

1.5 Class Observation Report

Class 1

First day I observe one class which was class 9 section group of science. English-1st paper on 10thMarch 2019. Along with the class teacher Md. Shah Alam. We entered the class at a time and he introduced me with the students. The class was decorated by the varieties scenery. I knew that school authority provided computer and one projector for special class this class one of them. This class was U system. Boys and girls sit in the separate benches. At first teacher called the attendance of the students most of them were present (41/46) on this day. School authority had a rule if anyone misses a class he/ she must be fine 30 taka otherwise they are not allow in the class. I noted how teacher were teaching them in the classroom. The teacher asks the question about previous class if anyone don't answer his punishment. He was taught unit 3 lesion 6. I capture some photos. In that time teacher take permission from the student I pick up a call. He picked up a call and crying than class mood has changed. Then teacher call me and say now I can't take the class please you finish the class. I asked the teacher what happen Sir our colleague Md. Sadekur Rahman Gazi had died. Suddenly my tears were coming. He is my referral teacher on the other hand he is my sister's father in law. Sir went to teaching room every teacher was crying on this room. In this time one of my students was senseless. Then I thought if I can't manage the students more student will be unconscious. I said hazrat Umar (Razi:) story when our Prophet Mohammad (SM:) had died than Hazrat Umar (Razi:) said if anyone told our Prophet had died I will separate his head from the body than Hazrat Abu Bakar (Razi:) said that every animal must be die Allah said in the Ouran. Don't cry only pray for him as if Allah gives him paradise. Then they had normal. After few minutes later Headmaster announcement that today we have no class. If you want to go home you can go, I was astonished that any students don't get out from the school gate. Lot of student went to school mosque and reading the Quran. He was religious teacher.

Class 2

The second class which I observed was class seven, English-1st paper on 11th March 2019. It was English second paper. All students are female. Every class has minimum three sections. It was class seven and section B, room number 209. This class started at 10:00 am to11:00 pm. This class teacher was Monir Hossain. We entered the room and he introduces me with them and teacher said to me that tell about yourself. I was telling about myself in English than I understood that they week in English language when I used code mixing than they feel comfortable. In this class there was no extra sit on the other hand more students from the sits. This day student was attended the class 57 students out of 67. At first teacher called the attendance of the students but most of them were present on this day because of teacher's mourning and every student put on the dress black base. I observed how teacher were teaching them in the classroom, the class 5 minutes for attendance than 10 minutes discuss about previous class and 45 minutes take new topics. In this day he wrote five superlative degrees for converting comparative degree how to change superlative to comparative. All students complete their task he check only 10 notes than 10 students shows all notes than he started new topics. At first he wrote in the black board students also write with them after finishing than he taught.

Class 3

Third class which I observed was class 7th section B English second paper on 11th march 2019. Maximum student was present 59 students out of 68. Along with the teacher (Md. Habibul Bashar) room no 101 this class duration was 50 minutes but only for this day this class duration 30 minutes because of teacher's death. After class they arranged a meeting. At first he introduced me and declared that if anyone talks loudly I will subtract your number at the time of final exam. Every week he takes an exam and it was quiz day and topic was "Your Village" Time 15 minutes. Maximum student wrote 3 to 5 sentence and he show me their notes and told about student lot of student don't know how to read English. He is guest teacher in the school. He told me that do you have any idea how I can improve their level. I suggest him at first you can make some group every group minimum 2 or 3 group leader who can read English they will teach them. A teacher was entered the room and say who can read the Quran 20 student stood. Some of write his name 2 para the Quran will read and someone 1 Para for their teacher. Whole students totally read the Quran 37 times.

1.6 Teaching Experience

I am totally new in classroom teaching in the classroom. I don't feel nervous because I am a tutor and I have a couching center. Without tension I took the class. When I entered the room I felt a teacher.

Class 1

It is universal truth that I felt that I am a teacher for few moments. I thanked my supervisor because he gave me task as a teaching profession for completing my internship. At first I called the attendance of the students most of them were present (45/46) on this day. I took first class 9 (section A science group). They talked with each other than I told the student which grammar part you have problem? They replied me that tense. I declared the students if anyone listen to my class after death you have no need to study about tense. Totally they were silence. I told them first 10 minutes entertainment or last 10 minutes they choose first 10 minutes. At first I start the class by the jocks and comedy story. 50 minutes class 20 minutes already done I taught the students present tense and past tense other teacher has come in the room all of student request to the teacher please sir give us 20 minutes. Sir gave me more time I finished the future tense only 10 minutes. It is interesting matter that the class teacher was Md. Shah Alam, he also attended the classroom first 30 minutes. The Headmaster called him than he left the classroom.

Class 2

After completing my first class I have took one hour break third period teacher sent me class seven (sections B). I took the class on 12th march 2019 at 12:00 pm to 12:50 pm. In short time I changed my lesson plan. At first I called the attendance of the students most of them were present (66/68) on this day. First five minutes I took the class without Bengali but student don't understand anything some of student request me please sir if you use bangle we would understand easily. Then I apply my rules without entertainment class is not possible. I am a joker, specially my class teacher Shamsi Ara Huda listen to my jock on the class time. At first I told them who is interested to tell jocks. In this class all of students were female. Because male female are separated section. Lot of girls raise their hands I called some of students requested me to tell some jocks. I told two jocks. Both of happy and silence the room than I continued my class. In this class I took the class on conditional sentence and how to identify sentence. Identifying sentence this topic is so easy I write down the five rules. For identifying sentence, there is no way without these rules for identifying sentence. Only ten minutes I finished the topics. Then I told other jocks and continued another topics conditional sentence. In short time me able to finish the topic.

Class 3

Without brake teacher sent me another class because this class is last class for that day. Third day they arrange a duamahfil for the teacher who had died. I have taken my last class with class seven sections A. This class time 30 minutes for that day. In this class I did not waste my time I sent a paper and told them that write your name and roll number and puss to your friends. Most of the students were present (67/67) on this day. Two English teachers for every class. This class was Md. Habibul Bashar which class I have taken. He finished present tense. I applied my own technique than I started my class. Already I finished past tense how to identify past tense in this time some of students took permission and entered the room. They said to me that we need some volunteer only scout member but they were not agreed to go. I told them that your friend will teach this class tomorrow, than they went. Finishing the lesion I write ten sentences and told write the tense name on the black board one student will write only one tense name beside the sentence. It was my last class. After finishing my class I went to teacher's room. Headmaster told me that you must be attended the duamahfil. They arrange the duamahful in the hall room. In the parties I captured some photos.

1.7 Overall Findings

- Teachers and students relationship are friends in the classroom father and children outside of classroom.
- ✤ Without fair student can ask the question easily.
- Every classes natural light and air has come easily.
- School authorities make some rules that are why every student has come in the school regularly.
- Class six to eight boys and girls are separate sections.
- ✤ Beside general knowledge student have got religion knowledge.
- ✤ They would like to entertainment class system.

- > Every class should be got projector facility.
- > Class should be interesting movement for few minutes.
- > As class room are fix so they should increase more section.
- School authority should decorate more educational environment that will be easy to learn for the students.
- > They should use white board in digitalization era black board is not comfortable.
- > Strong vocabulary foundation they can arrange a quiz ever week or every month.


