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

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Abstract

The main goal of this internship paper is to deal with the teaching techniques of the teachers in second language learning and to examine the current state of language education at secondary schools of Bangladesh. In this regard I had observed and conducted several classes at the school and gathered necessary information and data so that I can prepare the internship paper with proper justification. Through class observation I have learned how classes are taken traditionally in a secondary school. It helped me to gain ideas of the teachers about their strategies, methods of taking classes and controlling a classroom environment successfully. However, in class conduction, I have actually applied the knowledge that I have acquired both from the class conduction and my academic learning. This process helped me a lot. After the class conduction I was able to point out some limitations and possibilities of the education system of our country at the secondary schools. Again, I have also learned some really amazing ways to grab and hold the attention of the students throughout the class period. The entire process of this approach and experiences are elaborately portrayed in the later parts of this internship paper. All the necessary materials and ideas are included.

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Introduction:

In the field of communication, the important & impact of English Language cannot be denied at all. In fact, English is spoken as a second language in most of the countries of the world. Whether it is to communicate or complete with this modern world, we must need to master ourselves in English. Speaking of internship, it is the first step of my professional life. Here I have learned how to apply and utilize my subjective knowledge properly that I have acquired throughout my educational life. In this regard, I have worked under "Urban School & College" as a Language Teacher. Chapter – 3

Methodology:

- **3.1 Selecting the Level of Education for internship:** I have always wanted to do my internship from a school because teaching is something that has always fascinated me. I have a little teaching experience from here and there. Firstly, I wanted to do my internship from a primary school. But my honorable supervisor ma'am has told me that it will be better for me to do the internship from a higher secondary or from a secondary school. Then I wanted to apply in a college but it is very tough to get into a college for an internship. So, finally I chose a school in this regard. There are so many secondary private schools and the psychology of the secondary school students are easier to understand than primary school kids.

It was 12th February, 2024 when I went to the school to observe my first class at 10:00 am at Urban School & College, Dhamrai, Dhaka. The duration of the class was 40 minutes and 25 students were present in the classroom. The class was conducted by MD Mahtab Hossain, senior English Teacher of the school.

The class was taken on English first paper. The teacher introduced the students with me and told the students about the reason of my visit. All the students received me warmly. I have also greeted them well. Then I took a seat beside a student to have proper visual of the class.

Then the lecture session begun. The teacher told them what they will study today. He suggested a student to come forward and stand in the middle of the classroom and read out the passage loudly. He then explains the text in Bangla and picked up some words and translated them for the students. The students read the words loudly. He then gave the students some exercises given below the text and gave 10 minutes to them to solve. Surprisingly, most of the students respond on time. The teacher then appreciated the students for their response.

The teacher conducted the class in Bangla and he the presented and explained the topic well. All the students could relate to the topic which kept their attention throughout the class. The class was well organized.

Experience of the class:

It was 20th February, 2024 and I went to the school to observe my second class which was at 10:00 am at Urban School & College, Dhamrai, Dhaka. It was a sunny day and the temperature was up. The duration of the class was 40 minutes and 27 students were present in the classroom.

As they were already introduced with me from the previous class, they greeted me with politeness. I was greeted them back and took my seat at middle of the class to observe the classroom activity.

As the teacher started the lesson, I noticed something very common that happens on a classroom. Some students were gossiping among themselves during the class and were not paying attention to the lesson. It was noticed by the teacher. So, he stopped his lecture and shared an interesting story from his life. This time the students stopped gossiping among themselves and gave attention to the teacher.

Then the teacher read the topic by his own, explained it to the class. Then he gave some questions to solve in the class and some for the home work and then wrapped up the class for that day. At the end of the class, the teacher told me that for the hostile weather, students get tired soon and lose their attention. So, he told the story to bring their attention back to class and lesson.

Experience of the class:

It was March 2nd, 2024 and I went to observe my third class at 10:00 am at Urban School & College, Dhamrai, Dhaka. It was a bit cold and windy. The class duration was 40 minutes and around 29 students were present at the classroom.

The class was on sentence structure and rules of English second paper. The teacher first introduced the students with some basic structure of that a sentence consists of and then he proceeded to teach some rules of a sentence. For better understanding the teacher repeated everything and gave a summary on the topic. Making sure everyone has understood the lesson, the teacher then gave them some exercises from the book. After 10 minutes he gave them the answers on the board and told the students to make correction to their papers if needed. This time, not everyone could answer it correctly. So, the teacher explained the exercises again for better understanding. After taking feedback from the class, the teacher then gave some more exercises for homework and ended the class.

Chapter – 6

Class Conduction

Class Conduction-1

On 5th of March, 2024 and I conducted my first ever class of class 9 at 10:00 am at Urban School & College, Dhamrai, Dhaka. I was both excited and nervous at the same time. The weather was comfortable. The duration of the class was 40 minutes and there were 22 students present in the class.

That day I was supposed to take a class on "nature and environment" from the textbook. After a little introduction I gave them a pre-idea about the topic. Then I requested a student to come forward and read the passage from the text loudly. After that, I pointed out some vocabularies from the text and wrote them on the board. Then I translated the words in Bangla so that they can understand the text properly. I then explained the topic entirely in Bangla and told some stories that are relatable to the discussed topic.

After that I told the students to solve some questions from the text within 10 minutes. The students were very smart and could easily solve the questions. I then thanked the students and ended up the class.

Class conduction-2

On 7th of March 2024, I set my mind to conduct my second class at 10 am at Urban School & College, Dhamrai, Dhaka. The class duration was 40 minutes and 26 students were present in the classroom.

The topic was on "Degree" of English second paper. Firstly, I gave a brief on what is a degree and how does it work on English grammar as well as English language. Then I explained them the three types of degrees with some relatable examples. After explaining the basics, I went to teaching how to transform from one type of degree to another. For the first class, it was getting a bit harder for the students to understand the topic entirely. However, they all were interested in the class which helped a lot. To further evaluate their understanding, I made up some examples with their involvement and told them to solve it. I was really amazed to see that except some issues, they could actually solve the questions

easily. After taking their feedback I gave some exercises for their homework and the class was over successfully.

Class conduction-3

It was March 10, 2024. I went to take my third class at 10 am at Urban School & College, Dhamrai, Dhaka. The class duration was 40 minutes and 28 students were present in the classroom. For that day, I selected to teach a topic from the syllabus which is writing a dialogue. It is a topic of English first paper. Firstly, I explained what is a dialogue and how it should be written. I then discussed some important criteria of a dialogue writing. Now, when I was student, my teachers used to give topics on the dialogue matter and we used to memorize them directly from the book. But sadly, we used to suffer in the exam hall as the topic was out of the syllabus and we could not answer them. The dependency on memorizing only didn't work for us in exams, not on real life. So, I decided to influence the students to imagine themselves in a certain situation and make them write speeches by themselves. At first, they were a bit nervous to make mistakes. However, I appreciated their attempts by overlooking their mistakes and focused on correction. This experiment was a success by the will of Allah. After taking their feedback I ended up the class for that day.

Overall Findings

This internship project has taught me a lot. Here are some findings that I have pointed out from classroom observation. Such as:

- **7.1 Lesson preparation:** For taking class at Urban School & college, it is a must to make a lesson plan. Teachers make a lesson plan for all the respective subjects. This makes it easy to both conduct the class for the teachers and also for the students as they can take preparation on a topic before going to class. Such initiative is very convenient and effective in both teaching and learning process at the school.
- **7.2 Lesson delivery:** The teachers deliver their lecture making sure that it is enriched in content, focuses on the topic and easy in language. As a result, the target is fulfilled in the classroom Botha by the teacher and student. Speaking in English along with Bangla, encourages the students to get used to adapt with the language simultaneously, ensures better understanding at the classroom.
- **7.3 Classroom management:** The classroom is spacious and has all the facilities to ensure better teaching and learning experience. From the teachers' desk to the last bench of the classroom, it is easy to focus on and listen carefully.
- **7.4** Use of technology: All the classroom has microphone facility which makes it convenient to conduct classes as the classes are huge with large number of students. However, it is a necessity of time to include projector and multimedia facilities in the classroom.

Findings of Teaching Experience

Taking classes at a school professionally has taught me how challenging it is to explain and manage such a huge number of students at the same time. I believe every student is different, their way of absorbing the same idea is different. So, every time I went on a class, it felt like I was doing it for the first time. Here are some findings from the classes that I have conducted:

- **8.1 Lesson preparation:** From the lesson plan, I knew the topics prior. So, before going to the class, I always make sure to study the topic myself and find out different ways to presentation the same idea. I hope this strategy will influence the students to think about the same topic in different perspective.
- **8.2 Lesson delivery:** While delivering the lessons, I tried to give examples to make the topic relatable to the students. Again, I ask students probable question while explaining the topic. This makes it easy for me to evaluate their understanding, interest and concentration into the classroom.
- **8.3** Use of Language: Following the teachers I have tried to deliver the lecture in Bangla along with easily comprehensive English sentences.
- **8.4 Time management:** Time is a big factor in taking classes. I make sure to make the time as effective as possible.
- **8.5 Student Feedback:** After every class, I ask the students whether they have any questions around the topic and my teaching and we often discuss how to make the lesson more convenient to understand. Their cooperative behavior has made the teaching experience into next level.

Recommendations

9.1 Recommendation for My Institution:

After working as an intern at Urban School & College for a while, I have observed the value of discipline being maintained in the institution. From the root level to the officials, in every sphere of activities, disciplines are followed strictly. This practice has made it possible for the institution to bring goodwill every year.

However, there are some recommendations I would like to mention for the interest of my project paper. Such as:

- There are a huge number of students in a classroom which is quite difficult to handle. It would be better if the classes are decided into multiple sections.
- Multimedia facilities should be added to the classroom
- Students should be made acquainted with modern technology for learning purpose
- Teachers should encourage the students to use English while communicating in the classroom.

9.2 Recommendation for Myself:

- I should try my best to explain the complicated topics easily.
- I should find out and met up the curiosity of the students in the classroom.
- I should try to involve the students in the classroom activities as much as I could.
- I should encourage the students to make mistakes and acknowledge them gracefully to learn from them.
- I should put more emphasis on creative writing rather than memorizing without understanding.

My Experiment as an Intern

My experiment as an intern at Urban School & College:

It is my privilege to be a part of Urban School & College. The institute has given me the opportunity to explore through a completely different experience. While I have taken regular classes there experimenting through the traditional methods of teaching English in the classroom, I have also applied some methods by myself.

In one of my classes, I saw the students having issues understanding the sentence structure. In the contemporary teaching style, teachers often begin with the structure and then the example. As a result, things get harder for the students to understand as English is our second language. To eradicate these issues, I thought to turn it upside down. Meaning, I teach the example first and then extract the structure out of it. I am so glad that the students found it more convenient.

Again, as it is a 40-minute class, I try to take a break after 20 minutes. A quick 5-minute break consists of storytelling or doing some interesting stuff that refreshes the mind of the students. Both of these experiments were a success. From the teachers I got the response that students are more interested in a class which is taken a bit differently than the traditional methods.

Conclusion

From my very childhood, teaching is something that has always fascinated me. While playing the "teacher- student" game with my cousins, I have never thought that someday this is where I will be. It was such an amazing experience. I consider myself privileged enough to be able to work as an intern at Urban School & College, Dhamrai, Dhaka. Such a reputed institute has provided me an opportunity not only to work here but also taught me what it takes to be at the position of a teacher. My concept for the teachers has changed, my respect for them has increased for sure.

Being in a classroom with such a huge number of students is itself a difficult task. But the way the teachers manage the classroom environment and help building the future generations with their utmost care is worth respect.

As an extrovert myself, I can comfortably get mixed up with new people. But it is to mention that the classroom energy has intimidated my extrovert self and pushed me to overcome the challenge. Through this internship, I have learned to be humbler, more patient and more confident. I am very grateful to all the students and teachers of Urban School & College, Dhamrai, Dhaka, for accepting me as part of their intuition.






