First Week (22th Aug to 29th Aug)


- My Industrial Supervisor was my academic teacher in a course named advanced video production. On the first day of starting, he instructed me all about JMC MEDIA LAB.

Second Week (30th Aug to 6th Sep)


- My Industrial Supervisor gave me tasks every week.


