Internships give knowledge about working world. It is a practical work to achieve some goals into 3 months. And those are helped when you work in future carrier.


It also teach us about professional behavior, norms, manners, attitudes, those are helped to establish us in future work life.

BSAF has been preparing the report through collecting information and gathering data from various sources including media contents, publications of national and international organizations, academic and research institutions.
