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Introduction

I am Jannatul Ferdous Tanis. My holding ID is 192-10-2061. I am studying at Daffodil International University in the Department of English. In the last semester of my graduation, I was asked to do an internship and make a project paper about the present scenario of English language teaching in a Bangladeshi school.

We all know that, Bangladesh is a small nation with a sizable population, and the majority of whom are uneducated and in poverty. As a result, most of the people do not how to read, write or speak in English. It's clear that, English language has become a crucial tool to connect the world closer than ever, in this post-modern era. And there is no alternative to English language. To evaluate the present scenario of language teaching in Bangladeshi schools, I was asked by my supervisor, Ms. Nahid Kaiser to visit a school, do an internship, and make a project report on the scenario of English language teaching in Bangladeshi school. So, I decided to visit Palashbari USC High School for my internship purpose. I showed my letter of recommendation to the Headmaster, after that, he kindly granted me to take and observe classes and introduced me with the English teachers. Then, I contacted with the English teachers and see the class routine to fix my schedule of class observation and conduction.

Objectives

- To realize the condition about the present scenario of English language teaching in Bangladeshi schools.
- To know the condition of English language skills in reading, writing and speaking of Bangladeshi students.
- To get an idea of how to apply language teaching techniques in real classrooms.
- To know about their ideas and teaching methods and also observe the influence and effectiveness of English language
- To gather some experiences related to teaching.
- To observe the techniques of the teachers, apply them in class.
- To conduct classes by applying my planned methods and my learning.

Methodology

- As I am in my last semester of graduation, I was instructed by my supervisor, Ms. Nahid Kaiser, to find out a High School for my internship that would allow me to observe and conduct classes. According to the instructions, I decided to select an institution named Palashbari USC High School.
- At first, I met the headmaster and showed him my recommendation letter. The headmaster and the other teachers were very helpful, and I did not find any difficulty in their behavior.
- However, I selected Class 8,9 and 10 for class conduct and observation
- Then I observed two classes and took notes about their teaching methods, about their way of teaching, and use of English in the classroom for interaction with the students. After that, I also talked with the teachers and students and collected their opinions about the present scenario of English language teaching in their high school.
- Finally, I conducted some classes on Article and Tense in the selected classes by using GTM |(Grammar Translation Method) Method. I had given them some tasks, homework, taken some class tests and also arranged some seminars in the classroom. Most of the students were very pretty and they were so much helpful. At the end of the classes, I found a positive output from the students. And I think it was one of the great platforms for me during my graduation life.

4.1 Background and Basic Information of the Institution:

Palashbari USC High School is placed on 2 no. Palashbari, Birgonj, Dinajpur. It is a well-known Secondary high school stablished on January 1, 1942. The full name of the school is Palashbari Union Scheduled Caste High School. It is a non-government MPO level school, EIIN number is 120035. Its MPO number is 7802021301. The school offers classes up to Secondary level recognized by government. It is located in the rural area.

There are two academic buildings. The school has a mix up of poor and middle-class students. As it is in rural area, most of them are belong to poor families. But there are no differentiations. All the students get same attention from the teachers.

There is a big playground in front of the school. There is also another big playground outside of the school. Cultural programs are held on the playground.

Palashbari USC High School provides education in the following fields: science, humanities and business Studies. It is a combined school. There are about 410 students in the school. The dress code is formal. It operates on day shift, and management is managing.

There are 13 teachers in Palashbari USC High School. All the teachers are highly qualified. Most of them are BA B. ED and MA B. ED with good academic results from different universities. They are really very humble and gentle.

Though there is no club but they are fond of doing extracurricular activities. Some of them are really good singers, dancers, artists, and so on.

Internship Activity

5.1 Working Status:

I work at Palashbari USC High School as an intern teacher. But they treated me like other teachers. First of all, I observed classes, and after that, I conducted classes. I observed classes for gathering experiences, how they conducted classes and controlled the students. Then I started to teaching the students. I did a lot of co-curricular activities. Sometimes I arranged cultural programs or seminars.

5.2 Class Observation:

I observed two classes at Palashbari USC High School conducted by Mr. Obaidur Rahman and Most. Jannat Ara. They helped me a lot. I took notes and observed the classes very carefully. I observed the classes on February 6 and 9. Their teaching styles really very attractive. I enjoyed a lot.

First Class Observation

During my first-class observation, I observed a class that was in class eight at 11.25 am, conducted by an English teacher named Md. Obaidur Rahman and the class was English 2nd paper. The date was 6th February 2023. Class duration 50 minutes.

First of all, he checked his attendance before his class. After the introductions, he started the class with discussion. He explained the definition of Articles and then he taught them the use of Articles. I took notes on how he conducted his class, how he controlled the students and also observe his teaching technique. He utilized GTM strategy for conducting the class. He used both English and Bangla for conduct an understandable class. He related the lesson with the real-life example. They learned successfully, and his performance was amazing.

The students were equipped for understand the rules of articles and the proper use of articles. The teacher tried his level best to make the class more effective, attractive and justifiable. He made the class easier for the students, and in this way, the destination was done effectively by

him. And I think the students understood his lecture about articles. Most of the students were capable of answering the questions from the exercise part of this lesson.

He conducted a very well-designed class and also had superb time management skill. He tried to sum up the central issues that helped the students. The students learned the lesson by relating the topic with real-life examples.

Second Class Observation

My second observation involved class Ten, and the date was February 9, 2023 at 10.35 am. Class duration 50 minutes. The class teacher's name was Most. Jannat Ara and the class was English 1st paper.

First of all, she took attendance. After that her class started with the aims and objectives of the lesson. Next, she read the text with Bangla meaning. Later on, she asked them whether they understood or not. Then she gave them some tasks regarding the text. All the students were cooperative. She utilized GTM strategy while conducting the class. She used both English and Bangla for conduct an understandable easier class. She tried to relate the lesson with the real-life examples then she asked questions to them and answers them if necessary. Overall, she conducted the class successfully, the students understood the lesson.

The students were able to understand the topic. The teacher tried her level best to make the class more effective, attractive and understandable. She made the topic easier for the students, and in this way the destination was done effectively by her. And I think the students understood her lecture about Media and Modes of E-communication. After explaining the passage, most of the students were capable of answering the questions from the exercise part of this lesson.

Her teaching style and encouraging strategy were totally different. She tried to provide a lot of information regarding the topic. She looked very energetic while conducting class and tried to increase knowledge seeking behavior among students.

5.3 Teaching Experience

On February 1, I started my internship at Palashbari USC High School. After observing 2 classes, I took permission for class conduction and then, I started class conduction on February 12. It was my first-class presentation in front of a lot of students. So, I was so much excited and also little bit nervous in my first class. After that, I conducted many classes. I experienced a lot during 3- month internship. My overall teaching experiences are given below:

Teaching Experience 1:

Class: Eight

Number of Students: 43

Subject: English 2nd paper

Topic: Articles

Time: 45 minutes

I conducted my first class with class 8, and the topic was articles and the use of articles. At first, I entered into the class and greeted my students. They were very happy to see me and they were so helpful. First of all, I introduced myself and told them why I was taking their class. Then, I asked them their name and their aim in life. They responded spontaneously.

According to my lesson plan, I conducted an ice-breaking session to make them attentive. After that, I took their attendances. Then, I started the class's discussions on articles according to their demand. First of all, I asked them questions about some grammatical items (sentence, parts of speech, number, gender etc.). Then I gave them some ideas about those grammatical items. Then I started the main discussion about articles. I asked them whether they knew the topic or not. Most of them were replied positively. Later on, I discussed articles in detail and it's uses. I taught them some rules of articles. I wrote some examples on the white board in order to make the topic easy and understood as well as to make them comfortable.

After that, I gave them some tasks and checked some of their answer scripts. Then, I explained the solutions to them. Definitely, it was a great moment for me because most of the students were very pretty and positive, and it helped me to finish the class successfully.

Teaching Experience 2:

Class: Ten

Number of Students: 32

Subject: English 2nd paper

Topic: Tenses

Time: 45 minutes

I conducted classes with class 10, and in the first class, the topic was tense. I was little bit nervous because they are most seniors in the school. But after some times, I realized that, they were so much friendly.

Firstly, I entered the class and greeted to them. Then, I introduced myself and told them why I was there and taking their class. I also described about my internship and inspire them to do good in their future lives. They were impressed by my words. After that according to my lesson plan, I conducted a warm-up session to make them more attentive. Then, I asked them some questions about some grammatical items. They told me that, some of them were little bit weak in tense. Then, I started the class, discussions on tense. I asked some questions to them whether they knew this topic or not. I was happy to see that most of them replied positively and wanted to learn more about tense. As it was their first class with me so I just started the discussion in a white broad way on tenses and its classifications as well as about the details on simple present tense. After that, I wrote some examples on the white board in order to make the topic easy and understand as well as to make them comfortable. I advised them on how they could improve their skills in tense identification.

Following that, I gave them some fill-in-the blanks from Present Simple Tenses. Then, I checked some of their answer scripts and explained the solutions. They felt more comfortable with me, which helped me to finish the class successfully.

Teaching Experience 3:

Class: Nine

Number of Students: 39

Subject: English 2nd paper

Topic: Paragraph Writing

Time: 45 minutes

I also conducted classes with class 9. In the first class, the topic was Paragraph Writing. I was happy to see them. A huge number of students were present there. Though, I was little bit nervous, but after some times I realized that, they were so much friendly.

Firstly, when I entered into the class, they greeted me warmly. They gave me a lot of flowers. Then, as it was my first class with them, I introduced myself and told them my purpose of taking their class and also described about my internship and project paper. They were very impressed by my words. After that, according to my lesson plan, I conducted an ice breaking session to make them more attentive and comfortable. I asked them what they want to learn in their first class. They requested me to take a session about how to write a paragraph. Then, first and foremost, I explained to them about paragraph, what a paragraph is. I taught them there is only one para in paragraph. I also taught them about topic sentence and its importance. Then, I gave them examples and taught them how to write a perfect paragraph. I advised them how they can improve their writing skill. I told them about free-hand writing.

After that, I told them to write a paragraph about "Tree Plantation" by using free-hand writing. Then, I checked some of their answer scripts and I was surprised to see some of their writing. At the end of the class, they told me that they felt more comfortable with me. They were really very friendly and helped me to finish the class successfully.

I found my shortcomings, strengths and so on. Now I can conduct a class without any fear or nervousness. It's really been a great journey and achievement for me.

During my internship period, I set my career goal. The head teacher and the other teachers allowed me to join the meetings or discussion sessions with them. Everything made me more skilled, knowledgeable and energetic. Duties made me more professionals. I strictly maintained the institutional rules and regulations which made me more responsible and efficient. Those formal behaviors helped me to practice my patient.

5.6 Co-Curricular Activities:

I did a lot of extracurricular activities at Palashbari USC High School. As the students and teachers are very friendly, they allowed me to do some extracurricular activities. They helped me a lot.

After classes, we arranged cultural programs and simple seminars on reading and speaking skills. The students were fond of it. They spontaneously join the cultural programs or in the seminars. Some of them were good singers or dancers and some of them were good speakers or readers. They are really very talented.

We celebrated 21st February the International Mother Language Day. We arranged a rally and gave flowers in the Shaheed Minar to show our respect to the martyrs.

We celebrated 17th march the birthday of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, and the Children's Day. We have respect to Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman arranged a drawing competition and essay writing competition.

We arranged a picnic and went to Shopnopuri. Shopnopuri is an artificial amusement park in Dinajpur. It was really a good journey. First of all, I tried to convince the students to arrange a picnic for a mental refreshment. Some of the students were interested. Then we convinced the teachers. After that, we arranged a beautiful picnic in an amazing picnic spot.

I arranged a quiz competition in class 10. I gave prizes and chocolates to the first, second and third competitors. They were so much happy for that.

I arranged a speaking competition in a certain topic and gave prizes to the first, second and third competitors. They were very much interested and excited for the speaking competition.

Limitations of the Internship

I have felt some limitations, though my department has been enough resourceful and communicative regarding the whole internship process. But that can be resolved by taking proper steps.

- Time limitation is the main problem. Due to some processes in the department, I started my internship on February 1. As it was my 12 weeks plan, but due to Ramadan and Eid-Ul-Fitr, the school remained closed. So, I only took classes for nine weeks. It was so tough for me to maintain my whole plan in such a short time. The On the opening day of the school, I counted my last week. On that day, they bid me farewell.
- There were two English teachers. Another teacher was in retirement. For that, I was asked to follow his routine. So, it was tough for me to maintain the classes as well as extracurricular activities. It was another limitation for me.
- I have asked to observed 3 classes. But I observed only two, because there were two English teachers and another teacher was in the retirement. That was another limitation.
- I wanted to conduct classes by using CLT (Communicative Language Teaching) method. But the students were habitual in GTM (Grammar Translation Method) method. So, I was failed to use CLT method. It was a great limitation for me.

Overall Findings

7.1 My overall findings:

- Using both Bangla and English in the classroom. It was essential to use mother language (Bangla) to communicate with the students for English language teaching.
- Teachers teaching methods are not efficient for the average students.
- Classroom environment is noisy, not well decorated, and not colorful.
- There is no proper use of multimedia projectors in the classrooms, and lesson materials are highly confined to textbooks.
- Lack of experienced teachers as well as skilled and trained teachers.
- There are no opportunities for students to practice listening and speaking skills. There is no language lab. But, there are few opportunities for reading and writing skills.
- Lack of English teachers due to the retirement of a teacher.
- Students do not have scope for speaking practice outside of the classroom.

- The poor planning of extracurricular activities.
- Some complaints of the unsatisfied parents.

- Make a routine for proper time management.

- If cannot control laughing in the critical moment.
- Lack of technological knowledge.

Recommendation

Some recommendations of mine for the improvement of the English classes as well as the school:

- The school should set up multimedia projectors in all the classes.
- The school should decorate the classrooms with colorful papers and flowers.
- The teachers should be trained and learn more about the effective learning system.
- ➤ I noticed that the majority of students do not participate in the classroom activities. The teachers should encourage the students for participate in the activities.
- ➤ I also noticed that some students often hesitate to ask questions or any kind of query. The teacher should create a better environment for the students to ask questions frequently.
- > School authority should be arranging some programs as well as other extracurricular activities.
- ➤ Common room facilities should be increased, where students can read Bangla or English newspaper, magazine to increase their knowledge as well as vocabulary skill and they can also enrich their speaking skill by taking with each other.

Conclusion

As a way of wrapping up the report, I would like to express my sincere gratitude to Palashbari USC High School and the head teacher for giving me the chance to complete my internship as an English teacher. I was given permission to both watch and lead lessons, and throughout my internship I learnt a lot about some important concepts. In terms of the lesson plan, classroom management, class presentation, question-making, script-checking, planning extracurricular events, and other topics, I have learned a little bit.

As an intern teacher, my respected head teacher and my colleagues instructors gave me plenty of freedom to experiment, and I made an effort to use my knowledge as effectively as possible. Then, I asked them their name and their aim in life. They responded spontaneously. According to my lesson plan, I conducted an ice-breaking session to make them attentive. After that, I took their attendances. Then, I started the class's discussions on articles according to their demand. First of all, I asked them questions about some grammatical items (sentence, parts of speech, number, gender etc.). Then I gave them some ideas about those grammatical items. Then I started the main discussion about articles. I asked them whether they knew the topic or not. Most of them were replied positively. Later on, I discussed articles in detail and it's uses. I taught them some rules of articles. I wrote some examples on the white board in order to make the topic easy and understood as well as to make them comfortable. After that, I gave them some tasks and checked some of their answer scripts. Then, I explained the solutions to them. Definitely, it was a great moment for me because most of the students were very pretty and positive, and it helped me to finish the class successfully. Teaching Experience 2: Class: Ten Number of Students: 32 Subject: English 2nd paper Topic: Tenses Time: 45 minutes I conducted classes with class 10, and in the first class, the topic was tense. I was little bit nervous because they are most seniors in the school. But after some times, I realized that, they were so much friendly. Firstly, I entered the class and greeted to them. Then, I introduced myself and told them why I was there and taking their class. I also described about my internship and inspire them to do good in their future lives. They were impressed by my words. After that according to my lesson plan, I conducted a warm-up session to make them more attentive. Then, I asked them some questions about some grammatical items. They told me that, some of them were little bit weak in tense. Then, I started the class, discussions on tense. I asked some questions to them whether they knew this topic or not. was happy to see that most of them replied positively and wanted to learn more about tense. As it was their first class with me so I just started the discussion in a white broad way on tenses and its classifications as well as about the details on simple present tense. After that, I wrote some examples on the white board in order to make the topic easy and understand as well as to make them comfortable. I advised them on how they could improve their skills in tense identification. Following that, I gave them some fill-in-the blanks from Present Simple Tenses. Then, I checked some of their answer scripts and explained the solutions. They felt more comfortable with me, which helped me to finish the class successfully. Teaching Experience 3: Class: Nine Number of Students: 39 Subject: English 2nd paper Topic: Paragraph Writing Time: 45 minutes I also conducted classes with class 9. In the first class,

the topic was Paragraph Writing. I was happy to see them. A huge number of students were present there. Though, I was little bit nervous, but after some times I realized that, they were so much friendly. Firstly, when I entered into the class, they greeted me warmly. They gave me a lot of flowers. Then, as it was my first class with them, I introduced myself and told them my purpose of taking their class and also described about my internship and project paper. They were very impressed by my words. After that, according to my lesson plan, I conducted an ice breaking session to make them more attentive and comfortable. I asked them what they want to learn in their first class. They requested me to take a session about how to write a paragraph. Then, first and foremost, I explained to them about paragraph, what a paragraph is. I taught them there is only one para in paragraph. I also taught them about topic sentence and its importance. Then, I gave them examples and taught them how to write a perfect paragraph. I advised them how they can improve their writing skill. I told them about freehand writing. After that, I told them to write a paragraph about "Tree Plantation" by using freehand writing. Then, I checked some of their answer scripts and I was surprised to see some of their writing. At the end of the class, they told me that they felt more comfortable with me. Chapter-6 Limitations of the Internship I have felt some limitations, though my department has been enough resourceful and communicative regarding the whole internship process. So, I was failed to use CLT method. It was a great limitation for me. Chapter-7 Overall Findings 7.1 My overall findings: • Using both Bangla and English in the classroom. It was essential to use mother language (Bangla) to communicate with the students for English language teaching. • Teachers teaching methods are not efficient for the average students. • Classroom environment is noisy, not well decorated, and not colorful. • There is no proper use

of multimedia projectors in the classrooms, and lesson materials are highly confined to textbooks. • Lack of experienced teachers as well as skilled and trained teachers. • There are no opportunities for students to practice listening and speaking skills. There is no language lab. The teacher should create a better environment for the students to ask questions frequently. • School authority should be arranging some programs as well as other extracurricular activities. - Common room facilities should be increased, where students can read Bangla or English newspaper, magazine to increase their knowledge as well as vocabulary skill and they can also enrich their speaking skill by taking with each other.
