Class observation Report

It was 18 March, 2018. I informed the school about my internship plan and got permission. I chose the date 19 March to 21 March for my internship project. I observed three classes of different teachers and the respected teachers are-

- 1. Salma Akhter
- 2. Ferdousi Begum
- 3. Md. Aminul Islam.

• First day Experience on first class: 19 March, class-1

I went to observe the class of Salma Akhter. She was an English teacher of class four and five. I joined class five with her. Most of the students were present in time and they were attentive. The teacher, after her entry counted the number of present students and started teaching. Teacher tought them English poems and checked their previous homework and made her content of lesson easy for the students. She questioned them and students were answering properly. All of them were spontaneous spectators. The class started at 10 a.m. and ended at 10:30 a.m.

- Class-2 The second class was Bengali class by Ferdousi Begum. She was a charming one indeed. She taught the students of class IX about Application, mail and summary writing, She introduced me with her students. All of them were female students and it was a very good feeling. She tried her best to make the lesson interesting for her students. That class started at 11:30. am and ended at 12:15 pm.
- **Class-3:** It was class ten. And the teacher was Md. Aminul Islam. He introduced me with his beloved students. All of them were smart looking and well-organized with their uniforms. Their dress code was blue and it looked good. Sir taught them about Grammanr, English Second Part. His discussion topic was tag question and conditional sentence. He divided his lesson plans and did his content of teaching through various parts of sentences and tenses. It seemed me that students were enjoying the class. Class started at 2:30 pm and ended 3:15 pm.

Overall Class observation Analysis:

My overall experience of observing three different classes were really good to me. And I was performing like a professional educator. I passionately observed that classes and learnt techniques of teaching. The teacher were performing well. Besides I had filled my observation check list from while I was observing the three classes. And the matter I have noticed that teachers teaching techniques were different from one another.

Mrs. Salma Khatun, mam was very caring with her students. She was observing the whole classes and she took a special care of the weak students. Her performances was realy mindblowing. She was also performing to make the students understand. She also made the students to perform also.

The teachers were asking questions to their students and they were participating. In the classroom all the students were not the same Some were very good at learning and some tok more time to understand. All the students were with their uniforms and it looked really very nice.
