The National Final of 'Get in the Ring - a Global Startup Competition' where promising start-ups of different public and private universities of Bangladesh fight to fly to Global Meet Up, was held yesterday.

Nusrat Jahan Rysa of Arced Foundation won the national level championship beating 11 other competitors at 71 Milonayoton of Daffodil International University in Dhaka.

Md Mosharraf Hossain Bhuyan, chairman of National Board of Revenue was present during the occasion as the chief guest, a press release from the university said. Dr Md. Sabur Khan, chairman of Board of Trustees of Daffodil International University presided over the program. Daffodil International University is the national host of this international competition known as the Olympic for start-ups. This is for the second time that 'Get in the Ring' competition was organised by Daffodil International University. Earlier in 2015, Daffodil International University organised this competition for the first time in the country.
