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<u>Abstract</u>

The purpose of this project paper is to provide an overview of the situation of Online Classes in English and the techniques of teaching during the Outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic in Bangladesh. Online classes have been added a new dimension in technology. Though our typical life has been halted because of this Corona crisis however, online platform has assisted us to continue the education process. Fundamentally, in this paper we attempt to discover the strengths and weaknesses of online classes in English and we review the fundamental situation of students that how they are learning in this situation. We have chosen two classes to observe the teaching methods and the strategies of educators and a class for conduction so that we could get a clear idea from the English language teaching and learning situation of online classes. This project intends to know the teaching methods that teachers are utilizing in this Corona pandemic situation for online classes of English language and their outcome. How far the objectives are being fulfilled is also a significant part of the study.

This paper is written to bring up all the weaknesses of English language learning techniques so we can reorder them further with all the strengths, qualities and potential techniques. Moreover, a few suggestions are given to the part of "Overall Findings" as per the two observations and the experience of class conduction.

This paper have been developed as part of a quantitative study, and attempts to, on the basis of the findings, find out the solutions of the troubles encountered in online teaching-learning classes.

Chapter – I

Introduction

Introduction

The Covid-19 pandemic has made worldwide difficulty that has deeply affected each area of our life. Particularly, in our education system, the outbreak of Covid-19 has changed the entirety technique for conducting classes. This is also another experience for students but more interesting for them.

All around the world, over 1.2 billion students are out of the classroom. On March 18, 2020 Bangladesh education ministry announced all educational institutions to stay closed due to Corona virus outbreak like other nations. However, as the teachers were stressed over the study of students so they began to take online classes everywhere on the world. This pandemic situation caused surprising changes in education system. Starting online classes were difficult in Bangladesh as many of our old educators are not so fast and known with advance technology but still they worked hard to stay up with the world. Things are currently not the same as past actual classes. We noticed and prepared a report dependent on the situation of online classes in English during this Covid-19 outbreak. English language is a global medium of communication and broadly spoken everywhere on the world. English has additionally become the medium of guidance in Education in most of universities and advanced education institutions of the world. In Bangladesh, English is a foreign language and learning English is necessary for all level students and pretty much every student began to learn this from the primary day of their school life. Because of our nation's poor instructive frameworks the greater part of the students are not familiar at speaking and don't have adequate information on English. 4. Class Conduction: I needed to take a class in Textile Engineering office. Observing the other two classes assisted a great deal with experiencing this class conduction. The length of the class was 15 minutes. Using the "Google Meet" application, I took the class.

Class Observation-1

The teacher began his class with pleasantly welcoming his students. Then he started his lecture by following a PDF book on computer screen. The students could understand his lecture for his proper speech cooperative learning. For better understanding of the students, sometimes the teacher provided his lecture in Bangla but most of the time he provided his lecture in proper English. He gave the class record to BLC for the students who missed the class. In the entire class, a few students were selected randomly by the teacher and told them to read a verse for the class. By doing that he made it sure that the students were listening his lecture attentively. After completing the entire discussion, there was question-answering session and then the teacher finished the class.

Strengths of the Teacher:

- ✤ The teacher use his voice effectively- speak with inflection
- ◆ The teacher is a good language teacher with extraordinary presentation skill
- The teacher had an incredible possession over English language
- ✤ The teaching is organized with subject matter
- There was a superb learning environment through the entire class

Class Observation-2

Firstly, the teacher welcomed her students and told them what she was going to teach them. The teacher was very enthusiastic and friendly in answering questions to the students. Before starting the new lecture, she repeated the theme of previous lecture for better understanding of her students. The teacher followed the PDF book for giving lecture and used real life examples for better understanding. She shared her computer screen to show them the PDF book to the topic. The teacher then asked students whether they had understood or not and gave tasks to students then. She was very clever to ask questions randomly so that everyone could understand her. She was aware of the condition of her students. She used DIU BLC to share all the materials including class records so that those who missed the class could watch it later.

Overall Findings

1. Organizations:

The organizations of class timetable and goals of the lessons were managed properly. The two teachers had understood their approaches so that students could give their opinions comfortably. The two teachers had the ability to take the control of classes rapidly. Overall the classroom management was optimal.

2. Subject Matter Content:

The two teachers had good knowledge in the subject matter and they had selected efficient lesson plans for the students to develop valuable study skills such as summarizing and extracting central theme from texts and answered patiently to the students question quietly. For choosing advantageous learning activities, students were able to answer willingly all the questions in the end of the class and they enjoyed to answer the questions.

3. Use of Materials and Teaching Technique:

Because of this Corona pandemic situation, the classes I observed, both were online classes and so they used the materials- PDF and PPT files to teach the students. The PDF and the PPT file were extremely educational and there were so many examples of real life experiences which assisted the students with being more connected. One teacher gave the chance to the students of self-learning, with the goal that students could get the interest on the lesson and learn without help from anyone else. Other teacher clarified the lesson with the real life experiences, examples and utilized storyboard to make the lesson simpler and asked for examples from students after each point. The two teachers utilized meeting to generate new ideas. Both of them made the students participative and dynamic by their efficient lessons.

4. Use of Language:

The teachers utilized native language and English to make the lecture simple and understandable to the students. As both of classes based on literature and it would be helpful to learn target language for the students because of using target language rather than Bengali language.

5. Students Engagement and Environment:

Students were enough associated with the teacher during class. But I felt that physical classes were more effective where teacher could understand the students more than online classes. Eye contacts were too missing in online classes which are another approach to stay connected to the students. Online classes are additionally successful however I felt the class time of online classes should be 1 hour rater than 1.30 hours. Since I observed that after an hour students began to lose their interest to stay connected with the class.

6. Lesson Delivery:

Teachers provided the objectives of the lesson maintaining a perfect time management. One thing might have added greater happiness to the class that is humor. Sometimes, one of the teachers delivered speech so fast, which was difficult for the students to understand the lecture.

Finding from Conducted Class

What I wanted to achieve:

I needed to ensure the understanding of the students what I was providing to them and I wanted to ensure the objectives of the lecture are being given to them appropriately. They perceived the topic properly and their participation improved the class.

Few Drawbacks I Noticed During Conducted Class:

I believe being confident and having commanding voice are some obligatory characteristics of each teacher should have. I was successful for having confidence and commanding voice but, I was a little bit nervous as it was my first time to conduct a class as a teacher. Other things, like communications with students and giving the lecture all had been done very effectively.
