






Fig: 07-The news has been published on 01 May 2019



Poor road system is key obstacle to development in Dhaka

Dhala is one of the most densely populated mega cities. world. Urban expansion, industries and employment opportunities is the main causes of excess population in Dhaka. The rapid growth of population creates a lot of problems which badly affects the development of the country.

Road network problem is one of the biggest problems in Dhaka city. Most of the parts of entire Dhaka are affected badly by road problems. Transportation of Dhaka mainly depends on road based system but there is lack of functional roads here. Mostly narrow and twisted roads are the main cause of road problem.

In general it is said that a city is supposed to have 25% roads out of its total area where Dhaka city don't have even half percentage of it. As population is increasing day by day, travel demands is also increasing but the condition of the roads is extremely poor.

The main transportation system used in Dhaka city is public buses and for this reason the roads should be wider but in reality they are not. On the other hand cars,

buses, trucks, rickshaws and other vehicles use the same road without any specific lanes which creates heavy traffic. Lack of parking lot and turning spaces also have an impact on traffic movements.

Footpath problem is another problem of road network in Dhaka city. In recent years, footpaths in Dhaka city improved but there are some roads where still walloway facilities is bad as the hawkers and retailers occupies most of the footpaths. There are many areas where some people use footpaths as toilet which creates problem for walking


and there are also many dustbins close to footpaths.

It can be seen in Dhaka that there are many multi storied permanent residential and commercial buildings, shopping malls and different types of shops built on both side of the roads. Many buildings are still under construction which makes roads narrow. As a main part of transportation, public buses are many in Dhaka city but there are very few places for bus stoppage and most of the public buses stop by the roadside without considering the condition of the roads.

There are some roads from where it is very difficult to reach to the main road. Due to narrow or bad condition of roads, most of the time it is not possible for a rickshaw to move without stopping cars and other vehicles, Extremely bad roads system can be obstacle for the development. of the country. Not only urban expansion, urban planning should also be

proper for road system. RAJUK's Urban planner Ashraful Islam in an interview said that as the population of the city is increasing day by day, road capacity is decreasing and mainly this is the reason of another biggest problem which is traffic jam.
