

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

Abstract

This report will give an overview of my practical piece of working of knowing the experience as an internship teacher in a Bangladeshi school. I chose Wins School and College to work on my internship. Alongside my experience as an intern teacher, this report also purposed bringing out the methods the teachers use in the class. This report also gives some changes or modifications recommend by the intern teacher who was an intern teacher in order to enhance the English Language Teaching in school level.

To conclude, this study has provided some recommendations based on the overall findings.

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Chapter One: Introduction

I am Afrida Anjum, a student of the Department of English at Daffodil International University. As a requirement of my four years honors degree I did my internship in Wins School and College from 5th August to 5th November, 2022. I personally wanted to be a teacher from the beginning of my academic life. This profession is actually aim of life because this passion in my mind, I chose to do my honors degree in English Language and Literature and completed the courses with earnest dedication and cordiality.

Chapter Two: Background and Objectives of the Internship 2.1 Background of the Internship

I was offered the internship titled Project paper, Code ENG 431 as a part of my B.A (hons) degree. For which I had to choose Wins School and College to gather enough information about the current scenario of ELT, and to experience the challenges in trying out my teaching skills by observing five classes of five different facilitators, and by conducting five classes of different sections in the school. Through the whole process I was also asked to bring out the best solution I can think of to recommend a better environment of learning the target language for students. Even though English is an international Language and it is much demanded in job sectors the teachers only seem to let the students have tight exposure of the target language for passing the exam, and getting a good grade. English is rather taught as a subject in needing to be memorized until passing the exam not as language needs to be acquired.

While observing the classes I noticed English teachers were so passionate about teaching English. During classes, I noticed the teachers or the students using any English in the classes at all expect the part where the teachers and students were having a reading session from the text. The teachers also did encourage the students to speak English.

No use of technology is also a major issue there.

Therefore, the teachers should be more passionate about what they are teaching otherwise the students will not be interested in learning a new Language. The use of English in classroom needs to increase too. Also, technology needs to be introduced in the school to enhance the teaching.

All of these beholds how much important this type of internship is for developing a better learning environment. Not only that the intern will be a better performance in future but also a good recommendation can bring some good changes.

- 6. After completing my observation, I conducted five English classes in class
- 6, 7 and 8.
- 7. At last, after gathering lots of experience from the institute, I completed my report.

Chapter Four: Institution Details

Selecting the Institution

Selecting the institution for sure has to be one of the hardest job when it comes to doing intern as a teacher. I did not want to try my luck out any college because I have always wanted to work with a school. Therefore, I went back to my hometown, Rangpur, and visited a lot of schools but all of them are pretty much privileged. Since I wanted to do this report on some less privileged school to find out how things work out there, I ended up going to Wins School and College in my hometown. As soon as I visited the school the authority of the school gave me access to complete my intern as a teacher. This school has been established in recent years but it has already gained some popularity.

Wins School and College is one of the recently established school in my hometown Ranggur. This school started its journey back in 2020 only with 20 students. With its success through recent years the school now has 400 students estimated. Wins School and College started as a junior high until 2022 it started taking students for senior high too. Thus, the name of the school changed from Wins School to Wins School and College. The school is going to let their students take part in Board examinations by the name of another government school like they did from the start. The school also has records of toping in Board examinations. One of the teachers said the first batch of the school ranked in junior school exam. The failing rate also is lower. Lion Md Manik Hossain is the founder of this school, and he is the one who bear the whole expenses of Teachers' and staffs' salary, and other project related to the school. The rest comes from the students' admission fees and others and public fund. Talking with the faculty members they said Manik Hossain's dream is to let the poor and unprivileged students to get education for free. The teachers also added that this school has saved students from the risk of incidents such as road accident.

Chapter Five: Class observation

I observed many English classes of many different teachers where I gathered information about how the classes are generally taken, how teachers and students cooperate a lesson and the way teachers achieve their expected outcome from students in a school.

To successfully complete my Internship, I observed the first class which was conducted by Ibrahim Mohammad Santo who is an assistant teacher of Wins School and College. He took the class on Right forms of Verb which is a very important topic students were from the class Seven and students observed the class attentively. At first, he talked to everyone for a while and introduce the topic.

He distributed his lesson materials and presented his lecture. He then provided some rules and explained to the students. He asked individually whether they might understand while he was talking. He also tried to teach the student using proverb so that student can understand the topic and use the rules in the appropriate content. He also tried to use examples that is connected with our real life to memorize the rules.

Then I observed Tonu Akhter's class who is an assistant teacher of this Academy. She took the class on "Tense" there were 28 students in the class SIX and this class was really well organized . After starting, her lecture at first she gave the identity of the topic then classes of tense. Then she explained it in detail. In that one hour, she started to teach her student and tried to hold every student attention with very sweet words and sometimes telling funny story.

She discussed tense very clearly so that students do not have any confusions in their mind. However, she explained lots of examples and had given exercise to connect the students. Overall, I had spent a great time in the class.

Rakib Rahman took the class on Text book "English for Today" a significant topic for the students. The name of the topic was" International Mother Language Day". This class was very organized .Before starting, he tried to talk about the historical background of "International Mother Language Day". His way of teaching is wonderful. He made them comfortable and engaged in very short time.

The teacher who conducted the class was Mrs. Shahanaz Nargis. After entered the classroom she gave her identity because she was new for them. The students were from class Eight. The subject she was teaching in the class was English 2nd Paper. The topic of discussion was "Article" In her class, she tried to communicate with the students in English. I saw some students did try for answered in English. Then she gave a title the white board and discussed briefly about the topic. Her speaking style was very charming. I learned many things from this class.

The teacher who conducted the class was Dipty Roy. The subject she was teaching in the class was English and the book was "English For Today" the text book lesson five chapter three. The name of the topic was "The Monkey and the Cap seller".

At the beginning, she entered the class room and introduced me with the students. Then she read the whole story with translation so that students can understand the story very easily. So, the students were the PEC examiner so she tried to talk the students how to answer the question in the examination and sort of question can be in the examination. That class was outstanding and the students were very much cooperative with their teacher.

Chapter Six: My Teaching experience

Conducting classes is as hard as it sounds because controlling a class is as hard as making the students to perceive the lesson. I conducted the classes for VI, VII, and VIII. The teachers also helped me with conducting the classes. So, while conducting a class I had to go through the grammar and all to make them understand a topic because they are attached with conventional way of learnings such as learning grammar by rules from the start, translation of text word by word so that students can understand.

Firstly, I entered into the class on time. As I never had any teaching experience in any educational institute for this reason I felt a little bit nervous. I started the classes with a short introduction of myself though they knew the reason about coming as a guest teacher in their school. At first, I took their attendance and shared my school, college and university times funny moments so that they could become easy with me. Secondly, I started the classes with a short introduction about me though they knew the reason of my coming as a guest teacher.

I introduced myself to my students and informed them about my plan and purpose of this topic. I asked the students what thoughts on the topic and also requested them to tell their experience in this regard. The students answered my questions and practiced exercise.

I try my level best to make them understand about the topic through large description and related examples, so that student can understand the topic easily. I repeated my students that in case they have any confusion about the topic they can ask me willingly. Finally, I gave a short brief about my topic and gave them home work and concluded the class wishing "All the best" Students also attempted to their opinion as much as possible as they know.

I encouraged the students and helped the students so that they utilize their time properly in the right path. I tried to understand the topic easily and gave examples so that they can capture and

answered in the exam. The students completed their exercise that I had provided in the class room. Some students made instant examples related to the topic.

Sometimes I received feedback and sharing my thoughts. My student's feedback gave me more energy, excited and motivation. I really became motivated after receiving their feedback. I was so happy after hearing their complement. They wanted more class with me.

It was a great experience for me. For the very first time I feel honorable by my students. I got attached with my students. After completing my internship I miss some of my students badly. I told them if they need any kind of help or suggestion they can feel free to contact.

Chapter seven: Overall findings

From my observation, Wins School and College might be better than people expect it to be. On my very first day of observing the classes and the school I got the notion that the school is nothing special but after conducting many classes I can see now how my opinion about the school greatly vary from the opinion I had before. Though the students are deprived of technological privilege but they are trying their best from their level to tackle with the difficulties coming in their way. The school is almost as good as some other Govt. school of that area. But there are things about the school that needs a change or retouched.

The school's environment: The school has a really big area of it's own. But this field is not that much clean. Also, to my surprise there is dustbin around the whole school. The students are seen to leave the garbage of any kind here and there. Some teachers also have been observed to do the same. Nevertheless, the school has a big field for the students to do activities, and the greenery of the school calms the mind down.

The classrooms' condition: Each of the classroom is big and have enough numbers of benches but the classrooms are not so much clean and the paint of the rooms already faded. The building of the school also seemed like it could go down anytime as there was no touch of colors.

Lesson plan: The teachers gave their lesson as they should, and almost started and ended the classes on time but they could not provide me any lesson plan when I asked them for it. According to the teachers they do not make a lesson plan for the classes. They simply study on the subjects they are going to teach then the next day they go with the same techniques and styles of teaching their teacher used when they were students.

Lesson delivery: The teachers made the students perceived the lesson the way they always do but there was no use of English synonym and vocabulary neither by the teachers nor the students. The teachers explained topics and everything in only one word English.

Lesson management: All of the teachers showed good command to the rules, in a book-centered method. One of the three teachers used real-life examples and gave group activity but the others did not do anything that kind. The brainstorming part was also missing in classes. Even though the classes are told to be teacher student centered but there were no such activities to prove that.

Chapter Eight: Recommendation

Although the institute attempts to assure all the facilities to the students, but some more facilities should be introduced:

- 1. The canteen facilities can be added.
- 2. There is no cultural and debating club in the college. There should be formed so that students can be connected with practicing English language.
- 3. A monthly meeting should be organized. A monthly meeting between the teachers and the guardians of the students.
- 5. In order to sustain in the current time, the institution should use modern technology.
- 6. Magazine or English Newspapers may be provided by the school.

Chapter Nine: Conclusion

After observation and taking classes, I have a clear idea of English Language Teaching in a Bangladeshi High School. I learned a lot of things about English teaching from the experienced teachers during my internship time. The students and teachers were very sincere and helpful. For their cooperation, I could complete the internship nicely. I completed their lesson with fun and tried to use examples from our real life. For this reason they enjoyed my teaching and made a good bonding with me. After gathering lots of experience from the internship, I made the project paper which will help me to do better in teaching profession.
