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
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

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
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ABSTRACT

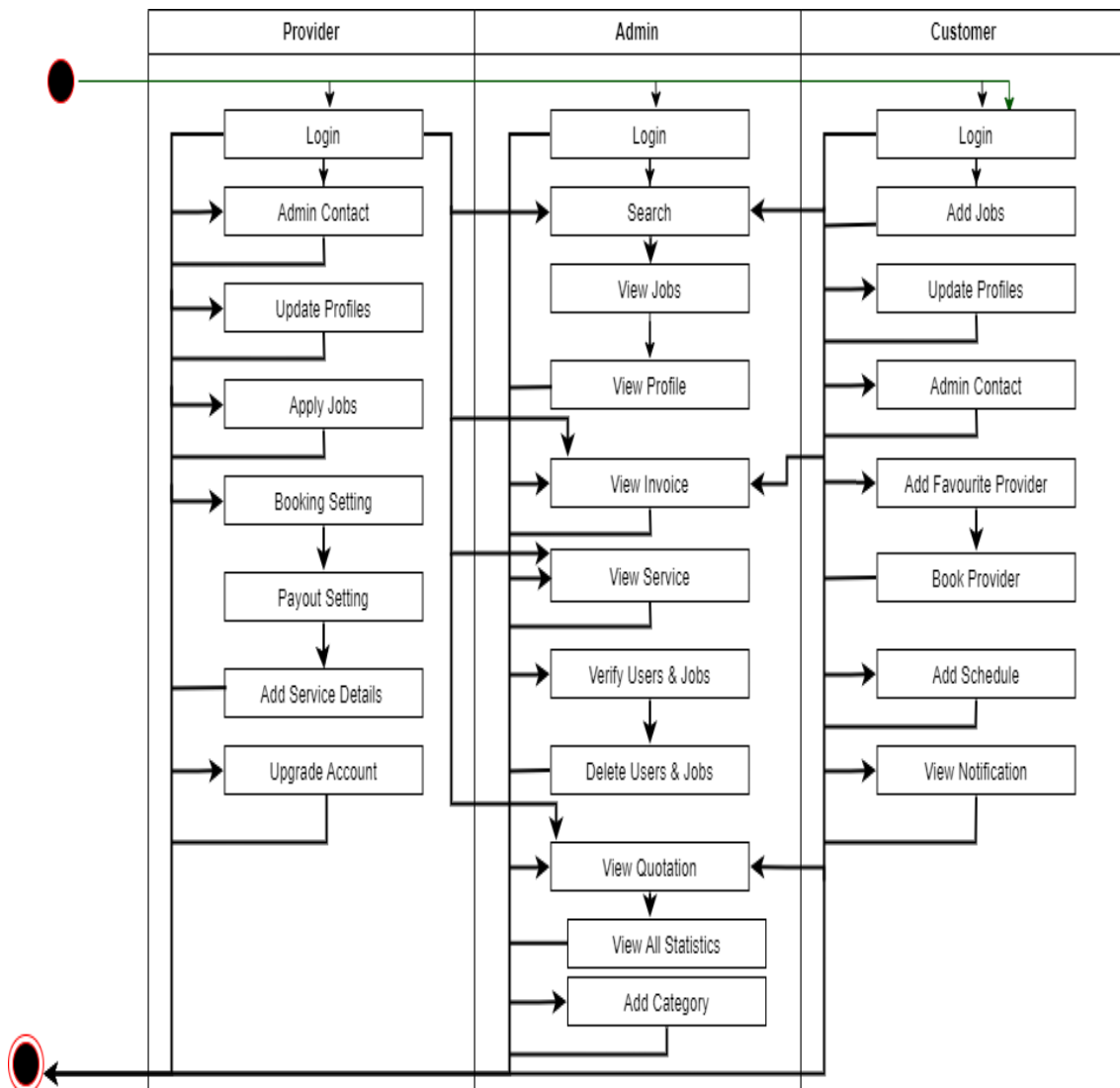


Figure 3.1.1: Business Process Model

The business process model is the model which helps us to know the workflow and potential improvement of a system [2]. Figure 3.1.1 shows the business process model of our system.

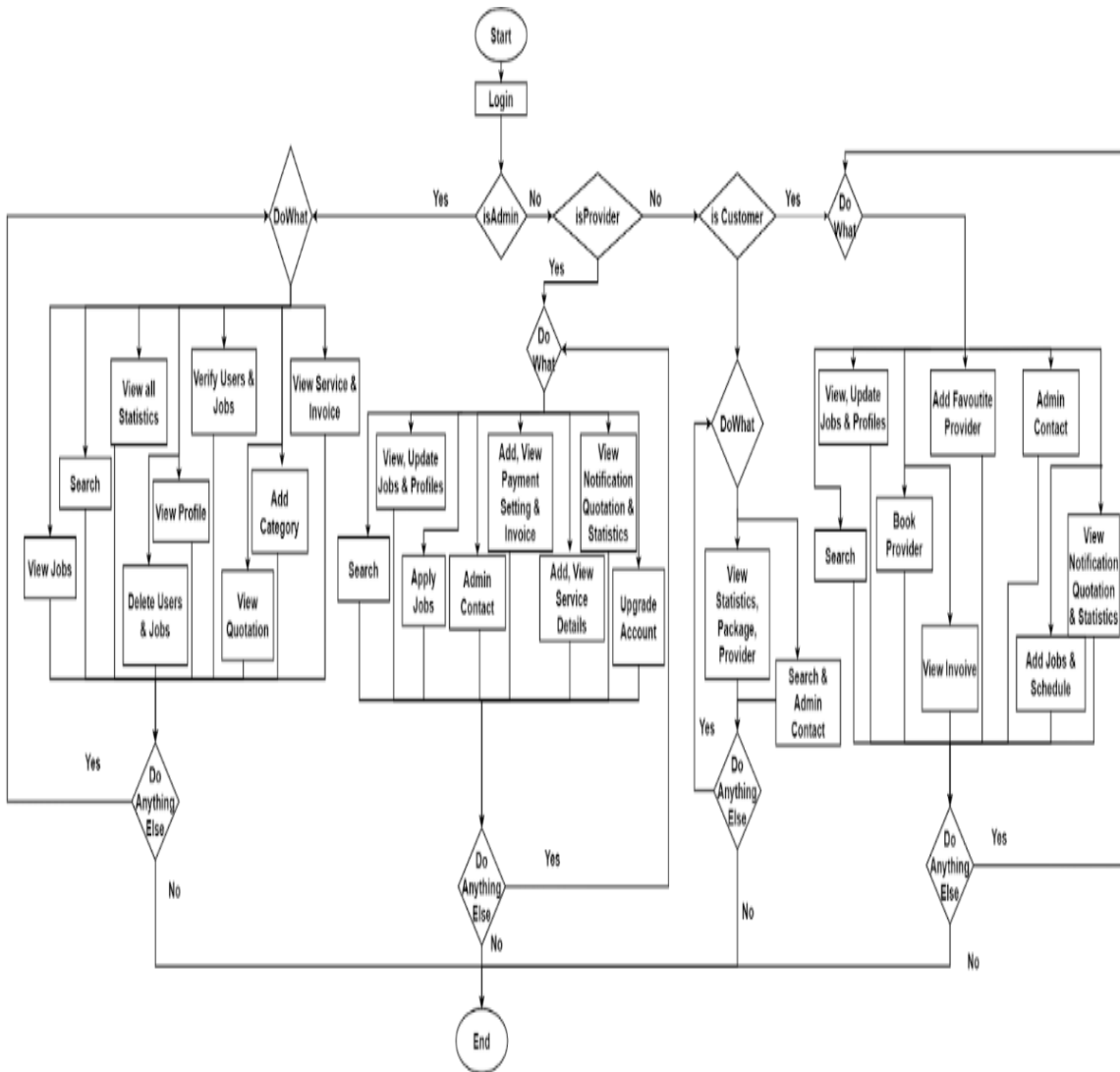


Figure 3.2.2: Flow Chart

Every system has a workflow that can be easily expressed with a flowchart. Figure 3.2.2 is the flowchart of our system that shows the workflow of our system.

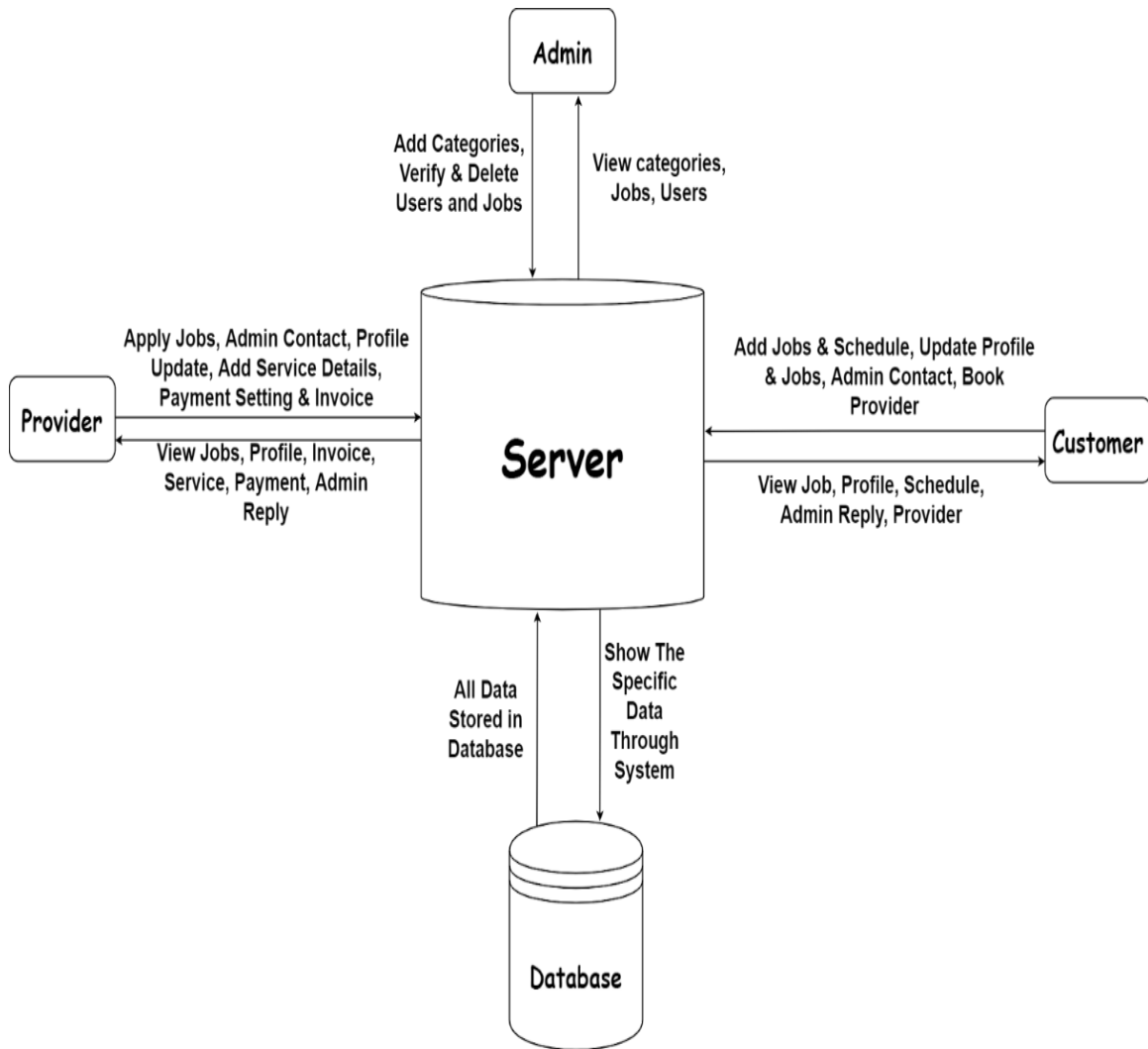


Figure 3.2.3: Data Flow Diagram

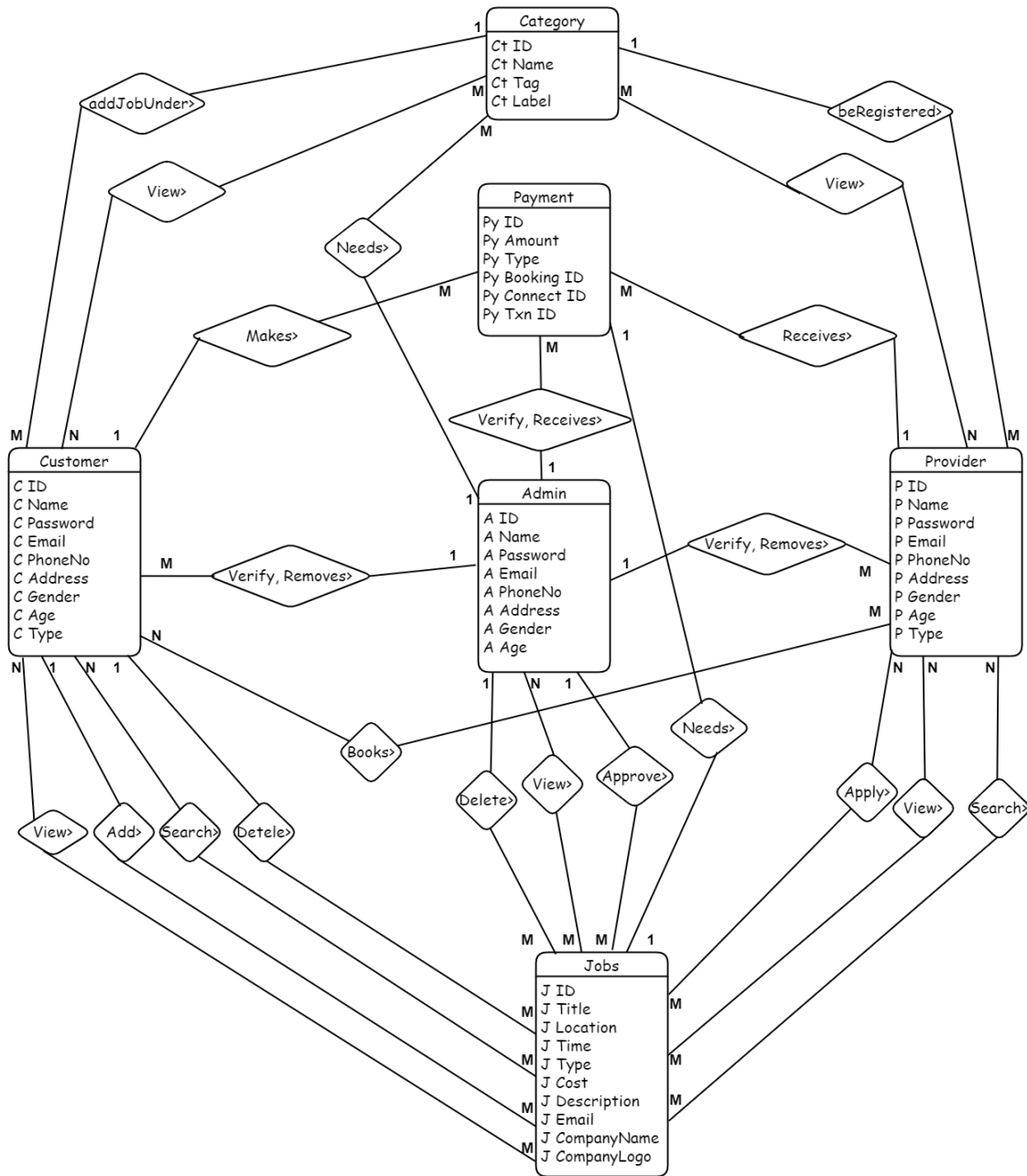


Figure 3.2.4: Entity Relationship Diagram

Figure 3.2.4 is the Entity-Relationship Diagram of our system.

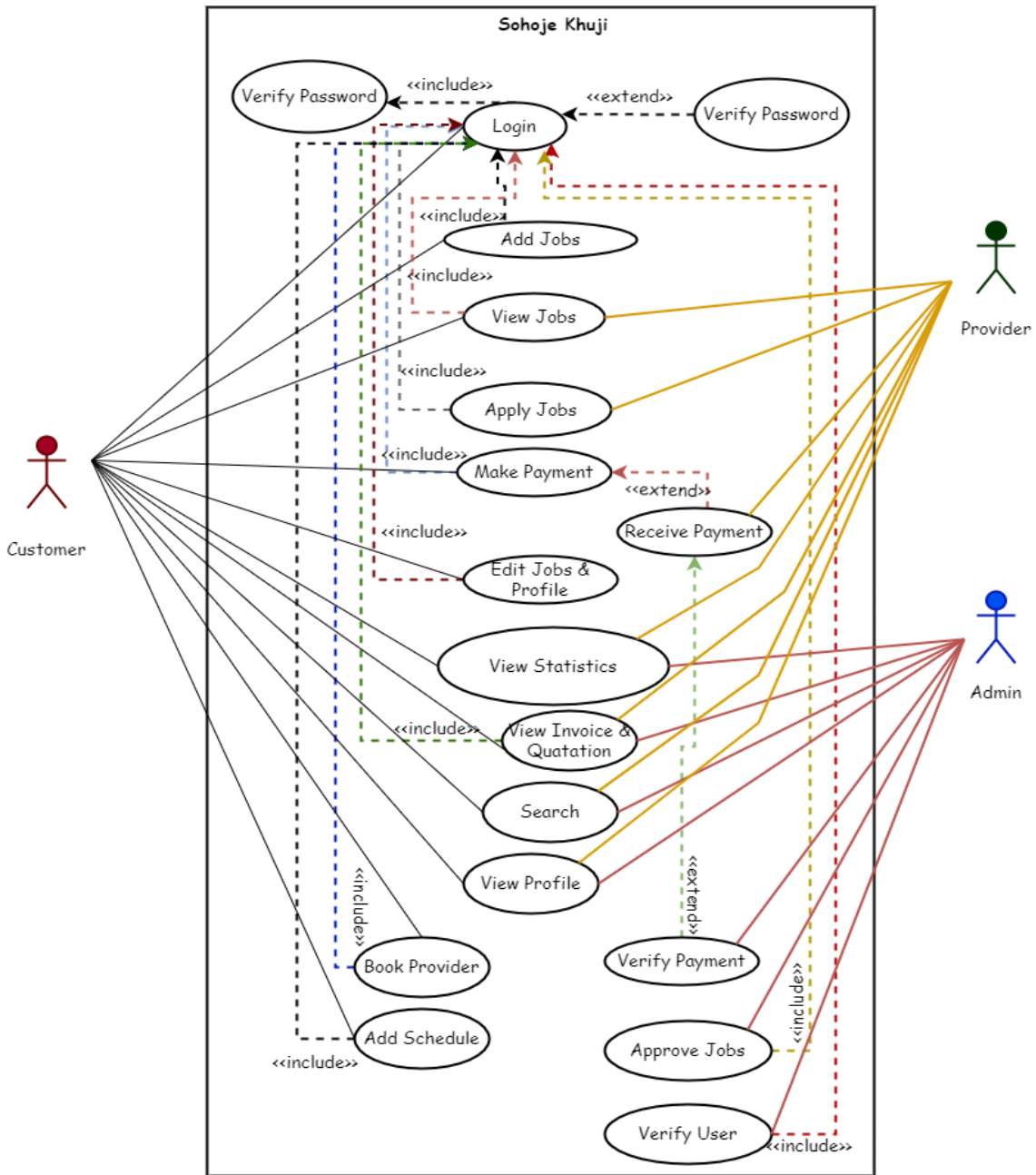


Figure 3.3.1: Use Case Modeling

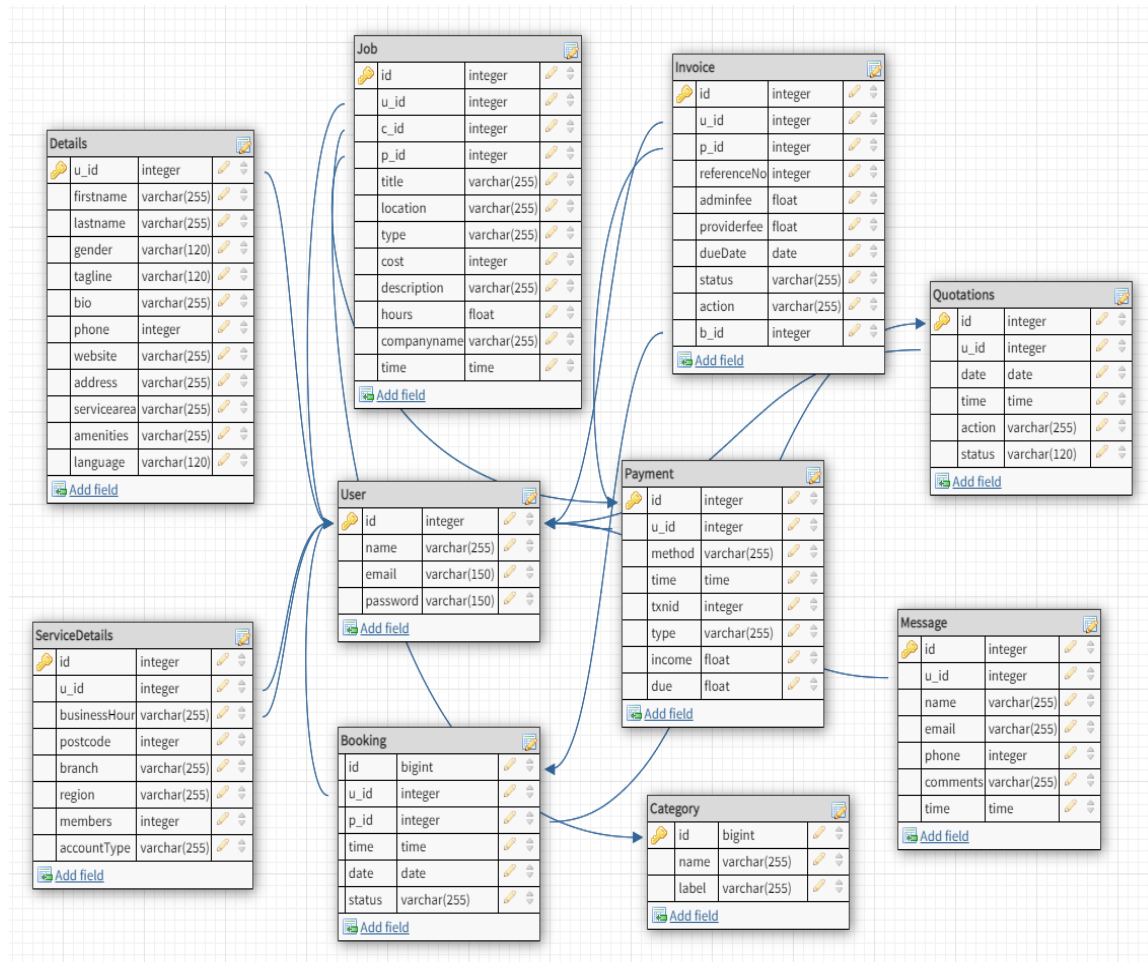


Figure 3.4.1: Logical Data Model

structure so that we can easily gather information about the domain. Figure 3.4.1 is the Logical Data model of our website.

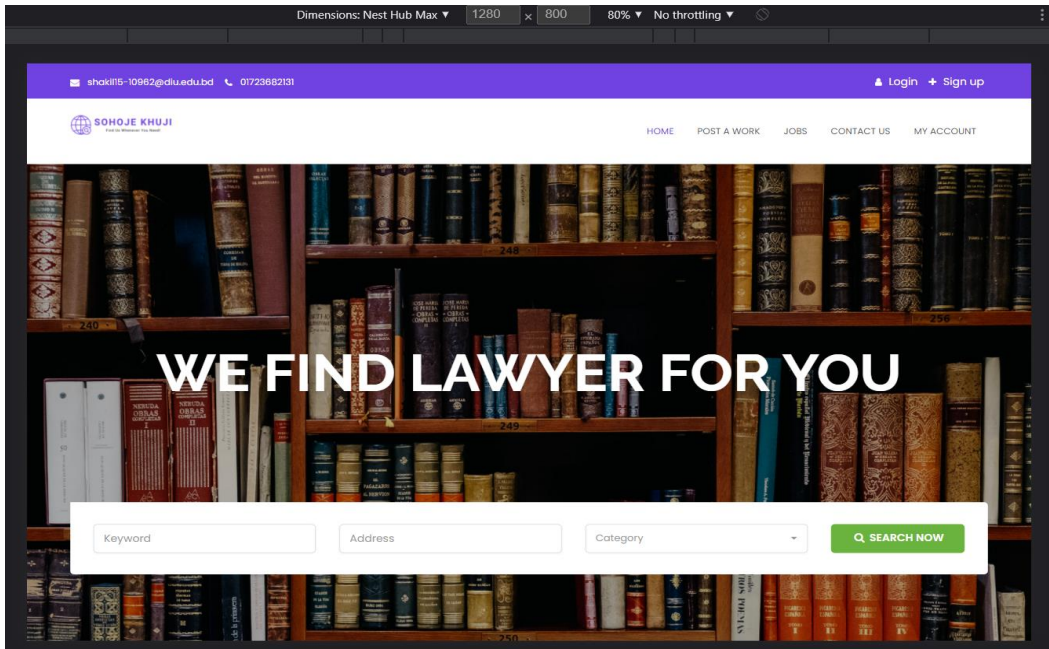


Figure 3.5.1: Homepage on Next Hub Max (Display 1280 x 800)

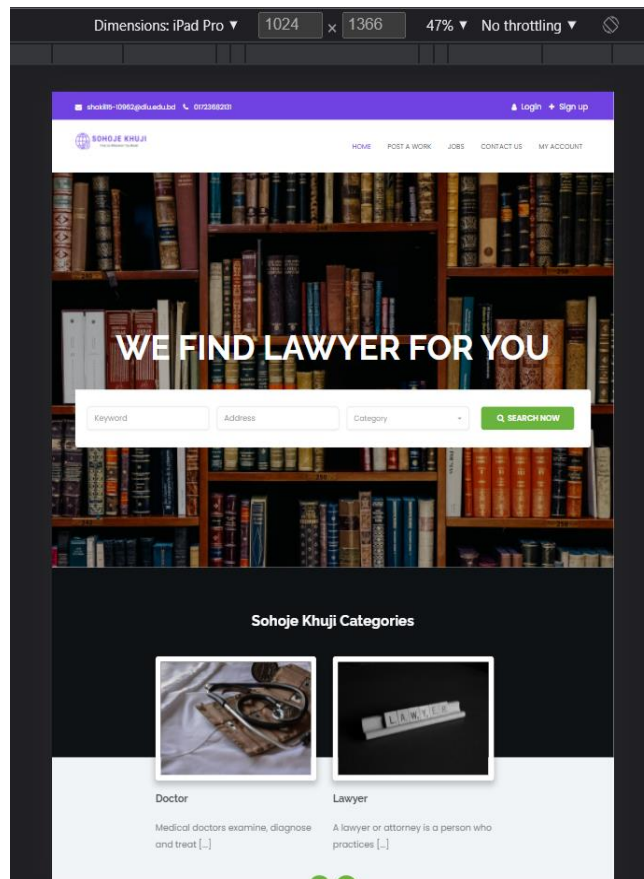


Figure 3.5.2: Homepage on iPad Pro (Display 1024 x 1366)

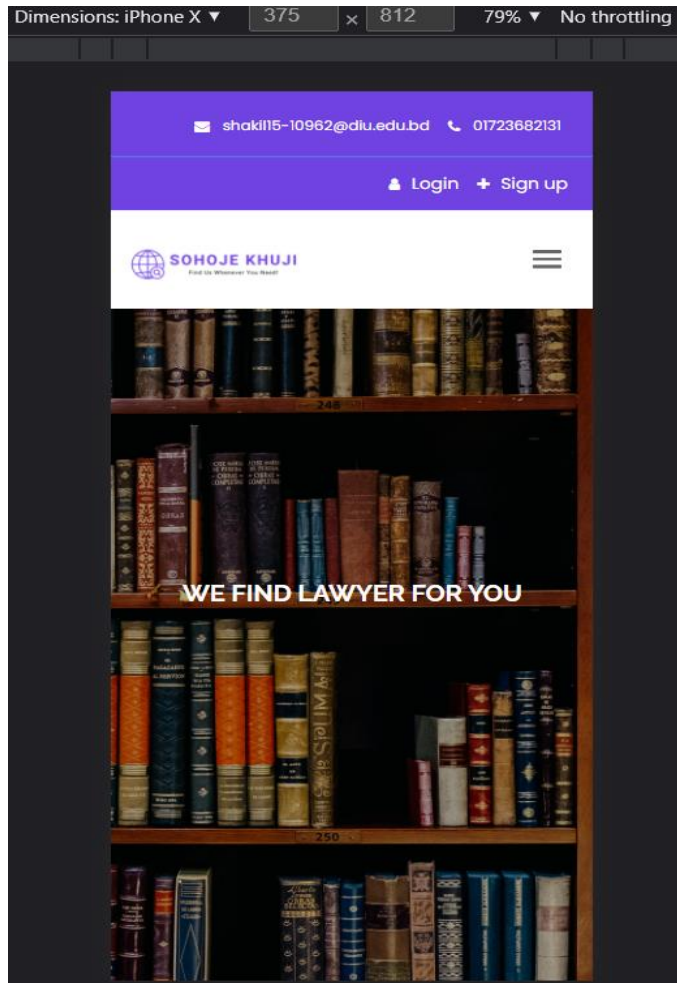


Figure 3.5.3: Homepage on iPhoneX (Display 375 x 812)

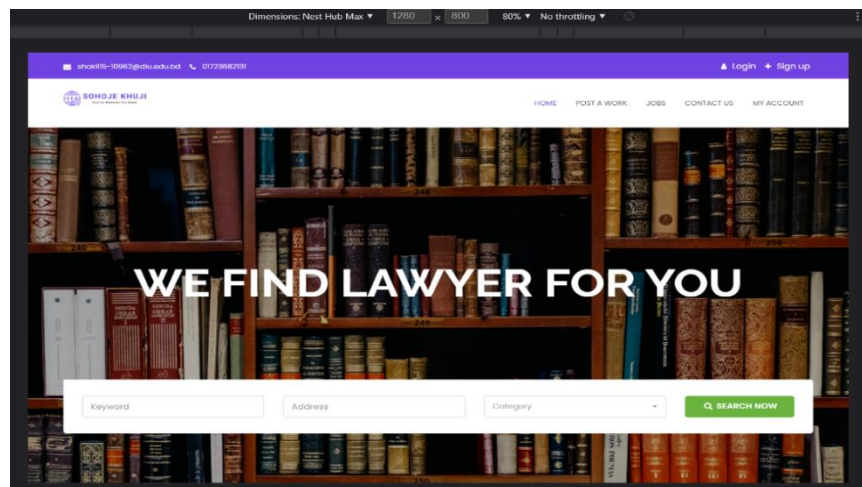


Figure 5.2.1: Homepage Section 1

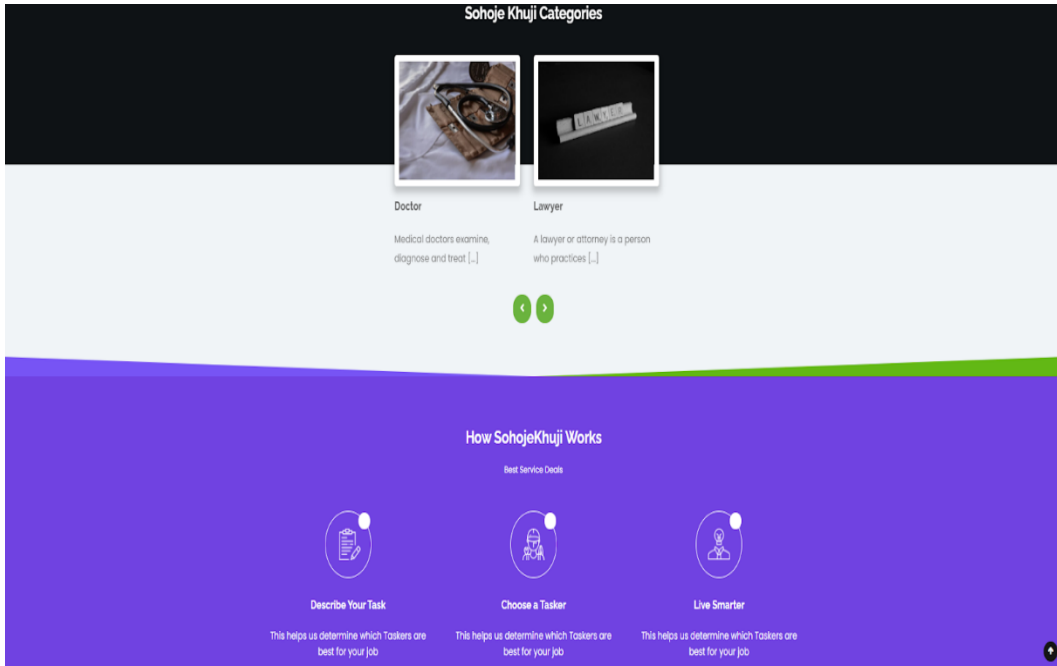


Figure 5.2.2: Homepage Section 2

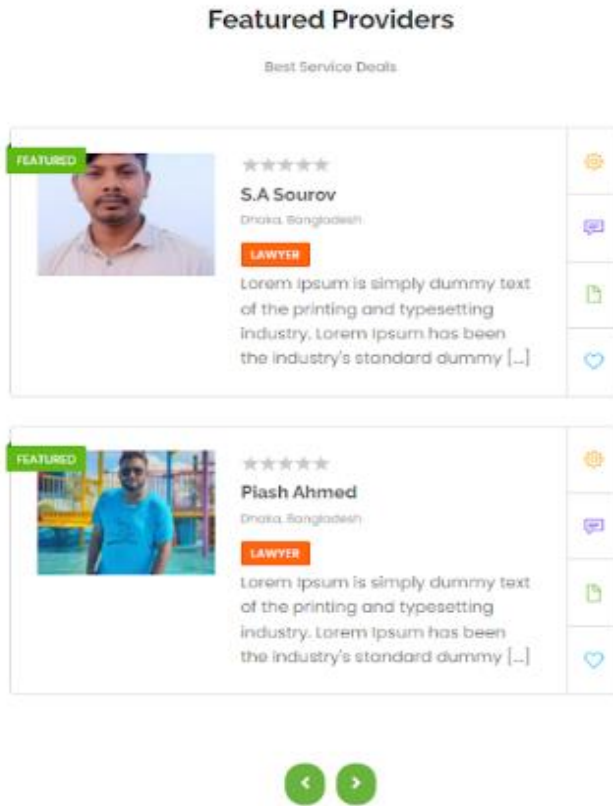


Figure 5.2.3: Homepage Section 3

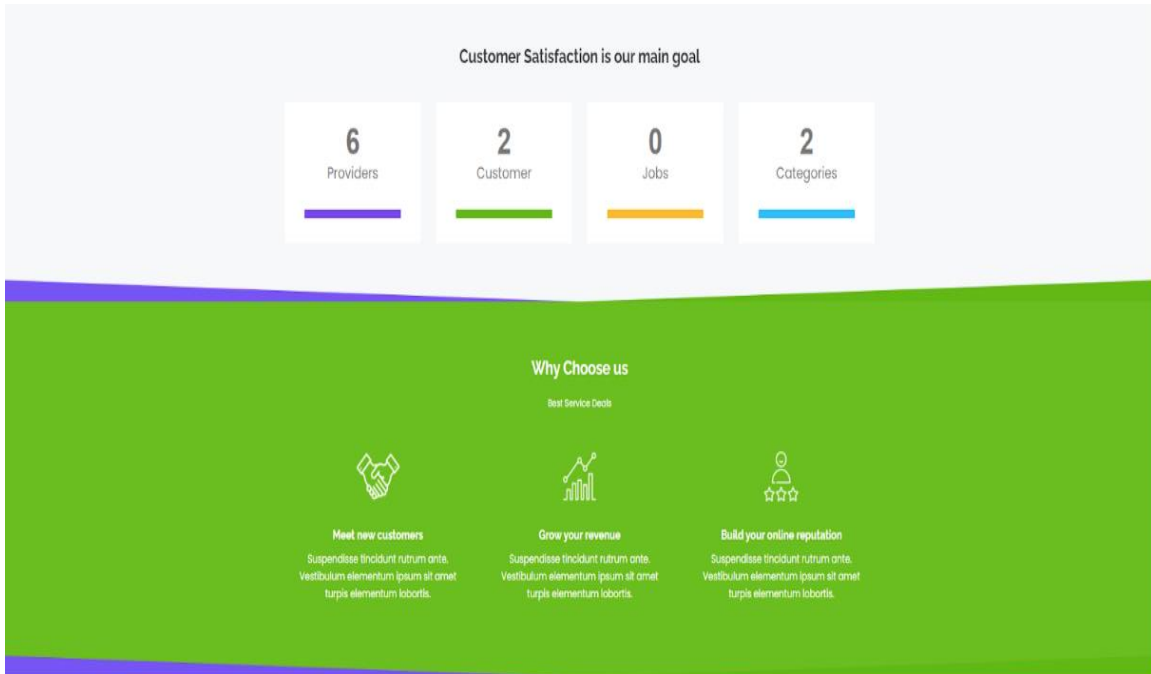


Figure 5.2.4: Homepage Section 4

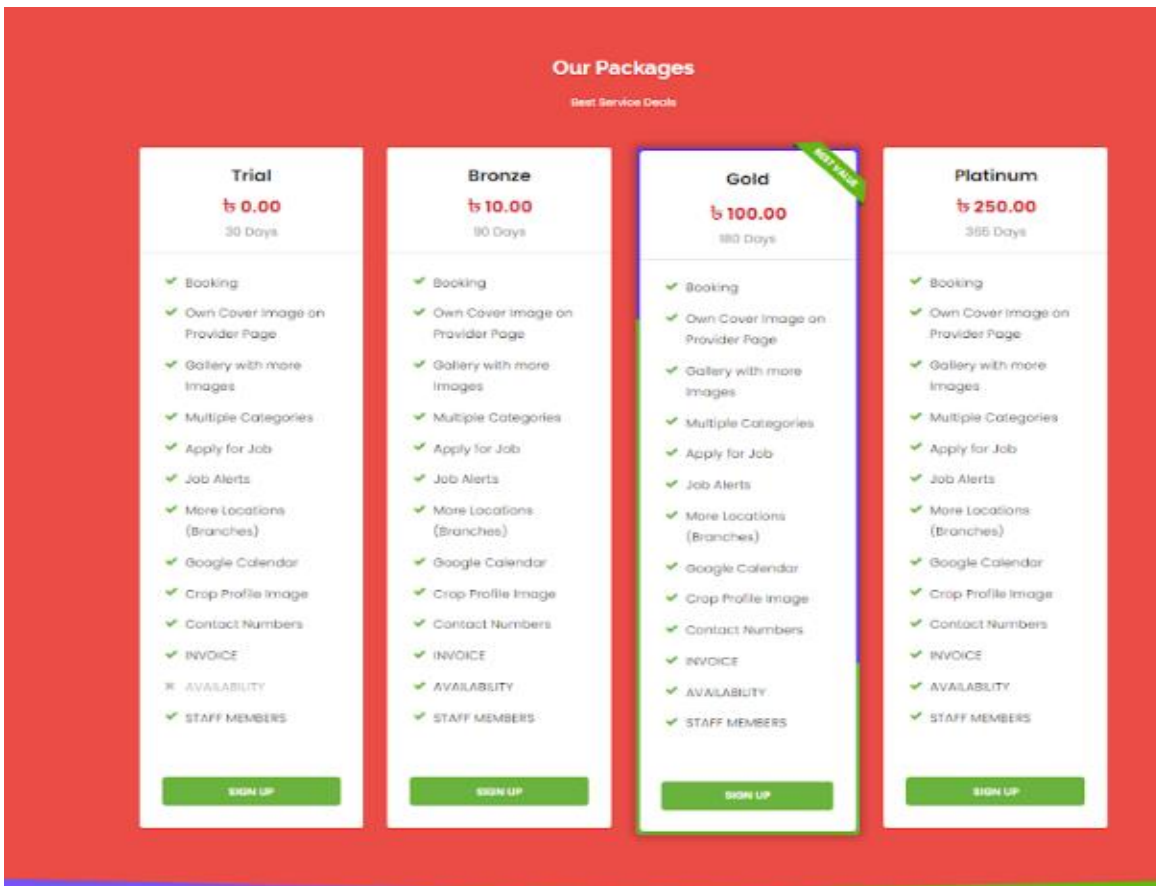


Figure 5.2.5: Homepage Section 5

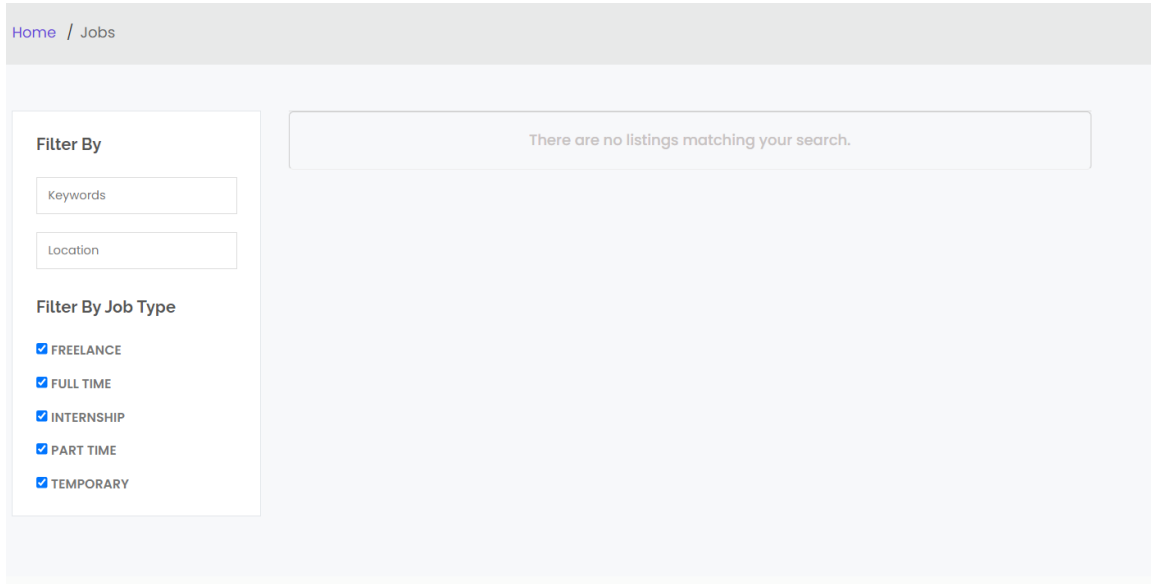


Figure 5.2.10: Jobs Page

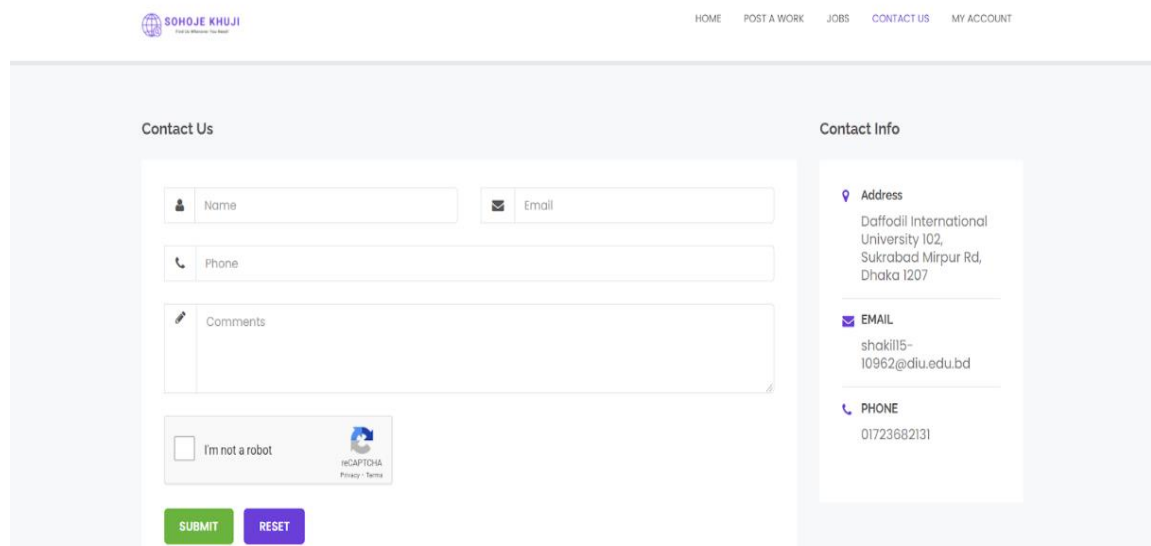


Figure 5.2.11: Contact Us Page

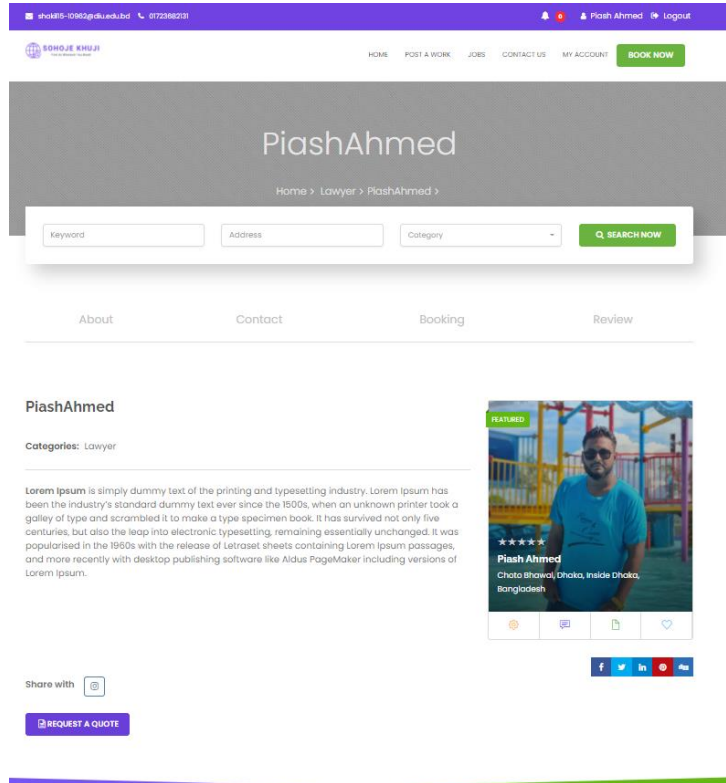


Figure 5.2.12: My Account Page Section 1

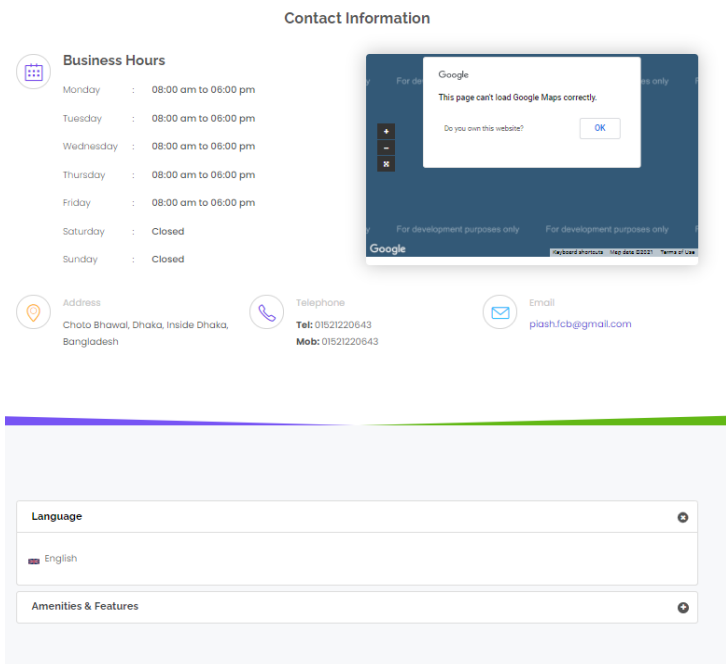


Figure 5.2.13: My Account Page Section 2

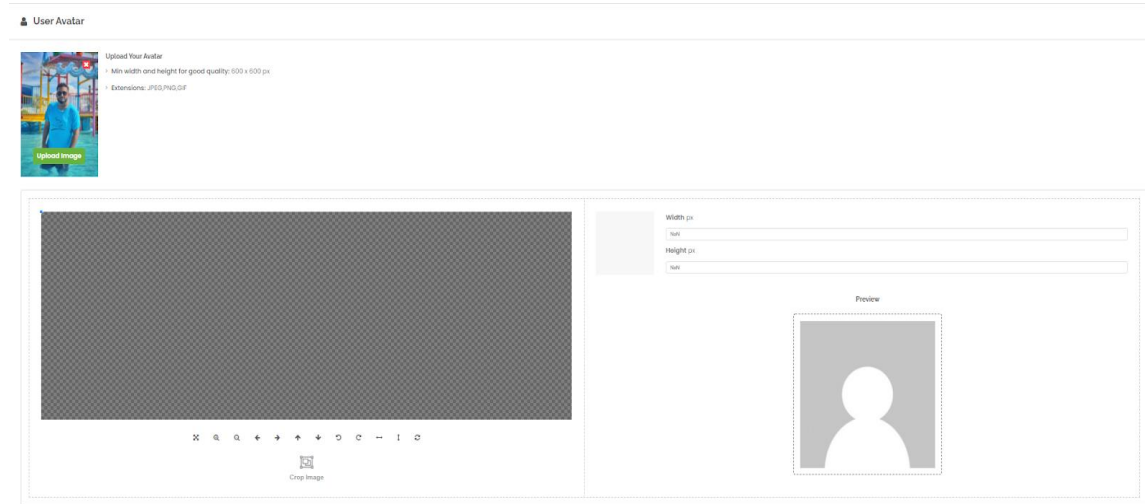


Figure 5.2.14: Profile Setting Page Section 1 (Profile Picture)

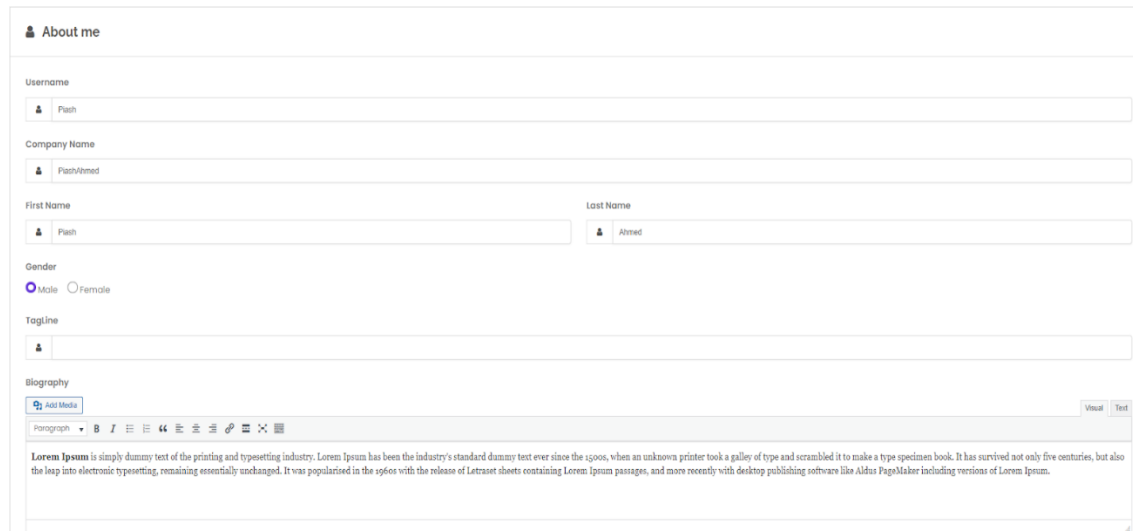


Figure 5.2.15: Profile Setting Page Section 2 (About Me)

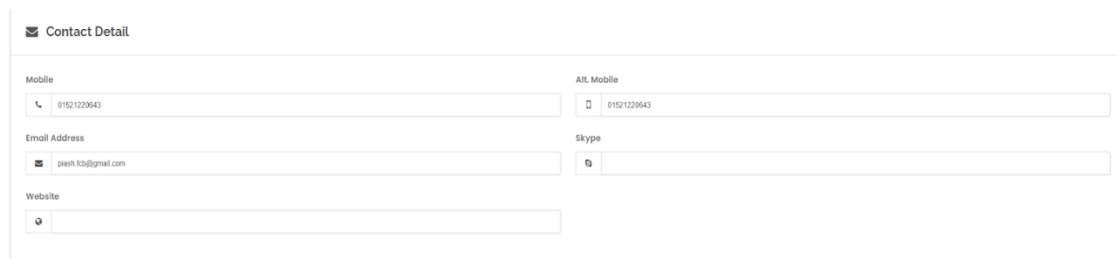



Figure 5.2.16: Profile Setting Page Section 3 (Contact Details)





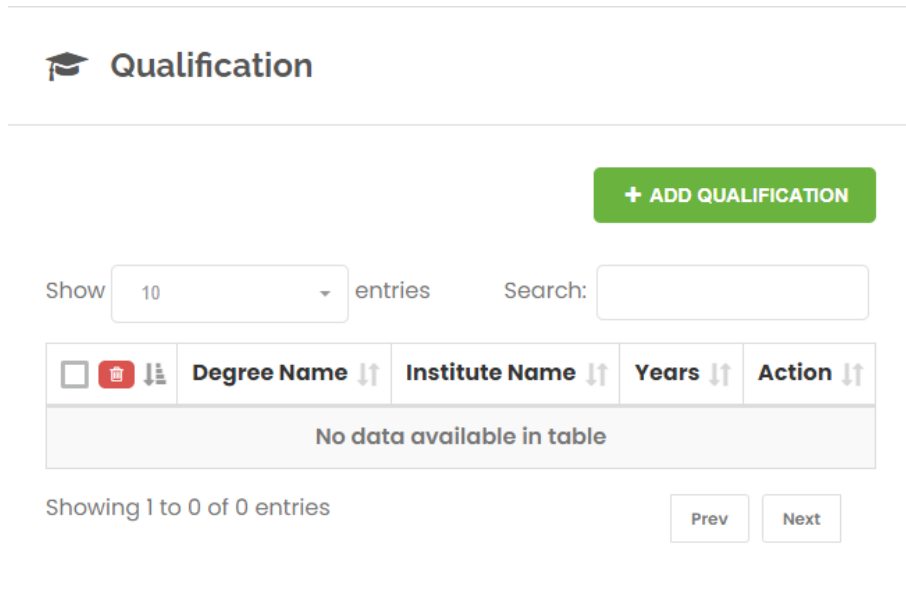


Figure 5.2.22: Qualification Page

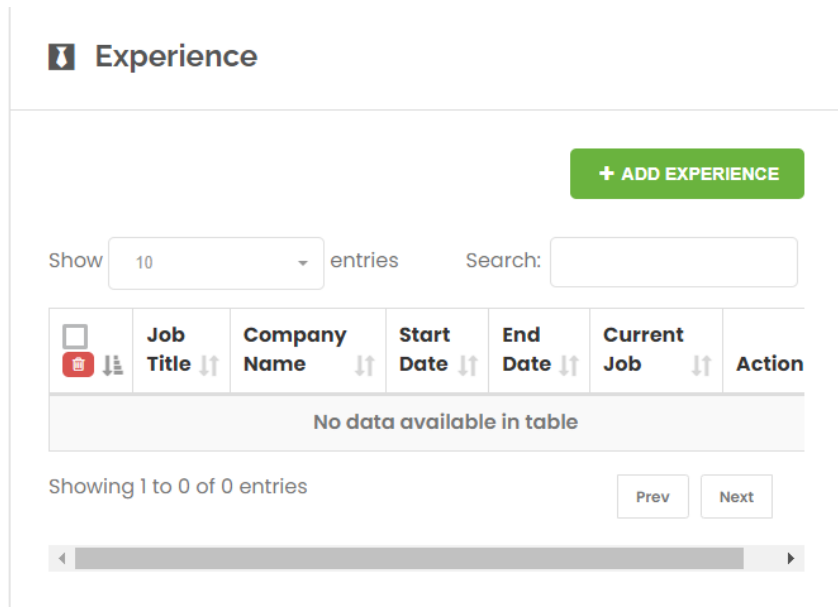


Figure 5.2.24: Experience Page

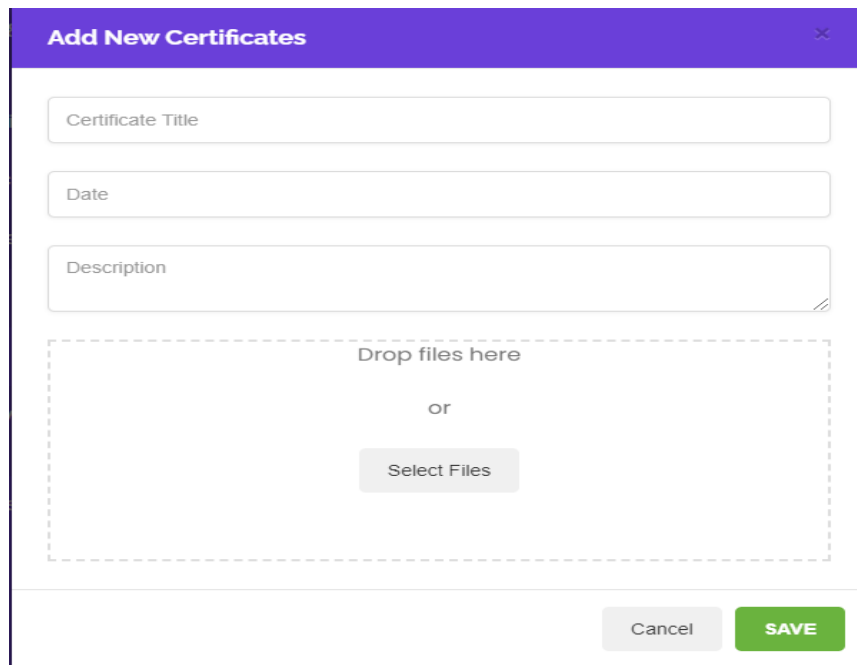


Figure 5.2.25: Add Certificates Page

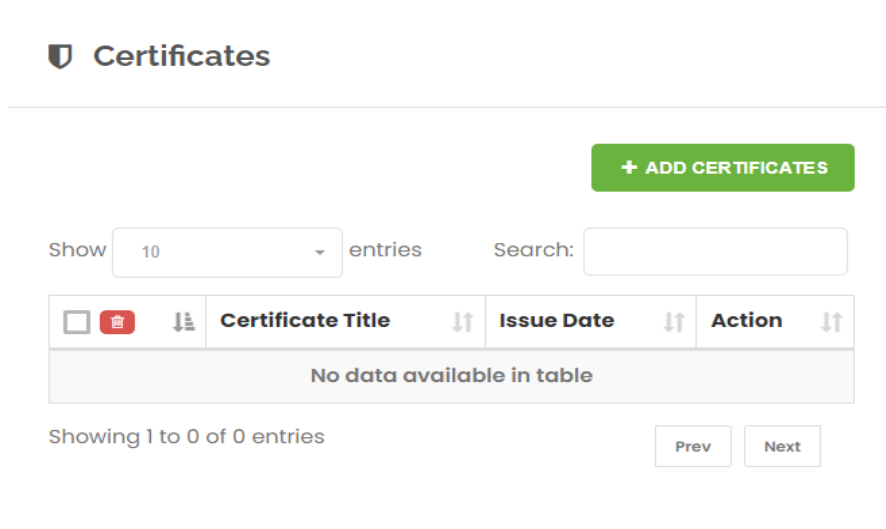


Figure 5.2.26: Certificates Page

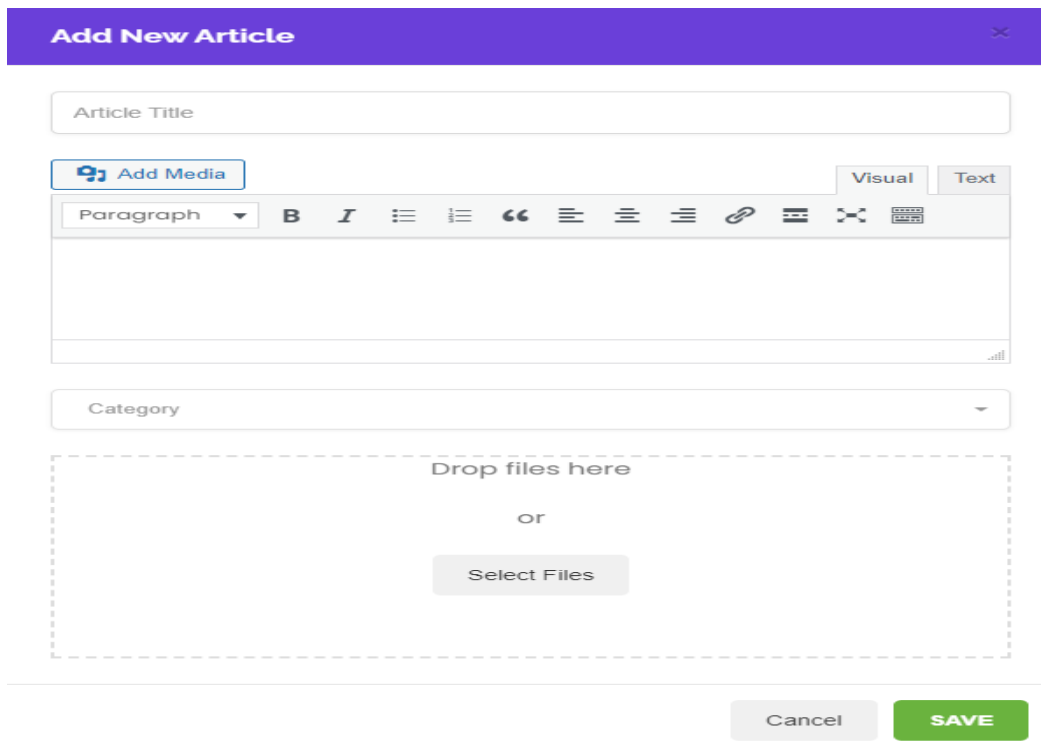


Figure 5.2.27: Add Articles Page

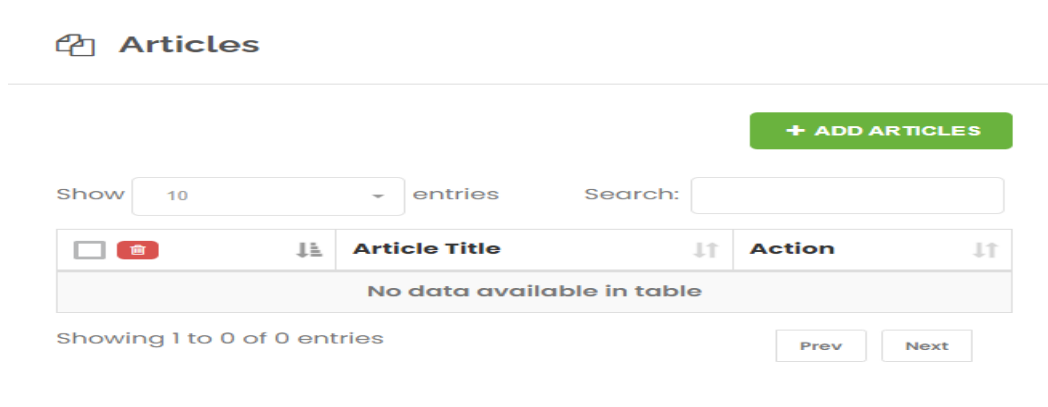


Figure 5.2.28: Articles Page

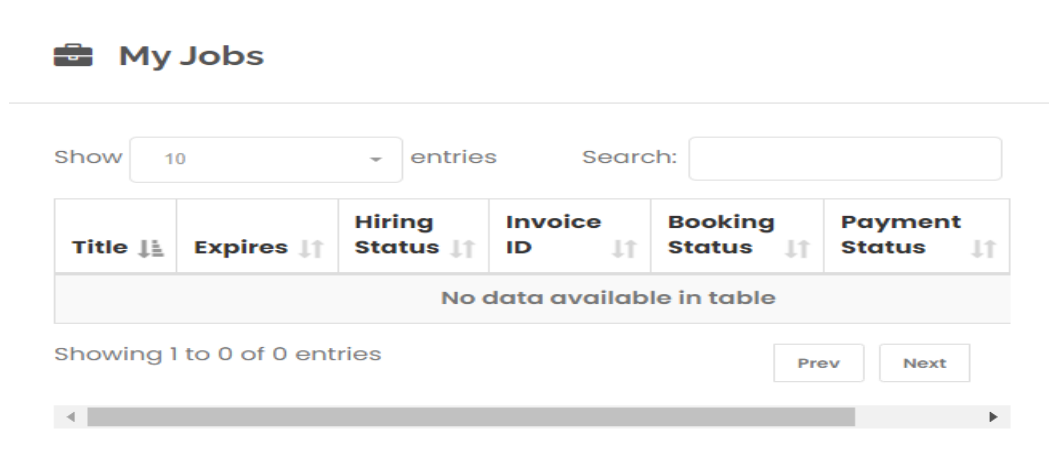


Figure 5.2.29: My Jobs Page

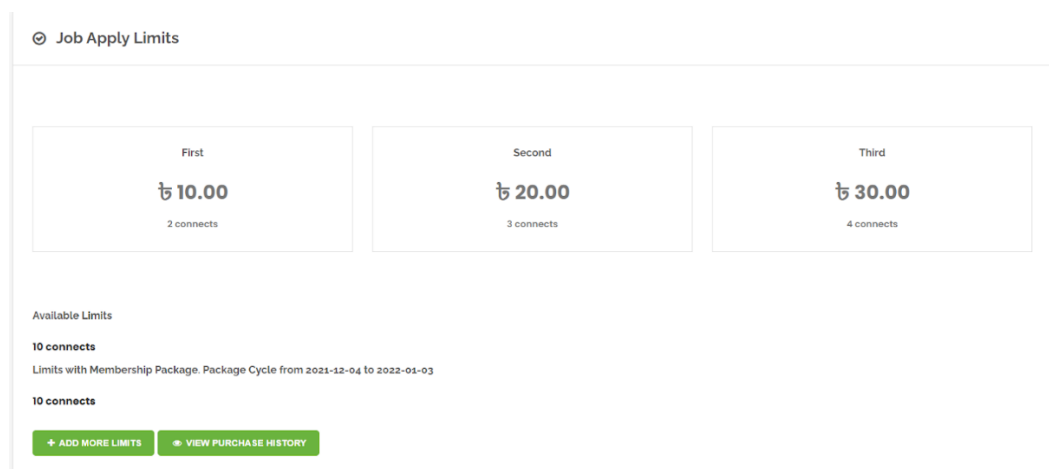


Figure 5.2.30: Job Apply Limits Section

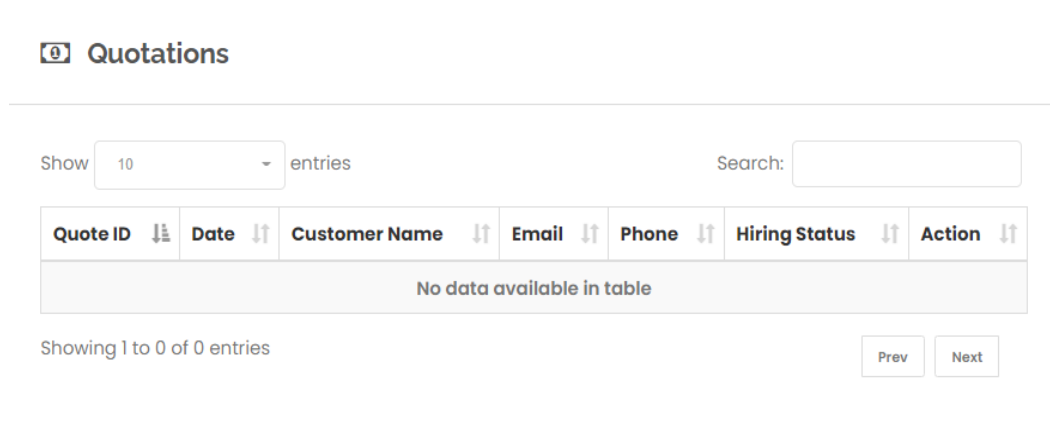


Figure 5.2.33: Quotations Page

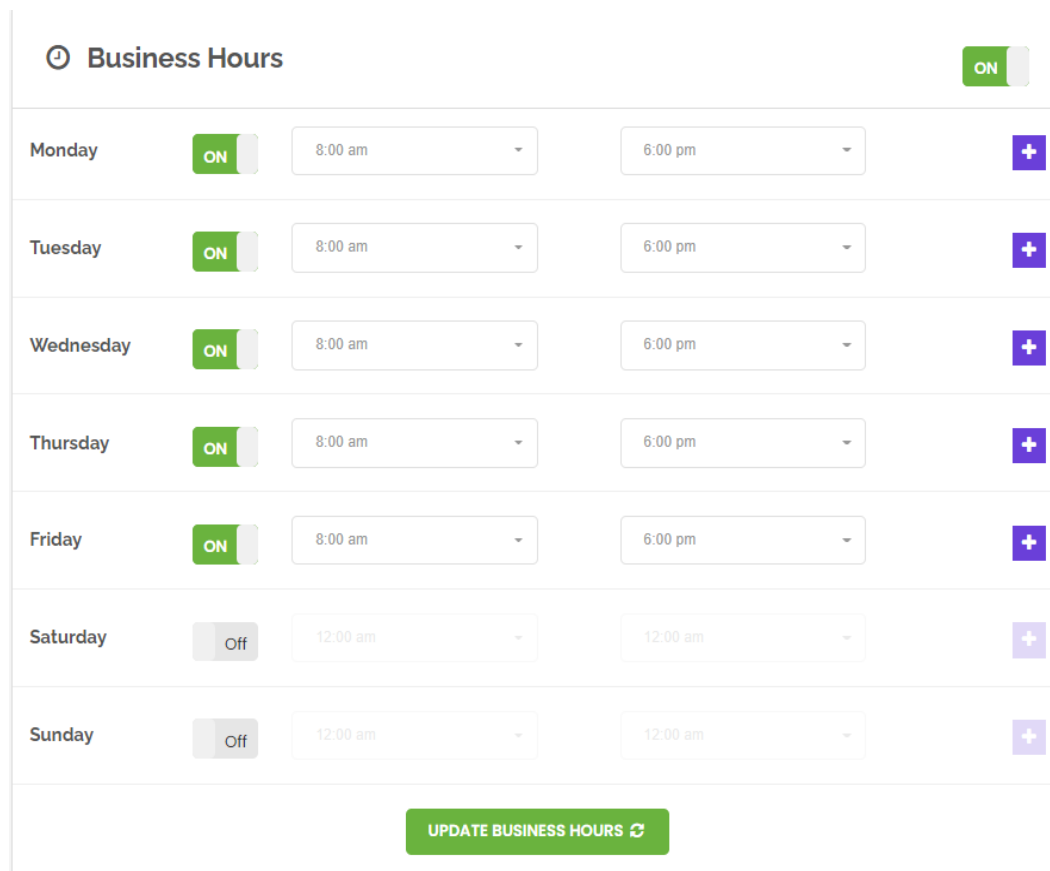




Figure 5.2.34: Business Hours Pages




Figure 5.2.39: Add New Region Page




Figure 5.2.40: Regions Page

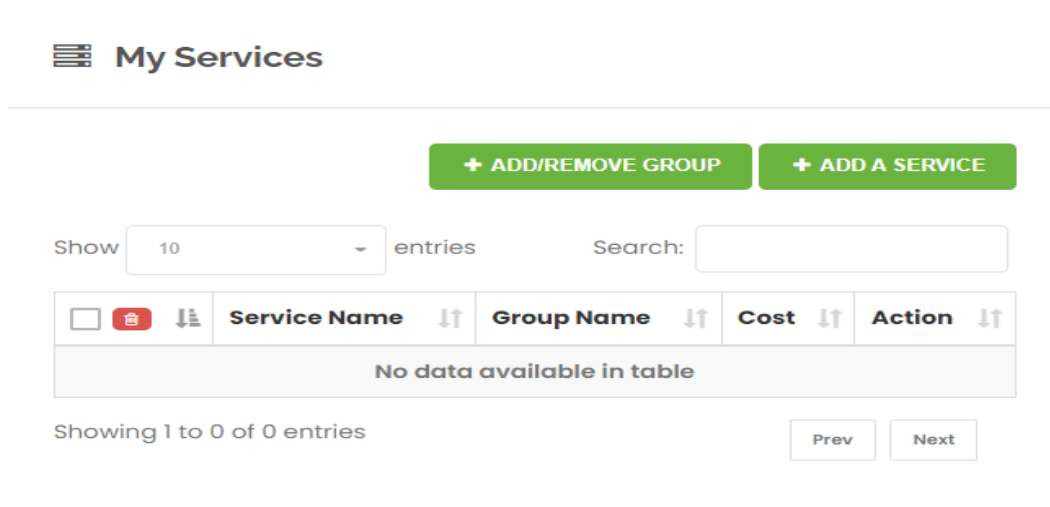


Figure 5.2.43: My Services Page

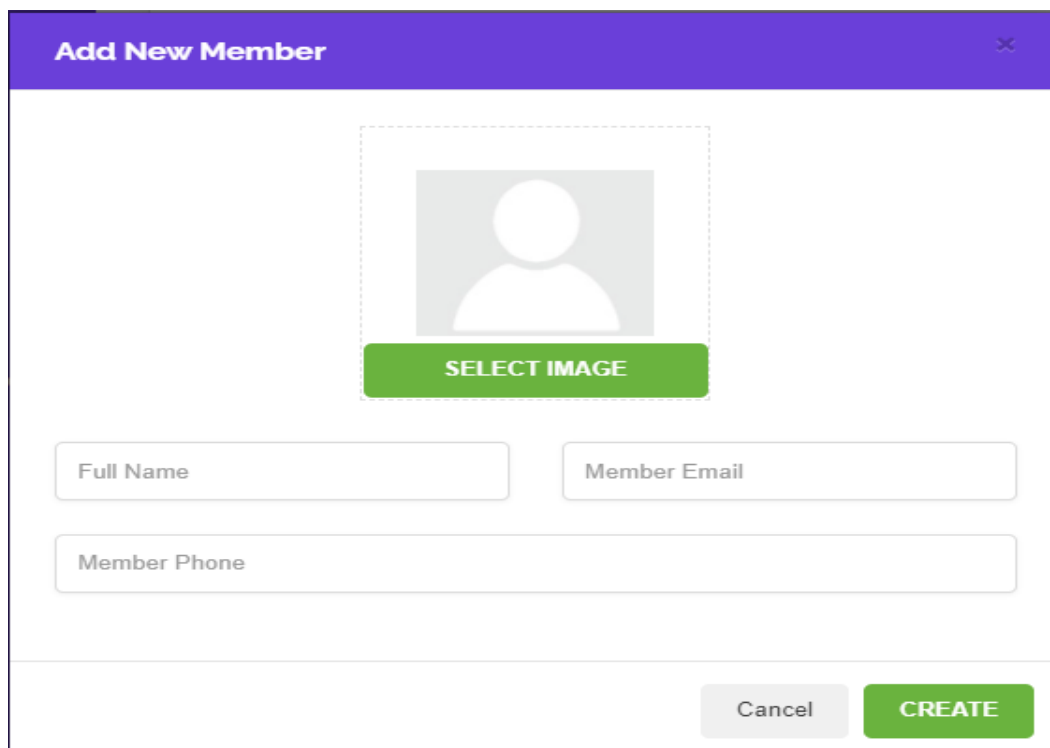


Figure 5.2.44: Add New Member Page

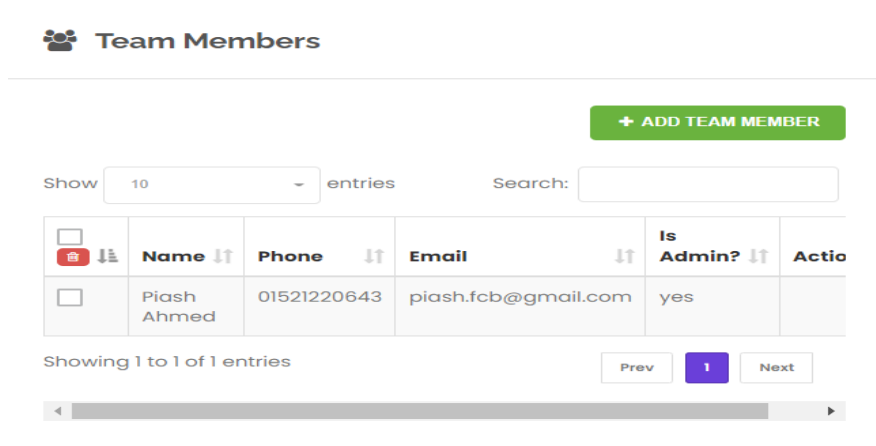


Figure 5.2.45: Team Members Page

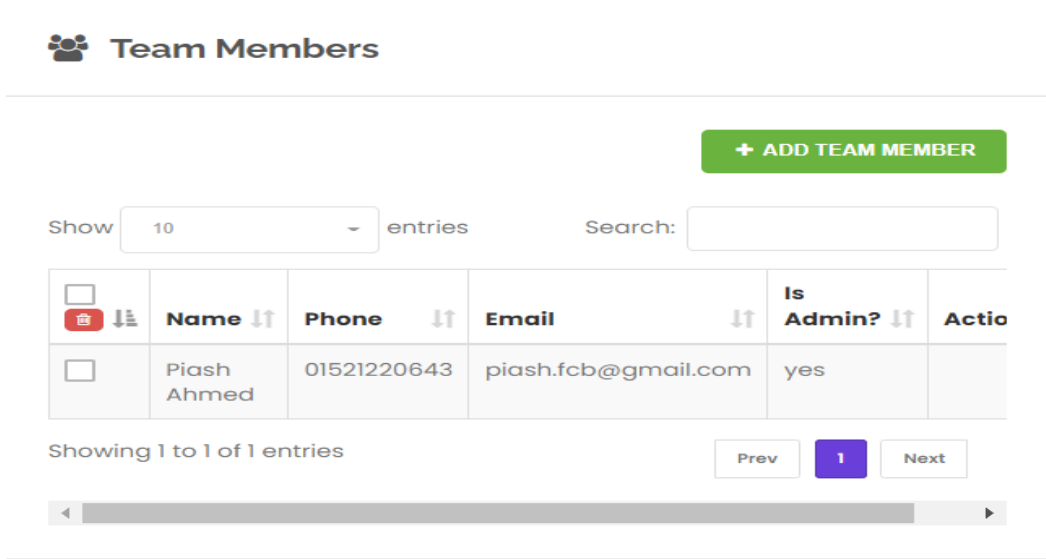


Figure 5.2.47: Invoice Page

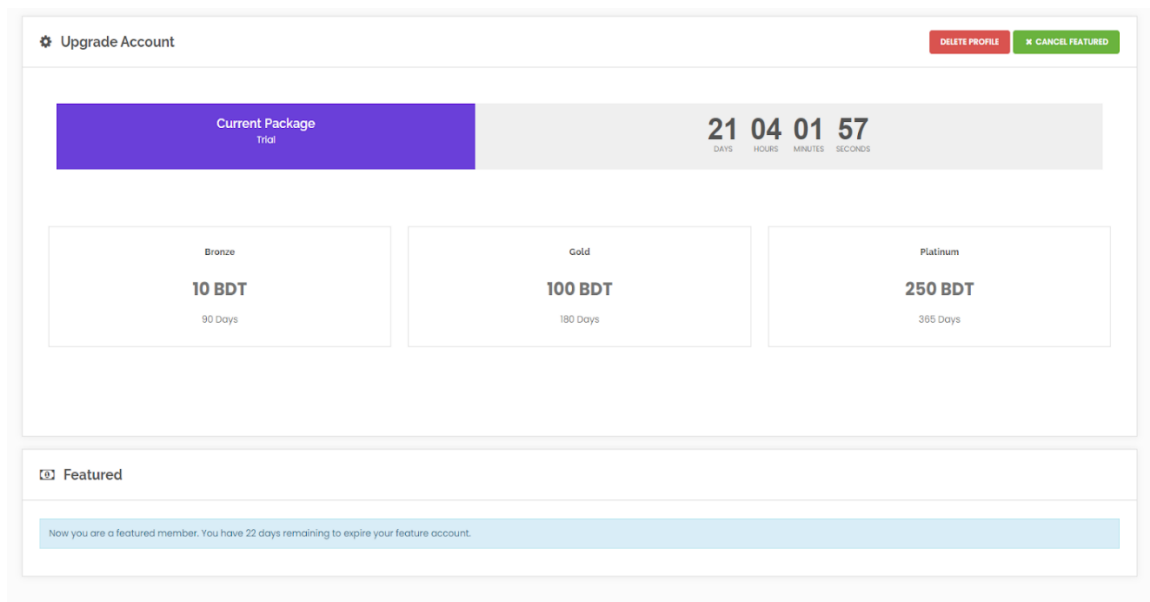


Figure 5.2.48: Upgrade Account Page

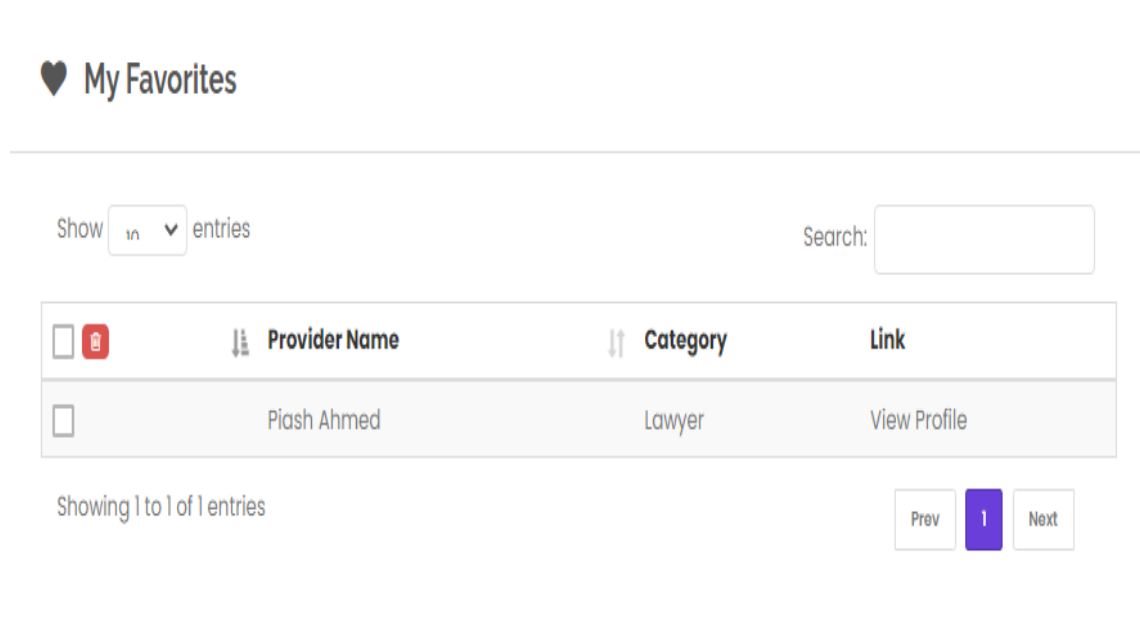


Figure 5.2.49: My Favourites Page

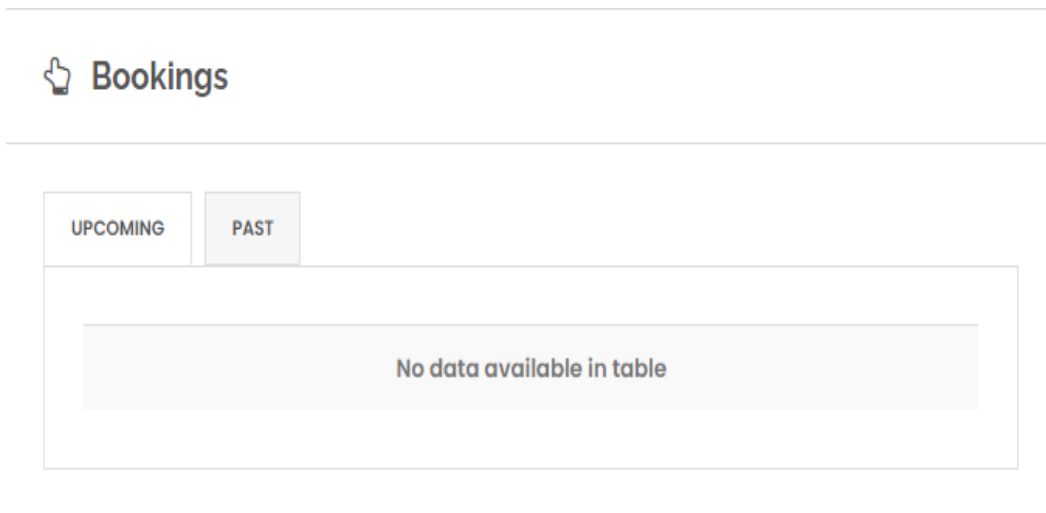


Figure 5.2.50: Bookings Page

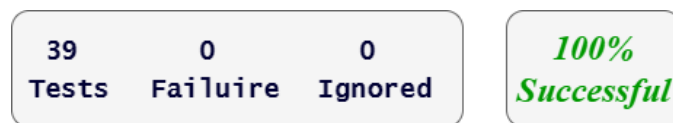


Figure 5.4.1: Unit Test Result
