**Methodology**: Based on the project paper's outline, this section is organized. The next part will cover the overall process.

Choosing an Institute: Initially, I experienced some apprehension regarding the direction to take in terms of my educational and career path. Faced with the decision between pursuing opportunities in the industrial sector or within an academic setting, I found myself unsure of the best choice for my future development. Ultimately, with aspirations of becoming a teacher, I made the choice to focus on educational institutions. Seeking guidance, I consulted with my supervisor for advice on the most suitable path to take. Aligned with his recommendation, I opted to enroll in a high school to further my educational journey. **Observing a classroom in session:** I chose to observe classes in sixth and seventh grade. In total, I had the opportunity to observe many classes over a period of 3 months. During my time observing, I received all the information I needed from my instructor, including the lesson plans, assignments, and exercises. In particular, Md. Askor Ali assisted me in selecting the classes to observe, guided me on how to conduct the observations, and how to handle the class. I made use of a checklist provided by my university during the observation process.

## **Teaching students:**

I made a strong effort to enhance the accessibility and engagement of the class for every student, striving to offer assistance and encouragement consistently. In addition, I worked on creating a lively and enjoyable classroom atmosphere, striving to keep the students actively involved to prevent any boredom from setting in. It was important for me to first capture their attention in order to effectively work on improving and evaluating their progress. I was pleasantly surprised by the level of attention they gave me and their eagerness to interact with me, which, in turn, brought me a sense of accomplishment and joy. A large majority of the students I taught demonstrated a high level of attentiveness and provided valuable feedback, which I considered to be a great sign of success as an educator. I was pleased with the feedback and comments I received from the students, as they demonstrated their active participation and improvement in learning.

#### **5.1- Class Observation: 1**

On the 6th of February, I participated in my initial observation session, during which I had the chance to watch English teacher Md. Shahin Islam engaging sixth-grade students in discussions about sentence topics. He engaged the students by providing various examples and explanations to help them better understand sentence classification. The lesson went for thirty minutes, during which I closely observed how the students interacted with the teacher and absorbed the lesson. A whiteboard and markers were provided in the classroom, facilitating an interactive and engaging learning environment for the students. The teacher effectively coordinated the class, ensuring that all students were actively involved in the lesson. Overall, it was a valuable experience for me to witness the teacher's teaching style and the students' learning process firsthand.

#### 5.2- Class Observation: 2

On the third of March, I completed my second observation in the same classroom and with the same teacher, Mr. Shahin Islam. During this session, he was engaging the students in a lesson about the use of prepositions .During my observation, I focused intently on the dynamics of the interactions between the students and the teacher, as well as their comprehension of the material being taught. The classroom was well-equipped with a whiteboard and markers, fostering an environment that was conducive to learning and creativity. I noticed that the teacher's coordination and communication skills were particularly effective in maintaining the students' interest and engagement throughout the lesson. Overall, my observation session proved to be quite productive, providing me with valuable insights into the teaching techniques employed and the level of student engagement in the English class.

5.3- Class Observation: 3

I attended my third observation session on the 20th of April, during which I observed English teacher Md. Shahin Islam conducting a lesson for a group of seven students. He engaged the students by providing various examples, delivering lectures, and writing on the white board. The lesson focused on topics such as the correct form of verbs, suffixes, and prefixes. There were a total of 29 students present on that day, and the class lasted for 30 minutes. I paid close attention to how the students interacted with the teacher and how well they understood the lesson. The classroom was equipped with a white board and markers, creating a conducive environment for learning. The teacher's coordination and communication with the students were effective in keeping the class engaged. Overall, it was a productive observation session where I gained insight into the teaching methods and student participation in the English class.

Initially, I defined the concept of tense and illustrated its various classifications on the board accompanied by relevant examples. I made an effort to provide the students with real-life scenarios demonstrating the use of different tenses. For instance, I presented a present tense example, "Afif eat rice," emphasizing the continuous nature of the action. Through such illustrations, I aimed to facilitate their understanding. Following the lesson, the students expressed their difficulty in grasping the material presented. Surprisingly, this feedback served as a source of motivation for me to enhance my teaching methods further. It was a moment of pride for me to receive such constructive criticism. During the session, I engaged the students with a variety of questions related to tenses, and I was pleased to see that most of them were able to provide correct responses. Additionally, I assigned them homework to reinforce their learning for the following day. To be candid, I experienced a sense of nerves on that particular day, as it marked my first experience as a classroom instructor. Despite this initial apprehension, I found genuine enjoyment in interacting with the students and guiding them through the lesson. In the end, the session proved to be a valuable learning experience for me as an aspiring educator.

On the 3rd of March 2024, I taught my second class to seventh-grade students. I was filled with excitement as I arrived at the school early that day. The classroom was packed

On the date of Thursday, May 2nd, 2024, I led a class for ninth-grade students focusing on the topic of "The Correct Form of Verbs". To begin the lesson, I outlined five key rules accompanied by relevant examples. Following this, I elaborated on each example to ensure full comprehension among the students. Once all examples were clearly understood, I assigned the students group tasks to solve together, emphasizing the importance of collaboration in problem-solving. This exercise aimed to instill in them the importance of working together to tackle challenges effectively. As a conclusion to the class, I provided

the students with various homework assignments to be completed by the next day, encouraging them to practice and reinforce their understanding of the topic outside of the classroom.

## 6.4-Learning from internship period :4

During my three-month internship, I was pleasantly surprised by the valuable experiences it provided. I particularly enjoyed the teaching aspect and gained insights into effectively engaging with students, a crucial skill for educators. Despite the initial challenge of delivering lesson plans within tight timeframes, I was able to enhance my class management skills. I not only learned from my own teaching experience but also benefited from the support of my colleagues, who generously shared resources and provided unwavering assistance throughout my internship. Reflecting on my journey, I now understand that being an exceptional teacher involves much more than achieving high marks. Effective communication, ethical behavior, student understanding, genuine passion for education, expertise in the subject matter, and skills in teaching methods are all important components in successful teaching.

## **6.5- Obstacles during the Internship :5**

During the initial week of my teaching career, I encountered challenges even though a well-planned lesson agenda for the students. I often exceeded the scheduled time by five to seven minutes, struggling with time management. Writing on the board also proved to be difficult as I lacked proficiency in this area. Seeking feedback on my handwriting, I realized that deciphering students' writing was also a challenge, especially when reviewing their work for errors, which took up a significant amount of class time. As a result, I had to take their assignments home for further grading. Additionally, staying updated with school events and unexpected holidays was challenging due to communication issues with the school administration. I made it a habit to seek regular updates before leaving the school to ensure better coordination.

## **Chapter:7 - Activities of the administrative**

On the 4th of April, 2024, I had the opportunity to serve as an examiner for the very first time. I was given the responsibility to collaborate with Mr. Alamgir Hossain in overseeing the examination hall and ensuring that the exam was conducted in an orderly manner. In the room, there were a total of 30 students who were taking the exam, and the exam questions were distributed promptly to begin the session. Additionally, I proactively offered assistance to students who were struggling with the questions, offering explanations to ensure that the testing process was conducted fairly and smoothly.

- During my time as an intern teacher at the institute, I noticed that the atmosphere provided for the students was conducive to their overall growth and development. The environment was carefully curated to support the students in every aspect of their learning journey.
- I have identified several issues with the commonly accepted belief. I often found that the classrooms were cramped, resulting in a noisy environment that made it difficult to focus on learning.
- Additionally, many of the classrooms were not properly equipped with digital technology, which limited our ability to engage with the material in a more interactive manner.
- The institute's strict adherence to academic and government regulations guaranteed that all students received equal and fair treatment in every aspect of their educational journey. This commitment to following rules and regulations instilled a sense of discipline and accountability among the student body, fostering a positive and harmonious learning environment for all.
- The school's water source has been found to contain high levels of ions, posing a potential health risk for both students and teachers. In response to this issue, the school administration is actively working to ensure that clean and safe drinking water is made available to all individuals on campus.
- Moreover, there was a notable shortage of qualified English teachers, which affected the quality of education provided to students. This lack of expertise in the subject area hindered the students' ability to develop their language skills effectively.
- In conclusion, it is worth highlighting that the academic system at this school is exceptional, boasting high standards for performance and recognition, which contribute to the overall success and reputation of the institution.
