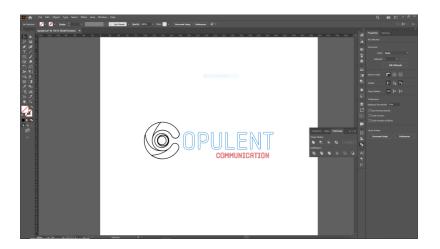


Figure 3.1.1. i. _ "Logo Layout"

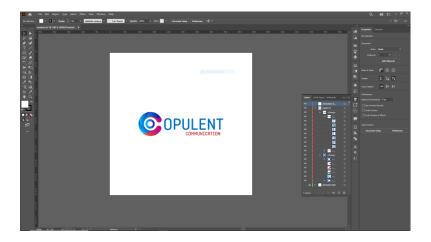


Figure 3.1.1. ii. _ "Logo Software view"

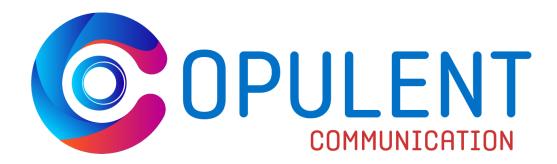


Figure 3.1.1. iv. _ "Opulent communication Logo Final Output"

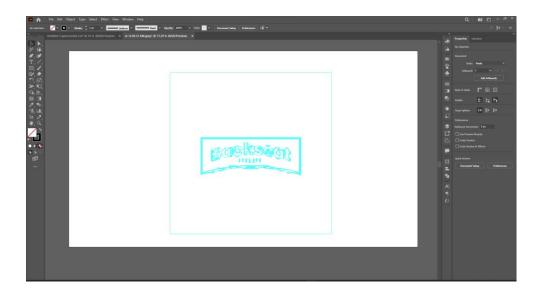


Figure 3.1.3. i. _ "Logo Layout"

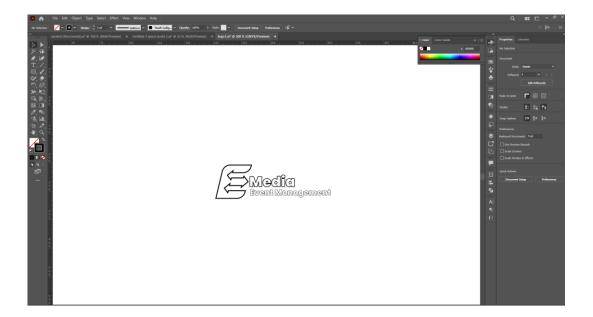


Figure 3.1.4. i. _ "Logo Layout"

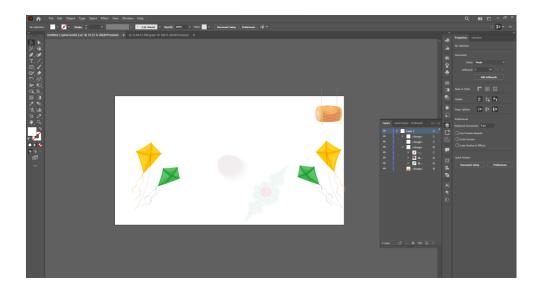


Figure 3.2.1. i. _ "Logo Layout"

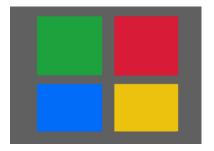


Figure 3.2.1. iii. _ "Color palate"

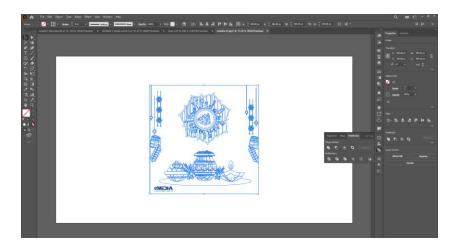


Figure 3.2.2. i. _ "Logo Layout"

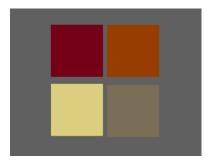


Figure 3.2.3. iii. _ "Color palate"

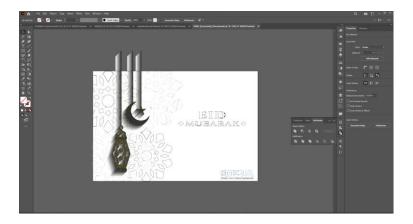


Figure 3.2.4. i . _ "Logo Layout"

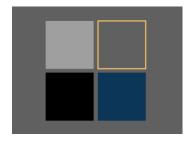


Figure 3.2.4. iii. _ "Color palate"

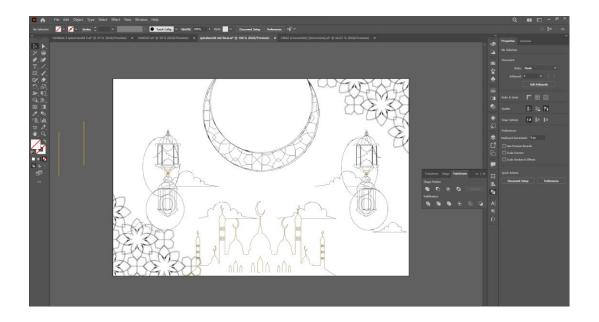


Figure 3.2.5. i . _ "Logo Layout"

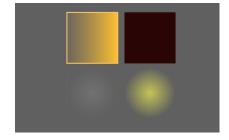


Figure 3.2.5. iii. _ "Color palate"

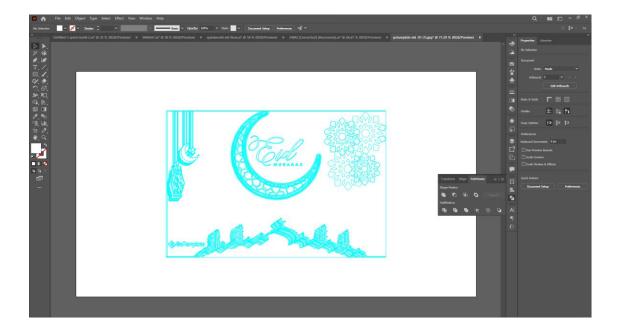


Figure 3.2.6. i . _ "Logo Layout"

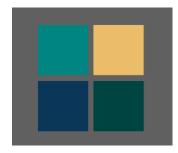


Figure 3.2.6. iii. _ "Color palate"

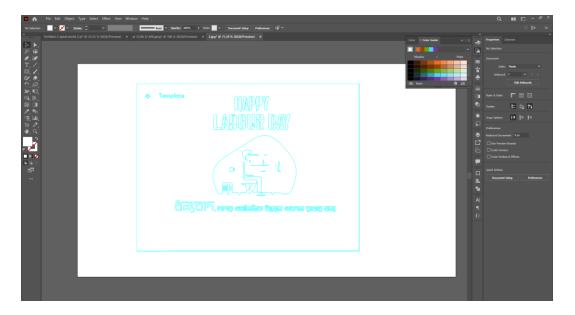


Figure 3.2.7. i . _ "Logo Layout"

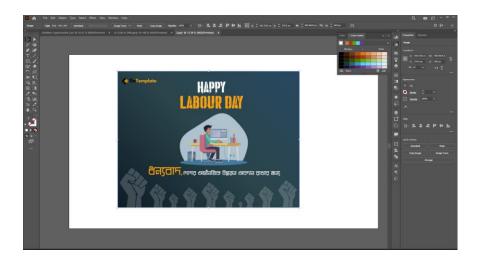


Figure 3.2.7. ii. _ "Software overview"

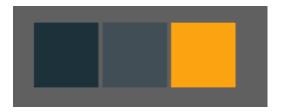


Figure 3.2.7. iii. _ "Color palate"

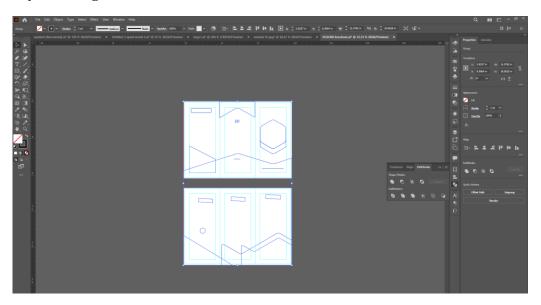


Figure 3.3.1. i. _ "Layout"

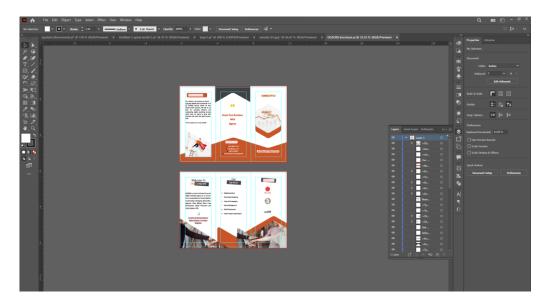


Figure 3.3.1. ii. _ "Software view"

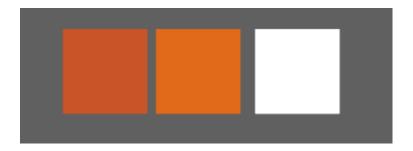


Figure 3.3.1. iii. _ "Color Palate"

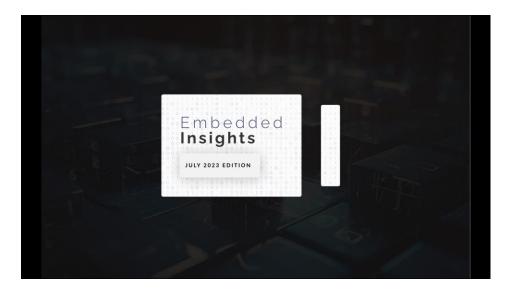


Figure 3.4.1. i. _ "Output"

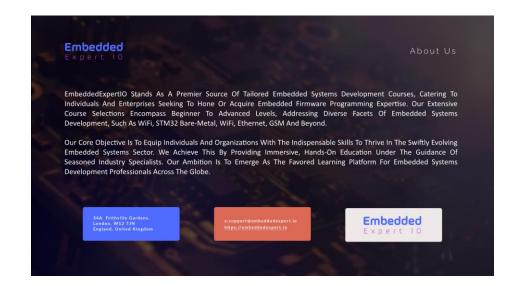


Figure 3.4.1. iii. _ "output"

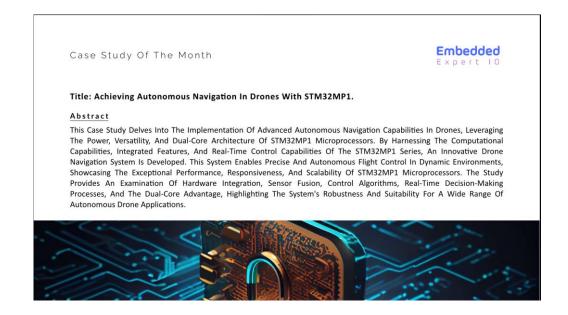


Figure 3.4.1. iv. _ "Final Output"
