
ABSTRACT

Introduction

Teachers are the architect of a nation. Being a teacher is one of the most desirable profession in this era. Teaching profession is not all about nurturing the students sharing the knowledge only, it includes in-depth elements like encouraging students, make a student special at about their career, bring talents out of them, and learning, developing self throughout the journey.

Since my childhood I had an immense fascination of becoming a teacher. But as time flew my eagerness of becoming a teacher faded away. But once I got admission in DIU, I started providing tuition for financial support to myself. I acted as an English tutor for almost 3 years and somehow that triggered my enthusiasm of taking teaching as a profession. Hence, I gained a great experience to deal with students, understanding them, developing my own method of teaching and most importantly the experience boosted my confidence to choose teaching as a profession. So, for the completion of my Bachelor degree, I had to do an internship and not thinking about other options I directly applied to couple of schools for the internship. After facing interview, I was selected as an English teacher at Glorious Creative School and college.

It was an internship of three months started from August 10 at Glorious Creative School and College. Since it has started its journey in the year of 2021 it is not much renowned in this locality but as because it is very close where I reside, I choose it right away after the offer. Initially I got the responsibility of taking English classes of class 5 and 6 as a proxy. On the very first day the principle said that most of the students are quite discouraged and afraid of learning English. He further added by saying despite being applied various method of teaching and changing English teachers they were nearly unable to create a spark of motivation in them to learn English. First I thought it would be a massive challenge for me to come up with the students and bring a change. However, with thousands of thoughts in mind I started my journey. Before entering the class I had full confidence but as soon as I entered I felt a drastic change in my confidence level. This was the first time I faced more than 20 students at a single time. Their curiosity made me a bit nervous. But soon I managed myself and started the class with my introduction.

Responsibilities and duties of a teacher

It has already been mentioned that a teacher is not only for sharing knowledge to the students, the obligations of a teacher are indescribable in a few word. But here we have listed the basic Rules and responsibilities that a teacher must carry on his shoulder throughout his teaching profession.

- 2. Developing student's morality
- 3. Motivating the students.
- 4. Student engagement is mass.
- 5. Unbiased evaluation
- 6. Self-learning and coping up with the technologies
- 7. Teaching through Technological advancement.
- 8. Promoting empathy compassion and respect

Required Skills and knowledge of a teacher

Determining what abilities, expertise, and credentials a teacher needs to do a great job is a difficult assignment. According to Stronge (2002), effectiveness is a general concept that depends on student accomplishment. He also provided a framework for effective teaching, which will aid in the development of effective teachers. One needs technical competence, instructional planning, instructional delivery, assessment, a positive learning environment, and professionalism to be a good teacher. According to Darling-Hammond (2008), if a teacher doesn't undergo some specialized training before beginning their career, the implications could cause them to quit, accuse the curriculum of "dumbing down," and ultimately blame their students.


In addition, a teacher must possess topic knowledge, curricular knowledge, teaching and learning knowledge, and learning context knowledge in order to carry out his or her tasks. Hourigan (2006) highlighted four crucial elements of teaching and learning.

Which are:

- Who the learner is and how they learn;
- What should be taught and why it is significant (knowledge); (learner)
- What types of teaching methods and system are best for classrooms, schools, and school communities? (Community)
- What kind of evaluation can be used to determine whether successful learning is actually taking place? (Assessment)


Since learner types are constantly changing and no two students will ever have the same comprehension and acceptability level, there is also always room for improvement and making one's teaching more effective. A teacher must also stay current in order to best serve her students.

Furthermore Ratzel (2013) shared his own way of becoming an educator, he conveyed the adventures journey of him becoming a successful teacher. he pointed out a reason behind the lake of Desire of the students to learn something new. He declared that this is a result of lake of motivation for asking question. He further blamed certain types of teachers who don't respond to their student's question. Such things need a change and eventually he offered an advice on how other teachers can continue their journey successfully. Must have excellent communication skills and clear goals. Patience is one of the most significant characteristic that a teacher must have. Apart from this a teacher must have the ability to handle any circumstance rising among students.



OBJECTIVES

- 1. To enhance the students' overall English communication abilities by applying various teaching strategies.
- 2. To understand the depth of the fear expanded among students about English subject and eradicate it from their mind.
- 3. To figure out the weaknesses and lacking of students in English and ways of overcoming them.
- 4. To establish various club, interactive activities and engage students to nurture them English with fun and joy.
- 5. To impart my theoretical and practical understanding of English subject to the students acquired from University.
- 6. To gain more knowledge and contribute in the field of teaching.



METHODOLOGY

For completing this internship I have selected a School named Glorious Creative School, located in Gazirchat, Ashulia, and Dhaka. I was appointed as an intern teacher.

I took classes of 5th and 6th standard initially and after two weeks I started taking class of 9 and 10 standard.

For class observation I selected classes among 5th to 9th standard.

I discussed teaching plan, method and materials with teachers.

During classes I have used several teaching methods to teach the students so in brief I am describing them below

3.1 Teaching method: In this section I will briefly discuss about the teaching methods that I was taken into consideration while working as a teacher. In this regard, I would like to emphasize that I did not follow any particular method straight; rather I used different techniques and activities that seems appropriate to me. Techniques such as, GTM (grammar translation method), Audiolingual method, I also used proficiency guideline to evaluate their condition regarding the level of learning in terms of improving the four skills speaking, writing, listening and reading. Eventually, I used the storytelling method sometimes for making a communicative classroom and engage students. Therefore, all the things I have used during my internship and all the literature regarding my topic will be discussed below in this chapter. As well as, I would like to add some relevant examples with those literatures.

Grammar Translation Method (GTM):

In the history of instructional strategies, the Grammar Translation Approach is referred to as the "Classical way" or "classical method." This approach was typically used to learn classical languages. This procedure is known as the deductive way of teaching language since it involves students first going through the rules before moving on to learning. According to Gollin (1998), the grammar translation approach is the most closely related in terms of language education. Additionally, others created a list in which they stated a few key aspects of grammar translation, including:

- i. Little usage of the certain language occurs in class as the teachers primarily use their native language. Like using Bangla to teach English
- ii. Many complex and unnecessary words are used to teach vocabulary, so, that must be avoided.
- iii. Detailed, lengthy explanations of grammar are provided. Should make it easier.
- iv. The text's content, which is used as the exercise, is not given much consideration.


Storytelling:

Any of the teaching methods can be used in a language lesson by the teacher. Storytelling is one of the methods used to teach languages. I used to teach class 6 English during my apprenticeship, and they used the Chowdhury and Hossain book for this topic. To teach them tense, maintain their attention, and make the teaching fun, I used the storytelling technique. Storytelling is also a fantastic idea for morality lessons.

In his article, Ilmu (2016) pointed out that in order to improve speaking, students need an interactive speaking technique. He also noted that the students were eager to hear their teacher deliver stories, particularly ones that were based on folktales. The dread of public speaking, however, diminished to some extent thanks to this opportunity for class and storytelling, engaging pupils, and at the same time, I felt more at ease as a teacher.

Sentence analysis:

It's a made up method to teach the students the structure of sentence. How the sentences has been formulated And whatever I used to teach them grammar like tense parts of speech right form of verbs, voice changes through sentence analysis. What exactly I was doing is to take a story and after that a particular sentence then I used to analyze all the parts of speech of that sentence to make them understand from where the word came, why this preposition has used, why we have used this form of verb and tense in the sentence. That helped them immensely to understand the formulation of sentence, identification of sentence, to write a sentence in a proper way and application of the basic preposition.



INTERNSHIP ACTIVITY

5.1 Internship Activity: One of the most crucial aspects, in my opinion, is that one must love and be passionate about teaching in order becoming a teacher. A teacher will never be a good teacher if they do not take pleasure in what they do and do not feel proud to be in that position.

Class Experience

Week 1:

During my first week I wasn't involved in the main classes rather I was only taking trial or proxy classes. So my first ever class was with class 6. There were more than 20 students in the class. I felt nervous because I was observing that 40 to 50 pairs of eyes were looking at me at the same time and they were curious about me so after completing the introduction session, I started to teach them the same topic where the other teacher left. I was engaging them throughout the period by asking them question, telling story and so on.

Since I was only attending the proxy classes I did not make any lesson plan for any of the classes. I literally started where the other teacher left and started continuing what's they were doing regardless they are knowledge, ability, understanding.

Throughout the first week I could not implement my planned curriculum, could not establish mike testing methods practically. In most of the classes I only taught those tenses and model test.

At the end of the week after requesting the headmaster and other teachers during a meeting, they collectively decided to give me the responsibility of class 5 and 6. Since I was not getting the independence of taking classes of any standard using my own strategies, curriculum, plans, I passed a week indolently.

Week 2:

From 2nd week I had started taking class of 5th and 6th standard. Since it was September I thought there syllabus was almost complete. So I started by asking them in which part they are facing problem. Still I wanted to evaluate their learnings throughout the year by myself. I told the students of class 5 to solve "fill in the gaps with clues, rearranging sentences and using of WH question" from a Model. After seeing the result I was really surprised by the fact that they all got very good

marks. Keeping that in mind, I made some of the questions like the model then told them to solve it now. And now they were struggling to get the correct answer.

Problem Identified:

- 1. The range of vocabulary of this two classes was quite low.
- 2. The students were unable to identify the tense and sentences.
- 3. Most of the students of class 6 memorize the model question but did not understand the basic grammars.

So, I had to make lesson according to my identification of problems. It's not like everyone was struggling. There were some promising students who were extraordinary. There was 2 boys I found and they needed extra care. Through asking questions from basic grammatical parts I realized their problems. So, keeping all things in mind from the day on I started making plans, finding out easy teaching methods to make them understand easily. As we all know to do better in grammatical part you need nothing but practice. But they were lacking immensely. Within one month they had a midterm exam.

Last three days of 2nd week I started teaching them the sentence and then tense as I found they had issues in rearranging sentences and in WH questions. For class 6 I had different plans for teaching them tense. I offered them hand notes of tenses filled with many practical examples.

Week 3:

Throughout the second week I tried my best to identify student's lacking in every sector. Then I made lesson plan, started applying different strategies to make everything clear to them. I wanted to utilize the whole week because they have taste in the next week. First of all for preparing them I started with tense understand the basic rules of tense, how to use them, which tenses are widely used, how to identify a tense. I took only two classes to make them understand the basic of tense. I used hundreds of examples. For making the tense much clear to them I excluded past perfect continuous tense future perfect and future perfect continuous tense. Most of the students were doing well. So I decided to jump to voice changing. Then it took me almost the full week to complete the acidity and imperative part only. I took several test but the taste I have designed were very easy. When they scored high there confidence boosted up to certain extent. Which help them to learn more and to think that they can do. I gradually increased the toughness of the question

pattern. Same I did for class five as well. After that with the discussion with the senior teachers we decided to keep the syllabus short till my topic.so I included easy topics with tense and voice changes. I got many classes to teach them because the school offers a privilege to attend coaching after classes. So I took classes in school and coaching as well.

Week 4:

My 4th week was the midterm test of the students. Throughout the third week I had pointed on which topics we would take the test. So I had to make questions. Do it was not the first time that I have created question for the students but this was the first time for a group of students of a school.so I was a little over it about the quality of my question. I analyze the previous question patterns. Took help from the supervisor and others teachers. But the headmaster give me full authority to make my question paper as I wanted. So by going away from the conventional question pattern I want it to make it a bit innovative for class 6. Question pattern of class 5 similar to the previous questions. Though the students of class 6 was not much extraordinary. I wanted to boost up their confidence. I thought them I designed the question in a same manner so that they could relate to what they were taught. For an example, I wanted a very brief explanation why they have changed the voice by using that particular formula. By evaluating in this way I wanted to make sure they have learned it properly with the explanation.

At the end of the week I have attended meeting and I requested the headmaster to give me classes of 9 and 10. Initially they were not agreeing but after insisting them they gave me two classes of class 9 and 10 in coaching center.

Week 5, 6 and 7:

From class 5 I had bigger responsibilities because I have got two more classes to take in the coaching center. The coaching is also organized in classrooms. So I assumed it to be a class not a coaching center.

In this week I had another responsibility of evaluating the student's paper. So as expected they had done really well in their exams except few students. While distributing the papers they were getting really happy because day scored well. One thing that I understood after evaluating the papers That the way I taught them with fun, by engaging them with me, by removing the fear of asking questions to a teacher where successful and effective.

So for class 9 and 10 I had different plan. On the very first day I had asked them very common question from there grammatical part but here as well I experienced the same result as I got it from class 6.students of class 9th and 10th standard they were also very weak in basic grammars like tense, sentences and right form of verbs. So I have started the basic of grammar like tense and sentences. After finishing them I started with right form of verbs. There were more than 52 rules in their book. So I planned to make it easier to them. After analyzing all the rules I found out that Through 1 rule I can teach them 4 to 5 rules. So I designed my types of right to move verbs and I taught them in my way.

Throughout the 5th 6th and 7th week the topics I had covered are-

- 1. Tense
- 2. Right form of verbs
- 3. Voice
- 4. Tag question

In between this weeks I have taken a lots of class tests of class 9/10.I was more focused on class 9th and 10th standard then class 5th and 6th standard. Because I found that they are studying in class 9th 10th standard by still they are lagging far behind compare to other school student. Because of continuous test, and homework I saw significant improvement in them.

Week 8 and 9:

Because of focusing on grammatical part a lot for 9th and 10th standard I completely became unaware about their writing part. As they are the most senior students I asked them to write anything they want about anything. I just wanted to know about their writing skill. But what they wrote about anything was a complete disaster. They could memorize a paragraph or any other writing stuff and write them in their exam to get good marks. But when it comes to be creative about writing they were unable to do that. I have seen that most of the students wrote only 2 to 3 lines of 5 to 6 lines. They told me that they don't know what to write further about their chosen topic. The topics I have given them were describe a happy moment that happened in your life, describe one of the most memorable memories of your childhood, describe a beautiful place you have visited recently. These topics were new to them so they were unable to write more about

these. I think free writing skill should be developed. Because memorizing skill is not going to help them in future. I taught them Different techniques of thinking and writing. I gave them homework about their desired topic as I got the full authority of implementing my ways of teaching, I tried to apply them all.

After teaching them writing part for 3 days. I started to give them a glimpse of suffix and prefix. What they did about suffix and prefix was they used to read suffix and prefix from their given book. But I don't think suffix prefix can be solved in that way. I instructed them to read all the suffix prefix that are mentioned in the book for couple of times. Then they just needed to practice more and more. I solved a suffix prefix problem in front of them and told them that I haven't studied or memorized those mentioned suffix prefix in your book but I could solve it. So to solve suffix prefix and get full marks you have to practice and read more vocabularies. To learn vocabularies I taught them the same technique that I used for class 5th and 6th and standard. Taking all the vocabularies and making a story out of it that can make very easy to understand and memorize those vocabularies with meaning and explanation.

Week 10:

Along with teaching 5th 6th, 9th and 10th standard, I was planning to do something else to improve their English and make them confident. I am not a very good speaker in English but I have a great desire to learn English more. I always wanted to become a very good speaker in English but I didn't get such environment. So I thought as I am practicing my English speaking why don't I include the students I am teaching to. So I started speaking English during my classes for 10 minutes 15 minutes out of 45 minutes. I think if a teacher speaks English in front of the students after couple of months they will be familiar with most of the English words that are used in daily activities and conversation. One article that I read from internet was about taking English classes in English helps student immensely. This practice has already been adopted in Indian schools and in modern schools of Dhaka. The English medium students of our country are improving in English but the classes are taken in Bangla. So I wanted to change it a bit. I would also get a platform to speak in front of students, which would boost up my confidence as well in front of people and teachers. Along with this initiative during a meeting I have proposed to start a English speaking club. Where the best performer will get a price of something?

I told them the benefits of starting a speaking club. I feel that if a student is confident enough in his speaking he would do better in writing as well. So all the teachers and headmaster have agreed upon my proposal and decided to start speaking club from next year. But I wanted to start it from now. So I already started it during my classes. I give them a certain topic of grammar or from their model questions and instruct them to prepare a small presentation on it. They have to come in front of the classroom and they have to speak in English for 1 to 2 minutes. I know that would really create a fear in their mind. But after practicing this activity for 5 to 6 months I am 100% sure that there stage fear would be demolished and they would have a great improvement in English Language.

5.2 CLASS OBSERVATION EXPERIENCE

As a part of fulfilling the requirement of my internship I have observed 5 classes. I observed class English classes of 5th to 9th standard.

✓ Class 7

On 18th September, when I went to the class the teacher Mr. Shakib Sheikh had already started teaching. At first I asked his permission to get enter the class and I explain why I need to observe.15 students were present in that class on that day. Mr. Shakib Sheikh was teaching voice change, changing voice of interrogative sentence to be more specific. The objectives was to make the voice change clear to the students and make them understand the importance of voice change in writing and speaking. Mr. Shakib Sheikh is a very experienced teacher so he has the ability to make it easier to the students. So he used the simplest method that can be applied to teach them. Students where really proactive during classes, they were communicative, interactive, they had no fear of asking questions. At the end of the class they were doing several exercises regarding voice change, and most of the students were able to solve them all.




- 1. Because of taking continuous classes of 9/10 standard my presentation skill got increased.

- 3. Noticed a huge improvement in communication skill as I communicated during meeting with colleagues.
- 4. Impactful understanding in every grammatical lessons.

- 6. As a new school there were lots of problems, so I participated in problem solving meeting which improved my idea generation and problem solving skills.
- 7. As had to finish syllabus in time helped me in planning, goal setting and target achievement.
- 8. Gathered event management skills while organizing several functions.
- 9. Learned to understand question paper and preparing as per requirement.
- 10. Helped me to learn how to maintain healthy relationship

ADMINSTRATIVE WORK


I was mainly busy with my classes' majority of the time but during the examination time I also involved myself into some administrative work and they are as follows:-

- 3. The number of teachers should be increased in higher school sections.

- 7. Finally they should do more marketing as their competitors are more. Including all the recommendations might boost up their reputation.


8.2 Conclusion


I also had the opportunity to work with some amazing teachers. They were so supportive and helpful. I learned a lot from them and I am grateful for their guidance.
