### **Chapter-5**

### My internship experience

I joined Shabuj Global Education on September 20, 2022. I was supervised by Md. Thuhidur Rahman is our Branch Manager of the Dhaka Office. Later I got the opportunity with their Senior Counselor Md Alamgir Hossain, then I got the opportunity to work with the application team, where Md Ahsanul Karim Chowdhury help me to know about the whole application process. I also learn Many things from Masiur Rahman and Md.Roben Meazi, they are my colleagues.

Being an English Department student to complete the graduation an internship or project is a crucial part after the completion of 4 years course. I have completed my internship at Shabuj Global Education as an executive student counselor. After the 3 months of my successful internship in this organization, I got a permanent job offer in the same position of student counselor. I have chosen this organization for my internship because of the position offered by the company which I thought I am suitable for. As a counselor, an employee must have good communication skills and patience in behavior while dealing with various clients as the counselor representing the company and their service. A counselor's proper way of explaining and communicating must ensure that clients feel a friendly service and behavior on their every visit to the office. My work responsibilities are the same after being employed and I am still getting training for more challenging tasks in the future. I think this sector is suitable for English Department students because communication and English Language skills are mandatory for this sector.

### 5.1 My duties at Shabuj Global Education

- 1. My first given responsibility is to be Familiar with Uk Universities, especially which are the partner universities of Shabuj Global Education. And try to remember the university names as much as possible. Then searched the University Website and collect the information.
- 2. My second given responsibility is to checking every day official email inbox of Shabuj Global Education. I must check if the universities or education solution providers have replied to whom Shabuj Global Education has communicated earlier and has sent emails about the potential students or the affiliation agreements. As a counselor, I will have to make sure no emails are delayed to reply and responses are given instantly or within 1-2 days after discussing with the colleagues, manager or senior counselor.
- 3. They gave an official phone to communicate with the students or clients. I made the phone call from the official phone for communication purposes. I use the phone and communicate with students easily.
- 4. I called students from their leads who are interested in UK higher studies. On Sunday and Tuesday at a particular time, I will have to give follow-up calls. In my follow-up calls i contacted with the old clients and potential clients as well. We get the contact numbers in two ways. 1st when any client whether a student /clients visits our office of Shabuj Global Education we give them an assessment form to fill up the form. In that assessment form, they have to provide their phone number and email id, and basic academic information for Uk Higher studies. 2nd is when any new member from the Facebook group gives a text on the Shabuj Global Education official page we ask them to provide their contact number or email that's how we collect those contact numbers, and names and keep them noted in that same excel follow-up file. Hence, we have more than 2500 contact details of both our old clients and new potential clients. If it is an old client who has visited the Dhaka office once and there

is no response from them or they were about to visit but havenot come which is noted in the communication status the file, then I will call them and will ask about their progress in their plan of higher study and will convince them to visit the Dhaka office again, if they have any confusion for which they haven't taken a step. Presently, the clients who still haven't visited the office i call them to ask about their plans related to higher study and give them a clear idea about Uk Higher studies, about our services so that the potential clients visit our office for their higher study plan or PR plan. I counseling with clients over phone, if needed . My follow-up call is mainly for gaining clients for Shabuj Global Education. We also get clients during our education fair.

5. After one month of my internship I got the opportunity to work with our application team. Then I made an application for Shabuj Global Education. I learn to apply to almost 30 Universities. I made SOP for the students about their needs. During my second month of internship, I need to make at least one application every day.

### 5.2 My responsibilities at Shabuj Global Education

- 1. I need to join online educational seminars in various UK universities both public and private. Therefore i have to look after the arrangement process of the seminar by communicating with the university authority on behalf of Shabuj Global Education and I have to fix the date by balancing other task schedules of manager, marketing manager and meetings of Shabuj Global Education.
- 2. My other responsibility is to meet UK university representatives when they visit our Dhaka office. I talk with them and help the Bangladeshi students to communicate with them.

- 3. Shabuj Global arranges 2-3 fairs every year. I invite the students and guests for our Education Fair. I attend my first Education Fair at shabuj Global Education, which was held at Doreen hotel Gulshan.
- 4. Sometimes I counsel with students and give them the necessary information about Higher Studies in the UK.
- 5. Searching the universities in the desired country of the client, admission session slot, semester fee, application fee of a particular university, and availability of the desired subject in that particular university for the clients, and provide them information is my responsibility.
- 6. I also look after the communication between Shabuj Global Education and the authority of UK universities through email. I have given an excel file of top-ranked universities in the UK. All I do is search out the potential contact details of some specific positions such as Country Region Manager, Asian Recruitment Manager, Admission department head, and Registrar to whom I will send an official agreement email to make a business relationship as their agent from Bangladesh.
- 7. My Branch Manager give me a task to make presentation slides for the meeting. And he always allows me to show the presentation in front of everyone.
- 8. I am the admin of the business Facebook page of Shabuj Global Education and moderator of the other 5 Facebook groups of Shabuj Global Education. Every day many students and professionals give a text in the messenger of the Shabuj Global Education business page and every day many members give post on those group pages. I have to every day check each text of each potential client in messenger and reply to them instantly if the questions are simple if any query is a bit complex to answer then I have to inform the senior counselor about the query and have to answer them after discussion within 6-8 hours as most of our clients come

from the social sites through the members of our Facebook pages. I have to look that the post given by the members are relevant and related to higher study before approving the group so that the standard of the group stay high and clean.

### 5.3 My Applied skills (Hard and Soft skills)

#### Hard skills-

### 1. Proficiency in a Foreign Language-

During my internship, I met many foreign representatives. I talk with them. I met a representative name Alex Carey. He is a representative of the University of Birmingham. When I was talking to him I faced a little bit problem to understand him. He talked with me very speedy. But as a student in English Department, I am able to talk with him fluently.

### 2. Typing Speed-

My typing speed is good. Day by day I improve my typing skill. During my internship, my colleagues admire me for this skill. I made many statements of purpose in a very short time.

#### 3. Presentation Skill-

As a student of Daffodil International University, I gave many presentations at my university. I saw many of my colleagues face problems during the presentation. But I am good at presentations. My manager always sends me first to give a presentation.

As an intern, I faced many problems during my internship. When I start the application I faced many problems. I took help from my seniors to solve the problem. At my University, I did a course, which name was Art of living. In this course, I have learned how to solve a problem under pressure. So I use this skill at my workplace.

#### Recommendation

It is been 3 months that I am working at Shabuj Global Education as a student counselor. Till now I have been engaged with many official tasks of Shabuj Global Education. Though the seniors are very helpful and the working environment is friendly and good I could like to give a few recommendations about the management.

- 1. As every day we have to work from 10.30 am to 7 pm and we just get 40 minutes for lunch and for relaxation which is not sufficient for our employees to gain mental strength from tiredness. As a result, the employees start feeling tired at last hour. Also the management should arrange the lunch facilities for employees as buying lunch every day is costly and bringing food for lunch early morning gets difficult for the employees.
- 2. As we employees get only one day's leave on Friday and in salary policy we have just granted free 12 leaves including casual and medical cause per year. So i think they need to concern about this matter. Many circumstances create unwillingly that we can avoid so we should get more leaves for a medical cause or other issues. An employee's physical and mental peace is necessary for a company's development.
- 3. Shabuj Global Education should be more considerate about the salary range of the employees to their work responsibilities.
- 4. Shabuj Global Education has a good image among the target customers. Sometimes we have to deal with clients who are interested to go Australia, Canada, the USA, and Japan but they want the visa processing done by Shabuj Global Education as they have heard about the visa success rate of Shabuj Global Education for Australia, Canada, USA through their

familiar people or the Facebook groups. So I think Shabuj Global Education should partition for countries that have a demand among Bangladeshi students.

5. Shabuj Global need to increase activity at their Dhaka Office.

### 8.1 Limitations of the Report-

I finished my report on time. It does mean that I didnot face any problems during my internship period, I also faced many problems during my internship period.

#### 1. Data collection-

It is not an easy task to collect all data during this short time. As an intern at Shabuj Global Education, it is the most challenging part for me. I work as a counselor and later on their application team. So I met new people in both sectors. As a new intern student I ask them many questions, and sometimes I felt nervous to ask many questions. Sometimes they are busy with their task. But i tried my best to collect data as much as possible.

#### 2. Time Limitations-

It is almost impossible to learn everything in 3 months. Shabuj Global Education is one the most renowned company in the educational consultancy sector. They are working on 100-plus universities. # 3. Lack of Experience-

# 4. Lack of Knowledge –

As a new counselor, I have to talk with students, They ask many questions, and sometimes I am not being able to answer all of these questions. Then I ask my senior and collect all the necessary information. Later I also overcome this problem.

#### **Conclusion**

During my work experience at Shabuj Global Education, I got to know the valuable need of education consulting organizations for the young generation and professional people in Bangladesh, especially government employees. The world is getting technologically and economically advanced day by day and when it is to employment and economy the world has become a global business zone. The young generation wants to be a part of the global economy, and they are interested in higher studies, especially in the UK. We are a developing and densely populated country, and the tendency of going abroad for higher study has raised the scope for better employment and to getting a higher standard of life being a part of modern society.
