Chapter –V

Class observation report

5.1 First Class Observation

It was the day I observed my first class on 16 September 2022 at 10.00 am with class 8. It was conducted by Farzana Yasmin, and she prepared herself perfectly. She conducted the class confidently. When the class started, she gave an amazing introduction, so that the students can be engaged. Her topic was "Preposition". She was going through by teaching preposition rules one by one. She gave such example that made every student focused on the class. She asked them to answer her question and students who can answer was getting applauses by others, which made others active. But she was unable to focus on every student at a time. The students sat on the back benches were gossiping among them, not even listening to their teacher, which is a common scenario in Bangladeshi schools. Overall, it could be said that it was a new experience for me to observe someone's class and wrote about it.

5.2 Second Class Observation

I also observed another class on 28th of September 2022 at 11.20 am, the name of the teacher was Nilufa. Her topic was "Paragraph writing'. In her class, there almost 75 students were presented. She also made an interesting introduction. She seemed very close to her students. But she was not very fluent with her words. She was not so strict to her students but was very systematic. In her class, she showed to the students some tricks that can use while writing any paragraph. Meanwhile, she asked her student to write a paragraph on a random topic. Most of the students could not attempt the given task as they did not have proficiency in English vocabulary.

At the end of class, few students seemed enthusiastic others did not enjoy the class.

5.3 Third Class Observation

On 2nd October I observed the third class, conducted by Ratan Kumar at 11:20 am. He was conducting his class with class 10.I was expecting to see some improvement in the students as they were about to face board exam. He taught his students the Right forms of verb. But he had to teach them with the help of the guide book. He was unable to give proper answer of his students to clear their confusion. At the same time the students were too weak in these grammatical rules. They got frightened when the teacher asked them to practice some exercise from the book.

But I must say Ratan Kumar tried his level best to solve his student queries.

5.4 Fourth Class Observation

I have observed fourth class, on 13th October. That was conducted by Alauddin Khan. He was conducting his class with the students of class 9 and he was going to teach them English For Today. In the beginning of the class, he asked to open the books and asked them what was the previous passage. Then he stood middle of the class to check on every student. He was asking them if anyone of them could read that passage loudly. Faisal, from the students stood up and started to read. Alauddin sir was helping him wherever Faisal was facing any difficulties. The teacher finished that passage as he was telling a story and everyone was very attentive to him. This method impressed me to catch the attention of the students. Alauddin sir leave that class after gave the students a task which was almost done by every student in the class.

It was really a fun class to observe.

5.5 Fifth Class Observation

I have observed the last class on October 20th. It was a class with the students of class 10 and conducted by Sharmin Akhter. She was about to teach the students English second paper. And her topic was Article. She started with the rules of articles. She was going through every rule and teach them one by one. After finishing some rules, she asked the students randomly to ensure that they did not have any confusion. Some of the students were finding difficulties to remember all the rules. But the teacher taught the rules again so that they could feel easy whenever they practiced the exercise.

I have learned many things from the class. It was so effective class for me.

I was very excited to experience my first class as a teacher. I was asked to take the second class as I am a intern teacher, so I went to the school at 11 am. Firstly I went to the Principal's room, he took me to the Teacher's room to meet everyone. At 11:20 am Principal took me to the class Eight, section B, it was the girl's section. When we entered the class all of the students stood up and gave Salam. Principal introduced me to them and left the class. I again introduced myself, I told them why I was there. They were quite friendly with me. After the introductory part, I asked them which chapter they wanted to learn from me. They all were agreed to learn Article. I started my class by telling a few sentences and asked them to put right article. Some of the students could answer them properly. I told them why that article should use before that vowel or consonant. In the last 10 minutes I wrote some sentences on the white board, and told them to fill the blanks with the correct article. I saw that time, most of them could easily put the right article. That made me feel maybe I was enabled to teach them properly.I got feedback from the students in last 5 minutes. My heart was filled with happiness when I left the class.

They asked me some question like where did I live, what was my result when I was in high school etc. After finishing that part. I ordered them to open their English Second Paper book and open the Parts of Speech chapter. Due to the time limitation I couldn't finish all the parts, but I covered many of them. In the last 10 minutes I said some words and told them to find which parts of speech did the word belong. They gave me feedback from overall class structure in last 5 minutes. They were answering them properly. It was an active class.
