Begun Bari High school ' is situation at Moista Para Birulia, Savar, Dhaka. It's educational institute identification number or EIIN is 108432. Furthermore, it's MPO type is yes and number is 2615181202, constituency no 19. There are 2 other MPO schools near it. But it's in complety Grameen area. Phone number is 01988214533. Foundation year is 1993. [1] This institute has four buildings. For high school, two buildings are using. One is for continuing regular classes. Another is for other activities. 12 teachers are present there and average age is 47 years. Most of them are male. They have done their hons and masters from respective subjects. They have got 7 days training at Cantonment public school and college last year as PT method came to rule in education instead of GTM. About 2000 students are studying in this school. Their uniform is full whither in colour. Boys are instructed to wear white paint - shirt. And girls have to wear white Salwar - kameez. Morning shift is only schedule for classes. 3 staffs are always presented there. It has a large playground, library. Unfortunately, it has no canteen. There's no setting of CCTV monitoring, garden, auditorium, common room. There's a prayer room. Laboratory and computer lab are just beside prayer room. Cultural programs happen in every year. There'sno system of transportation. Additionally, authority arranges a picnic in each year. There's no service of annual magazine. There is no service of getting staying opportunity. Common room isn't enough clean. Annual functions generally happen in the field of school. Students are encouraged to clean the field. Furthermore, students bring instruments of play which they like and almost daily they play in the field. Field is in quadrilateral shape. There's a multimedia classroom at 3rd floor.
