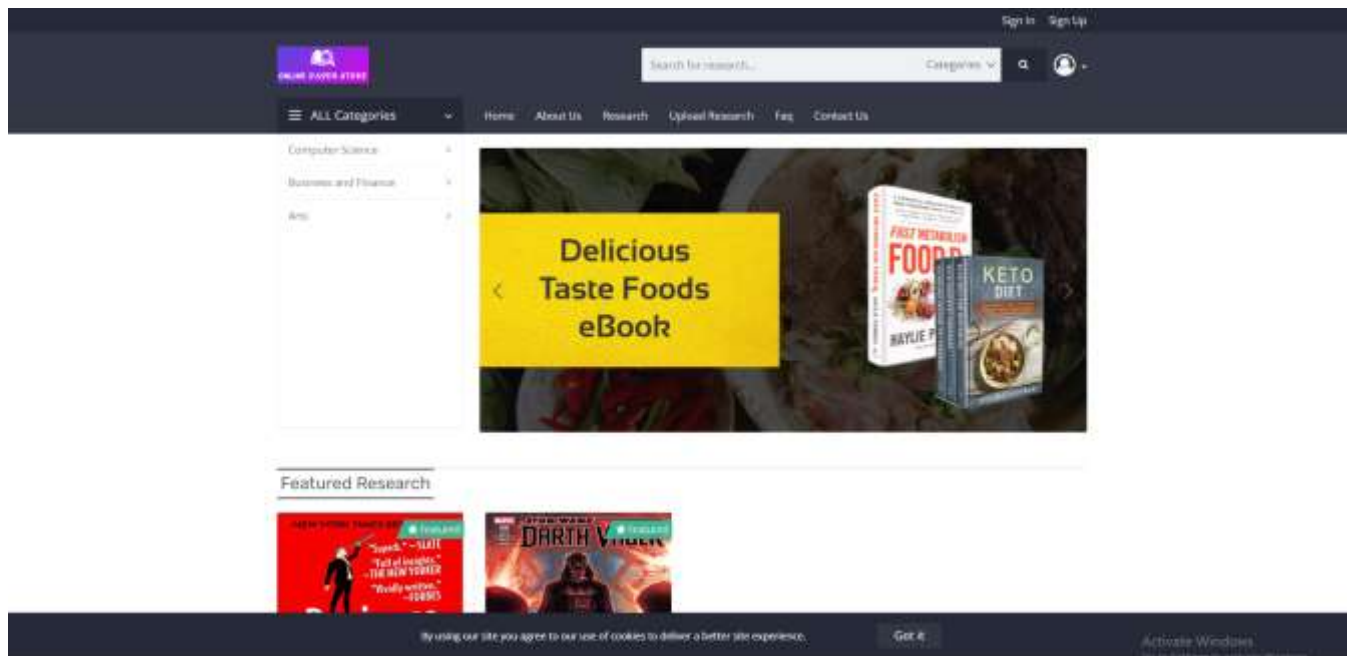



Figure:4.6: Home Page design

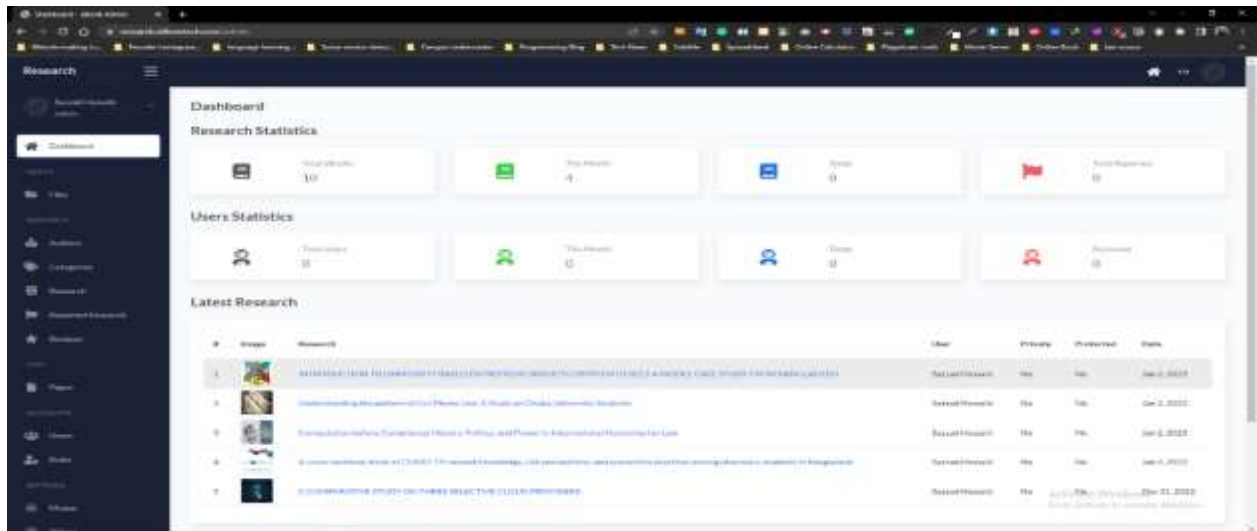


Figure:4.8: Admin dashboard
