

Though I learned Bengali typing through my university, after a long term of practice during my internship, I can type in Bangla and English so fast and comfortably.


#### **Professionalism:**

We learned how to use 5W's and 1H for news writing, how to build up a news story with an "Inverted Pyramid Structure", the process of editorial writing, ethics, and standards of journalism.
