In the absence of nation law nobody obeys the rules of plastics dumping, recycling, reuse or reproduction.

The waste management of Bangladesh is so poor if compared with other countries. Because of this poor management, many plastics such as plastics, glass, paper or perishable products are not managed separately. So many of the waste products are mixed into the soil and deep water.

In urban areas, though the city corporation fixed the specific are the dump the waste or plastic waste but there is lacking of proper plastic waste management. The final destination of this plastic wastes go to the river or cannel or some places which are not dwelling place or after burring the open place, the fire was set .is seriously affect the environment.

In rural areas, being unawarenessthey don't know the harmful effect of the plastic. There is a culture of throwing waste here and there. Especially the waste is thrown behind the living house or cannels. There is no specific places to dump the waste as like City Corporation.

- The government should make some specific laws for plastic waste management.

- Emphasis on producing a massive number of jute bags which can cover the needs of plastic bags.

- Some products like as rice, wheat, fertilizer, sugar, fish and duck food should compulsory to package by jute bags.
- The government should producing jute bags or by the providing facilities to the private firm to produce jute bags with reasonable price.
- The government should impose fine in case of
 - -First time use of plastic bags fine not more than 5,000 take
 - Second time use of plastic bags fine not mpore than 1,0000taka
 - Third time use of plastic bags fine not more than 500,000 take and imprisonment not more than 3 months.
